

# 212ss-07 Tours Dolman Cardigan



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Tours [100% linen; 115 yds/105m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #02 natural beige, 14 skeins [415g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- center back neck-to-cuff 71.5cm/28.15"
- length 71cm/27.95"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A (3.9mm needles): 25 sts and 28 rows
- pattern stitch B (3.9mm needles): 24 sts and 28 rows
- pattern stitch C (3.6mm needles): 19 sts and 35 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Knitting Tips

**Back body:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method, and starting from the cuff, work in pattern stitches A and B. Work right underarm shaping with lifted increases. Pick up 32 stitches from a crochet chain (made in advance for this purpose). Shape left underarm by working decreases (k2tog) and by binding off stitches.

**Right and left front body & buttonband:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method, and work left front (from cuff) and right front (from buttonband edge) in pattern stitches A and B. Shape underarms in the same manner used for back. For front buttonband, also cast on with long-tail cast-on method, and make two strips in pattern stitch C. Seam the ends of the two strips together with Kitchener stitch.

**Finishing:** Seam from sleeve to shoulder with mattress stitch. Seam sides with slip stitch seam. Seam front buttonband strip to body with slip stitch, placing wrong sides together. Seam back collar with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around cuffs and work pattern stitch B in the round. Bind off in pattern.

## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

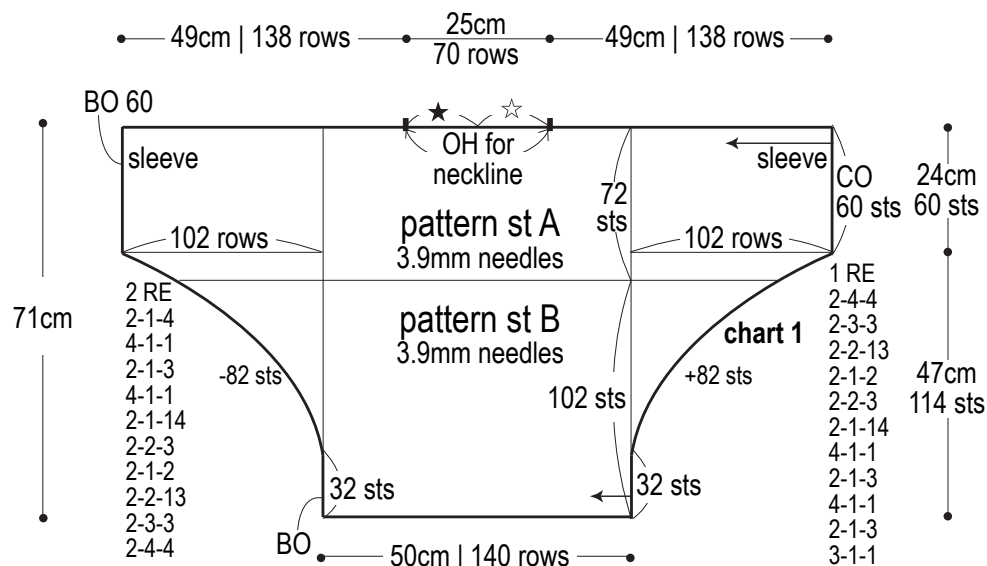
OH = on hold (i.e., place on stitch holder)

PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

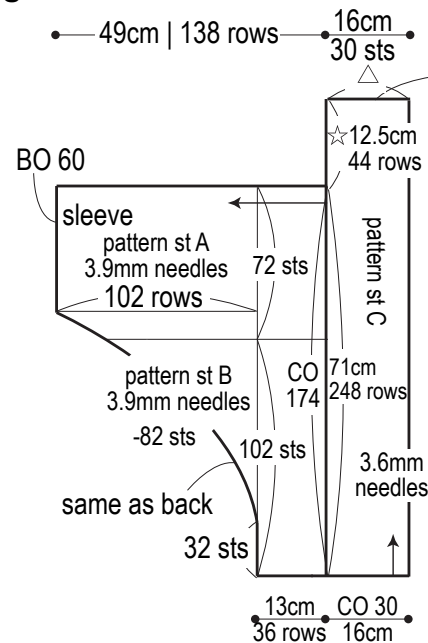

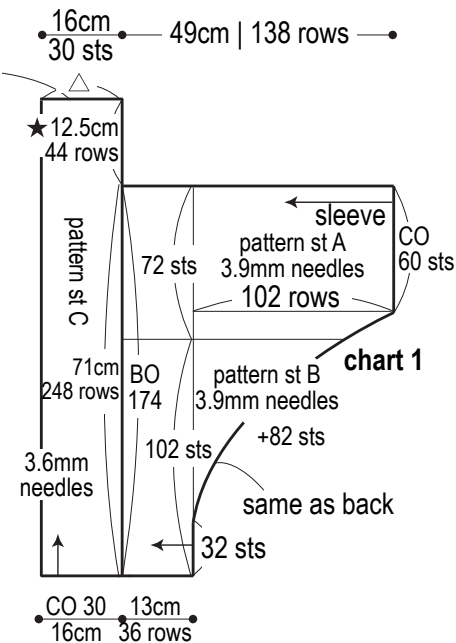
※Seam ☆ and ☆, and also

prepared in advance.

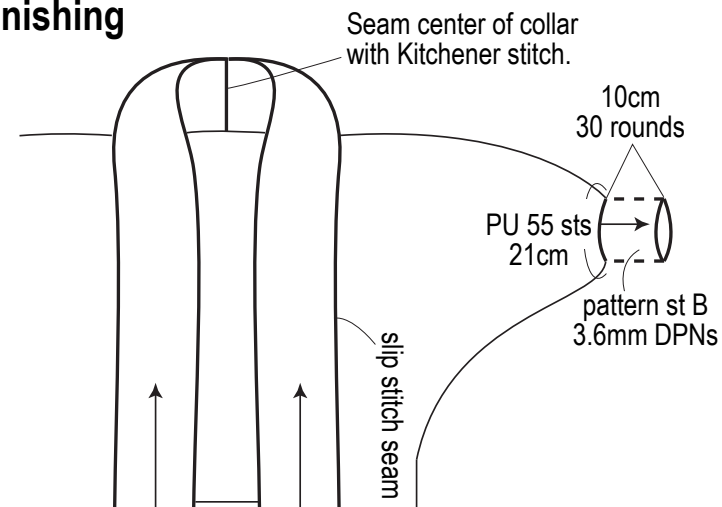

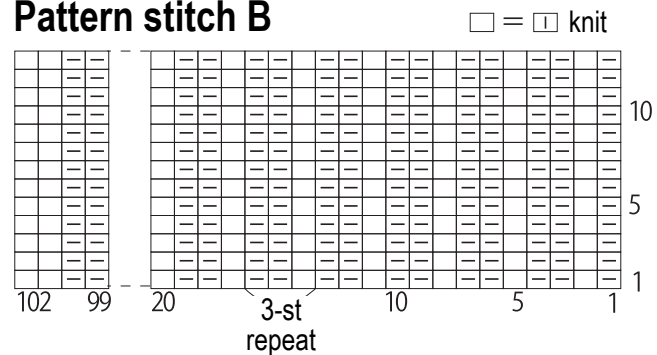

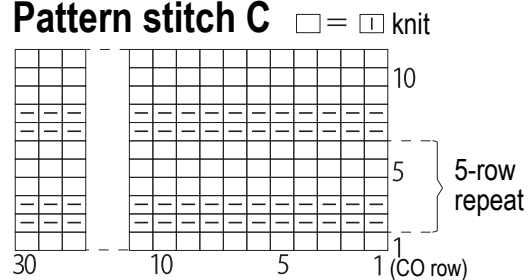

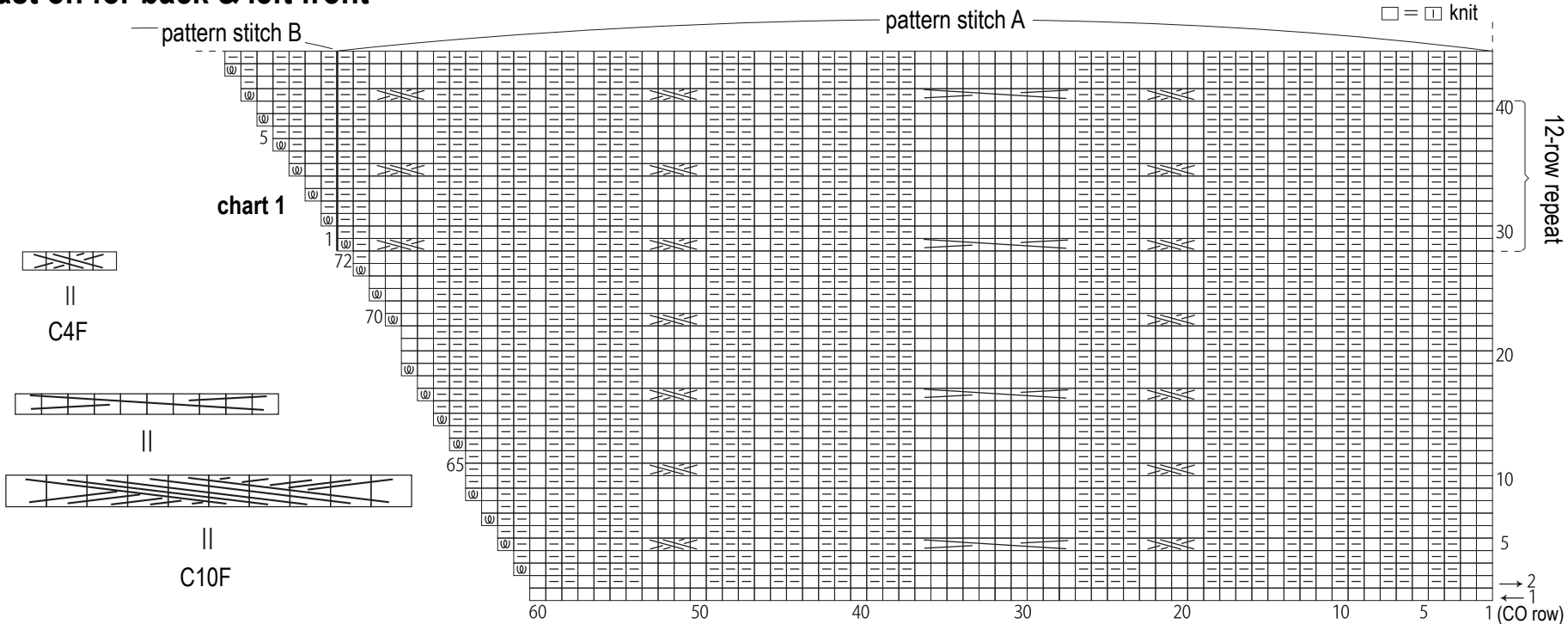
### Pattern stitch B
