

212ss-26 Amian Purse



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Amian [100% washable Japanese paper; 94 yds/86m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #26 pickles, 6 skeins [225g]
- Pierrot Yarns Am Cotton Bulky [100% cotton; 115 yds/105m per 3.42-3.53 oz./97-100g hank]; color #02 beige, 1 hank [20g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) and 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- Refer to schematics.

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US): 24 sts and 24 rows
- pattern stitch: 24 sts and 14 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Bottom: Crochet a chain to begin. Work in sc, increasing as indicated.

Sides: Continuing from bottom, work 6 rounds of sc, then 31 rounds of pattern stitch. On round 29, you will be creating holes to thread the handles through.

Finishing: Referring to schematics, crochet handles. Through through eyelets made for this purpose.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain

crdc = crossed dc

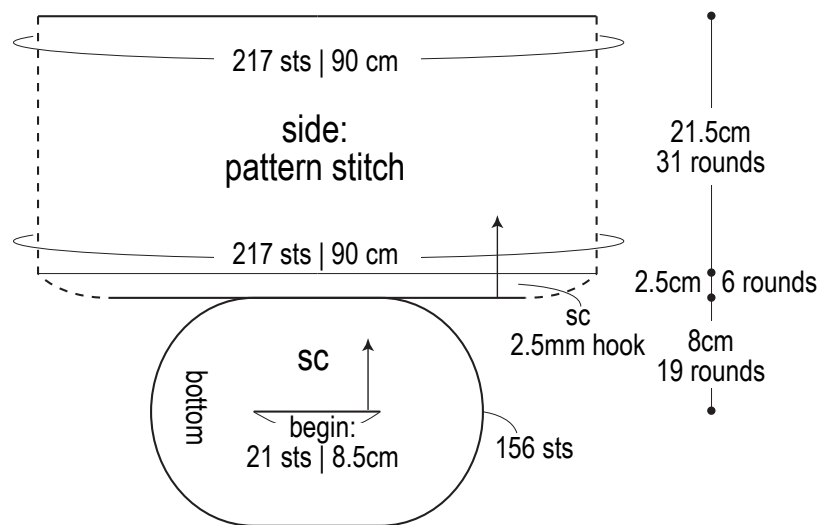
dc = double crochet (US)

left-leaning crdc = skip next st, dc into next stitch, dc into next st, dc into skipped stitch

right-leaning crdc = skip 2 sts, dc into third stitch, dc into first skipped stitch (working behind first dc), dc into second skipped stitch (working behind first dc)

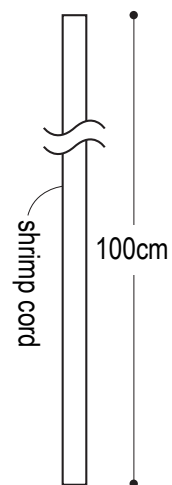
sc = single crochet (US)

Bag (2.5mm hook, Amian)

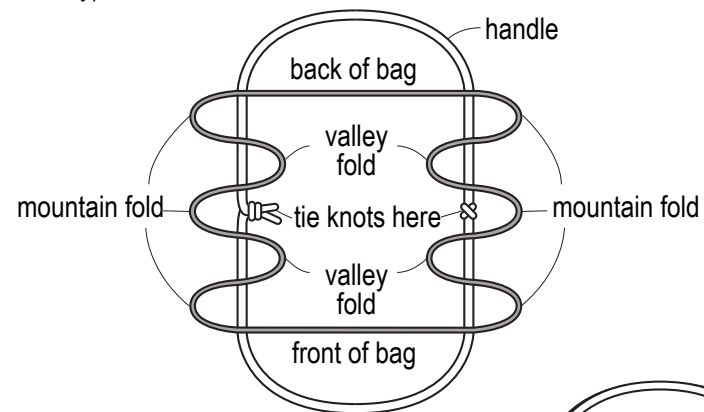


Handles

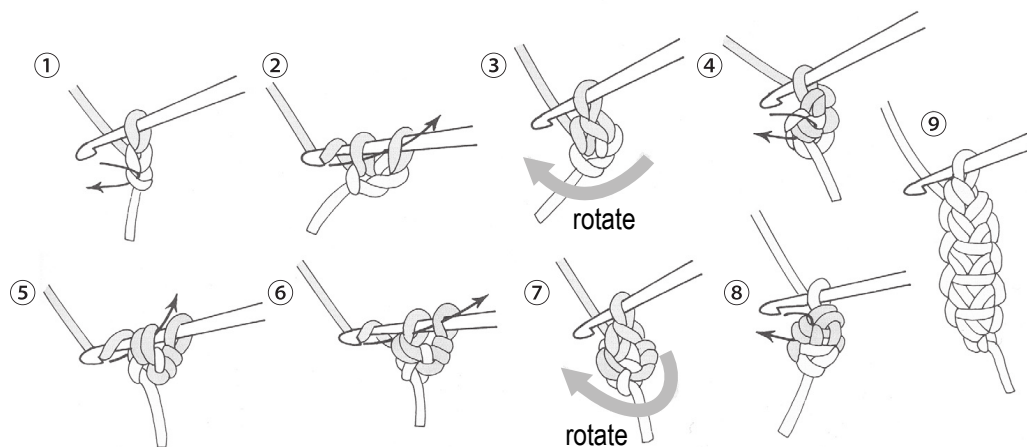
(3.5mm hook, Ami Cotton Bulky)

Lobster stitch cord

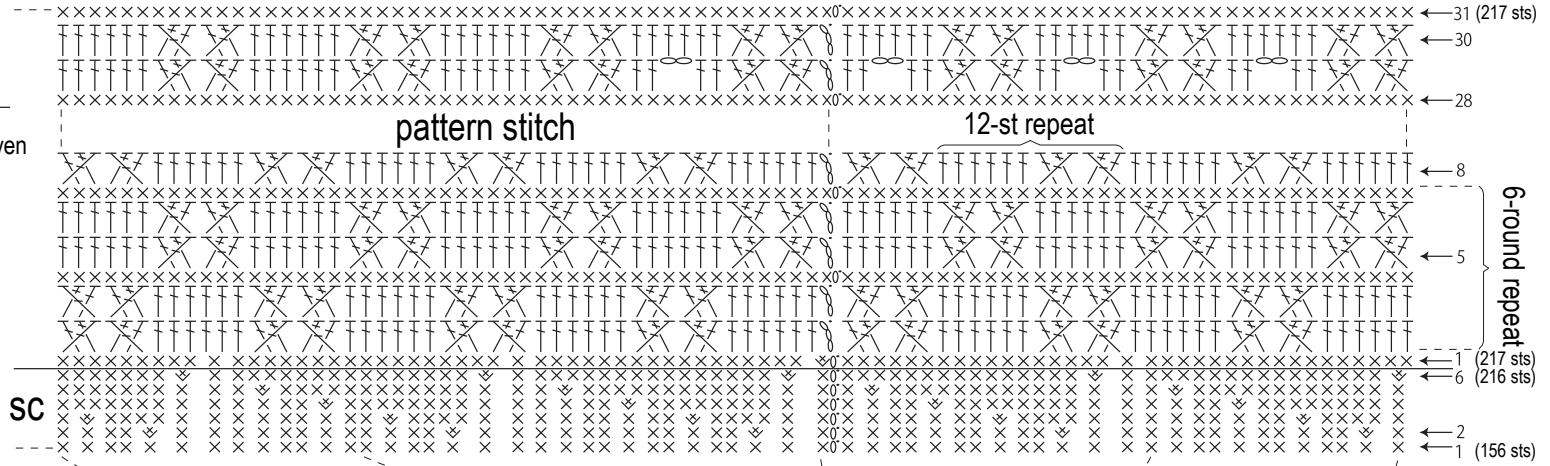


- ① ... ch1

- ⑨ ... Repeat ④ ~ ⑦.

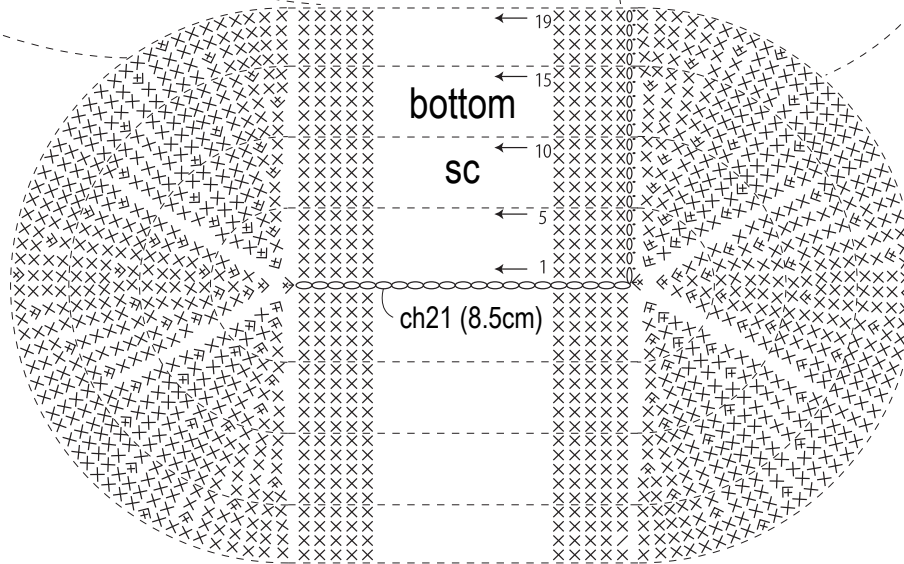
