

212s-5 Basic Cotton Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Basic Cardigan [100% cotton; 60 yds/55m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #10 sky gray, 10 skeins [300g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) and 4.2mm (approx. US 7) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5 buttons (13mm/0.51")

Finished measurements:

- bust 93cm/36.61"
- cross back width 38cm/14.96"
- length 48cm/18.90"
- sleeve length 19.5cm/7.68"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 21 sts and 26 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Back & front body, sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method; work in garter stitch and pattern stitch.

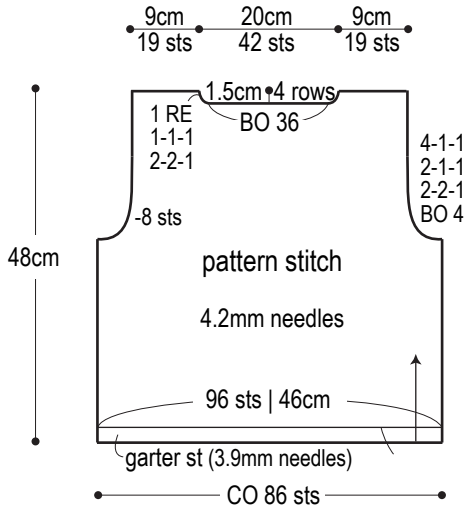
Amigurumi buttons: Create magic ring, and work sc in the round. Leave a long tail after binding off. Make up button following schematic instructions.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with slip stitch. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam sleeves to body with slip stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in garter stitch. Pick up stitches along front edges; work front button bands in garter stitch. Make and attach button loops to right front band where indicated. Attach amigurumi buttons to left front band where shown.

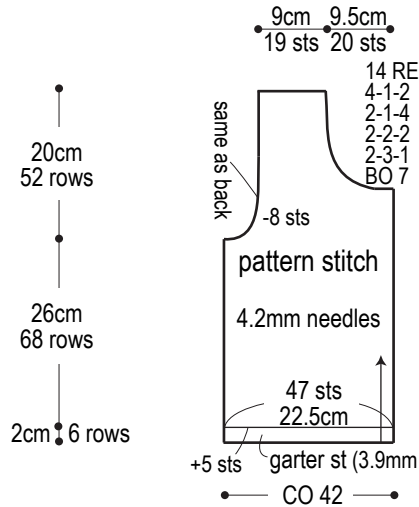
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
ch = chain
CO = cast on
m = magic ring
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
sc = single crochet (US)
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

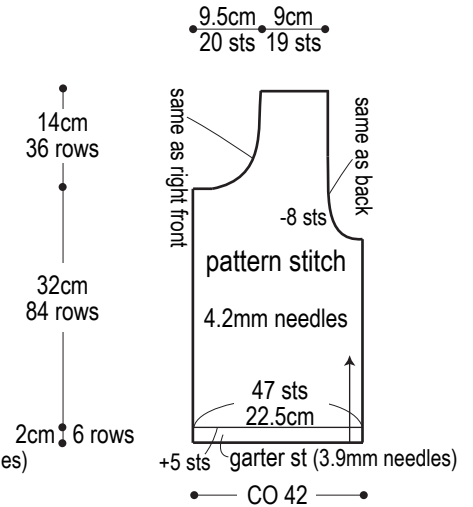

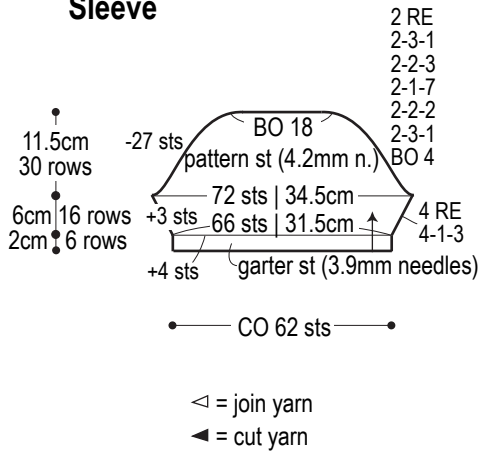
Right front



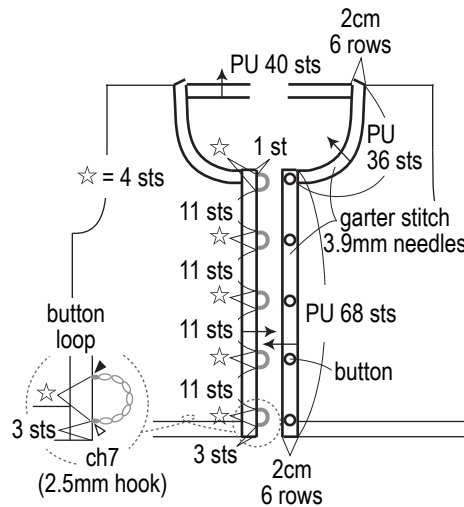
Left front

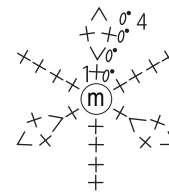

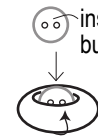


Amigurumi button (2.5mm hook)

make 5



round	stitch count
4	6 (-3 sts)
3	9 (work even)
2	9 (+3 sts)
1	6 (sc6 into magic ring)



On last round, thread yarn through sts and cinch shut.

Leave 20cm tail after binding off.

※Use the yarn tail to sew button to cardigan.

Pattern stitch (4.2mm needles)
