

212s-13 Summer Poncho



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Beauty Silk Cotton [90% cotton, 10% silk; 180 yds/165m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #13 baby pink, 6 skeins [155g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.0mm (US steel hook 4), 2.3mm (approx. US B), and 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- length 49.5cm/19.49"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 7.5 peaks and 13 rows
- net stitch (2.5mm hook): 7.5 peaks and 14 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

※Work cord with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Body: Chain to begin, working first row into bottom loops of chain Work 10 rows of ch4 net stitch. Using a piece of chain 19 chain stitches long (worked with a separate ball of yarn in advance for this purpose), work net stitches at front placket area into chain. Work ch5 net stitch in joined rounds, altering gauge as indicated by changing hook sizes. Continue, working pattern stitch in joined rounds, working evenly spaced decreases. Work edging in the round.

Finishing: Working into foundation chain at beginning, work collar and front placket edging in single crochet (US). Crochet 2 cords (each with 2 strands of yarn held together). Make and attach fringe to beginning end of each cord. Seam other end of each cord to body of poncho.

Abbreviations:


ch = chain

RE = rows even

sc = single crochet (US)

= rows-peaks-places-times (For example, 4-1-8-5 means "every 4 rows, decrease 1 peak in each of 8 places evenly spaced around; do this 5 times total." This means that on every decrease round, you decrease 8 peaks in all, and there will be 5 decrease rounds for this step.)


Body of poncho

Cord: make 2


2.5mm hook, use 2 strands of yarn



*Fringe: Fold 8 strands of yarn (each 19cm long) in half, attach to starting end of chain.

Net stitch (change hook size as shown)


2.0mm, 2.3mm, 2.5mm hooks




*Using yarn tails, seam chain (prepared in advance) to both edges of front placket area.




