

210-4 Net Stitch Bolero



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Sawayaka Cotton [100% cotton; 416 yds/380m per 3.53 oz./100g cone];
 - girls' size: color #16 pink, 1 cone [95g]
 - ladies' size: color #26 artichoke, 2 cones [150g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 26 sts and 12 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Back body: Chain to begin, working first row into bottom loops of chain. Starting from shoulder, work in pattern stitch.

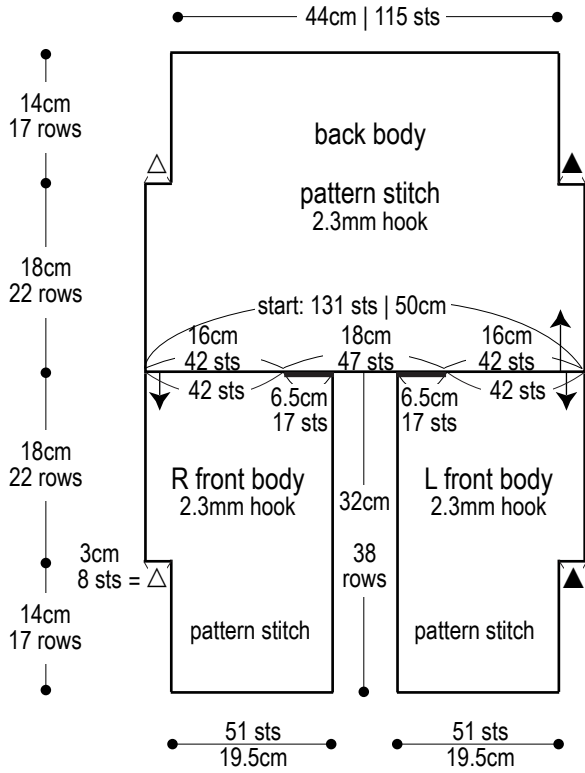
Front body: Working into stitches from start of back body, work front in pattern stitch. At both sides of front center, add 17 new sts (14 sts for girls' size).

Finishing: Seam sides and sleeve undersides with chain seam (alternating chain and sc stitches as needed). Work 1 row of sc along front edge and neckline, then work edging. Work 1 row of sc along hem, then work edging. Work 1 round of sc around cuff, then work edging.

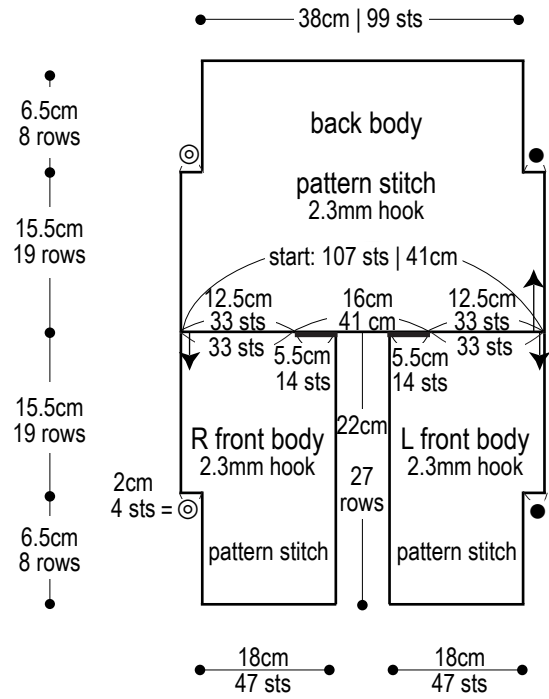
Abbreviations:

Ladies' bolero

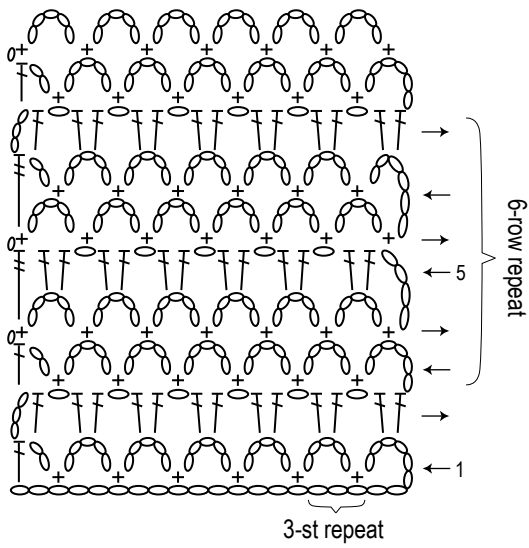


Girls' bolero

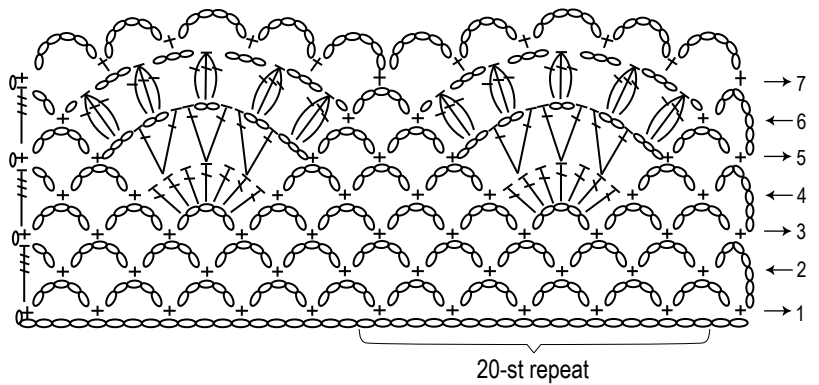

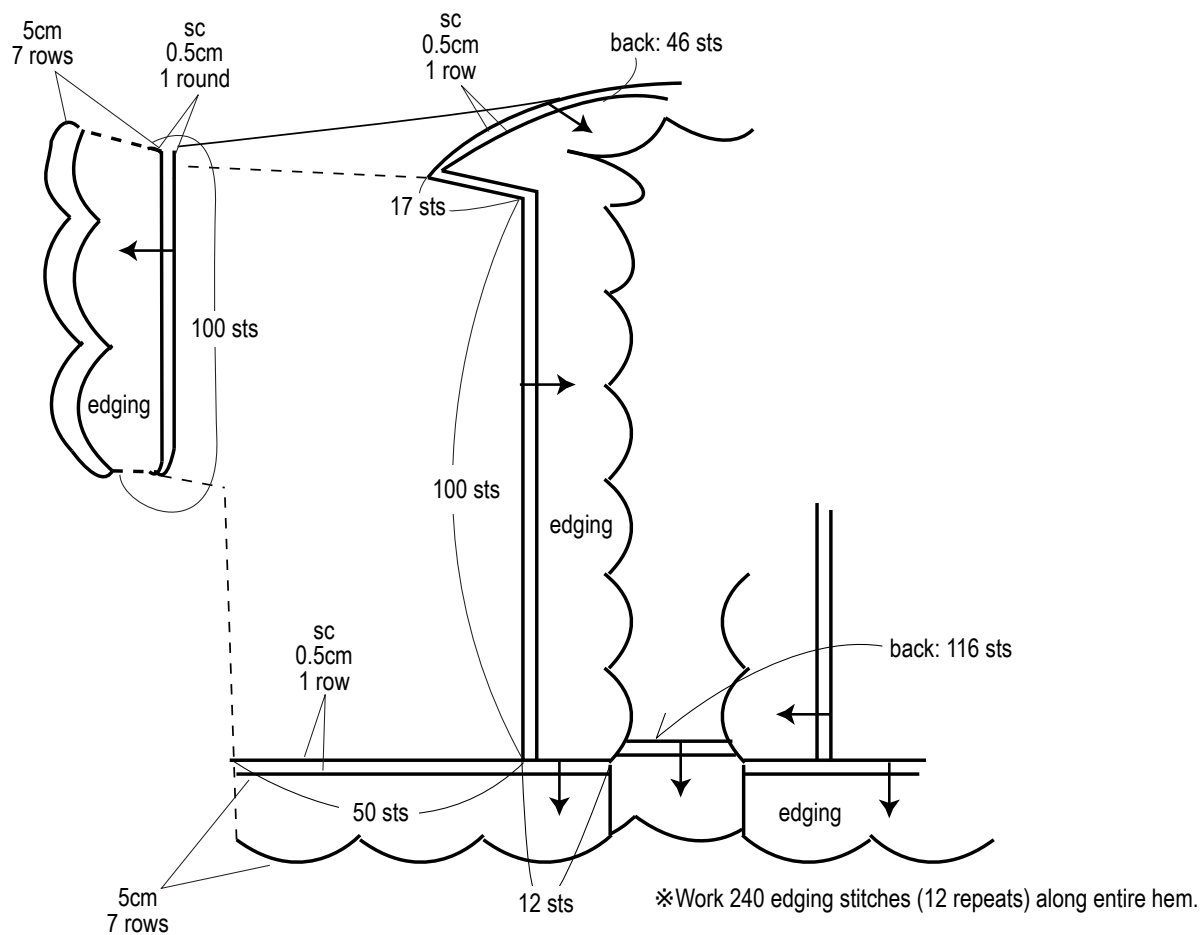
Pattern stitch (2.3mm hook)
