

212ss-13 Flower Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Beauty Silk Cotton [90% cotton, 10% silk; 180 yds/165m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - color #01 white, 3 skeins [365g]
 - color #08 maroon, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #15 citron green, 1 skein [small amount]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 5) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.6mm (approx. US 5) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 piece of Japanese paper, 50cm/19.69" square
- 5 buttons (15mm/0.59")
- embroidery needle

Finished measurements:

- bust 96cm/37.80"
- center back neck-to-cuff 46cm/18.11"
- length 65cm/25.59"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch (with largest needles): 23 sts and 28 rows
- k1p1 ribbing (with smallest needles): 24 sts and 30 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

※Entire cardigan - including embroidery - is worked with 2 strands of yarn held together.

Front & back body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method; work in k1p1 ribbing and stockinette stitch. Shape sides with backwards loop cast-on increases. For front, work buttonbands in k1p1 ribbing at the same time as the front body; be sure to work buttonholes in right front.

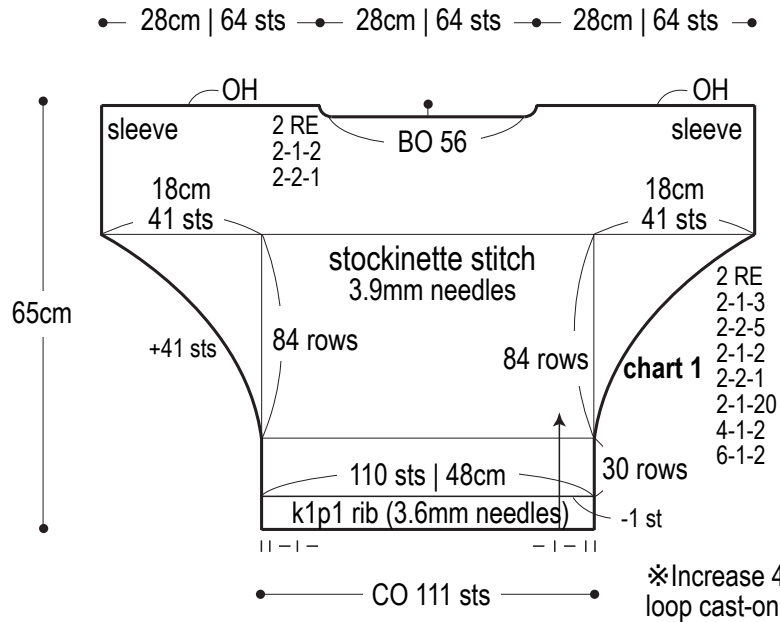
Finishing: Seam sleeve from shoulder using slip stitch seam. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Seam ends of buttonband together with woven seam, then seam to back neckline with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch seam. Pick up stitches around cuffs; work edging in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Fasten buttons to left front.

Embroidery: Baste Japanese paper to top of knitted fabric as shown. Embroider from top of paper.

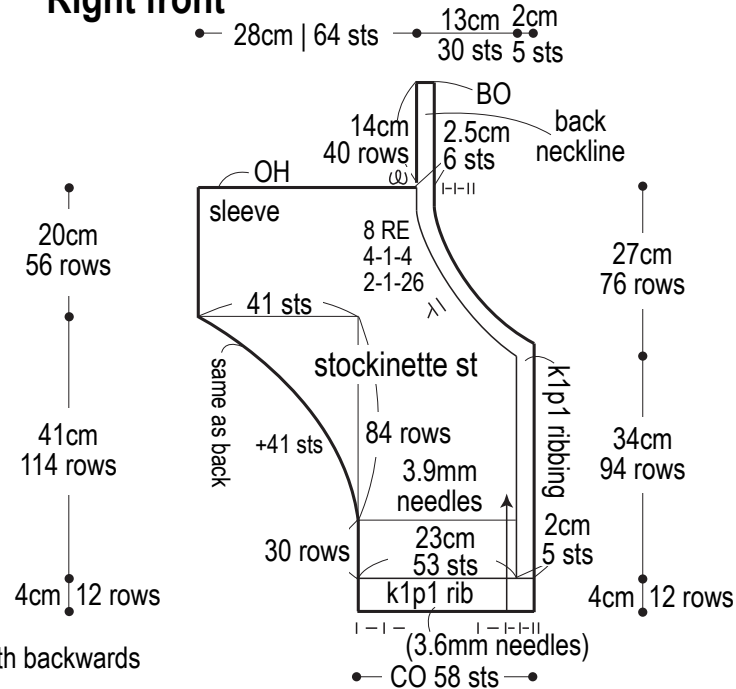
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off; CO = cast on; OH = on hold (place stitches on stitch holder); PU = pick up; RE = row(s) even; #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

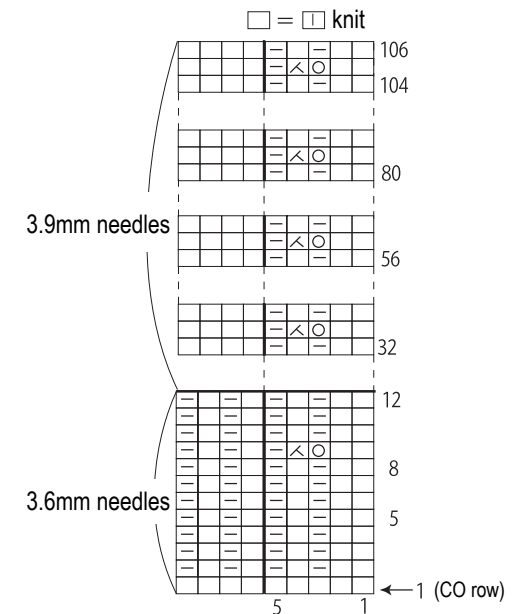
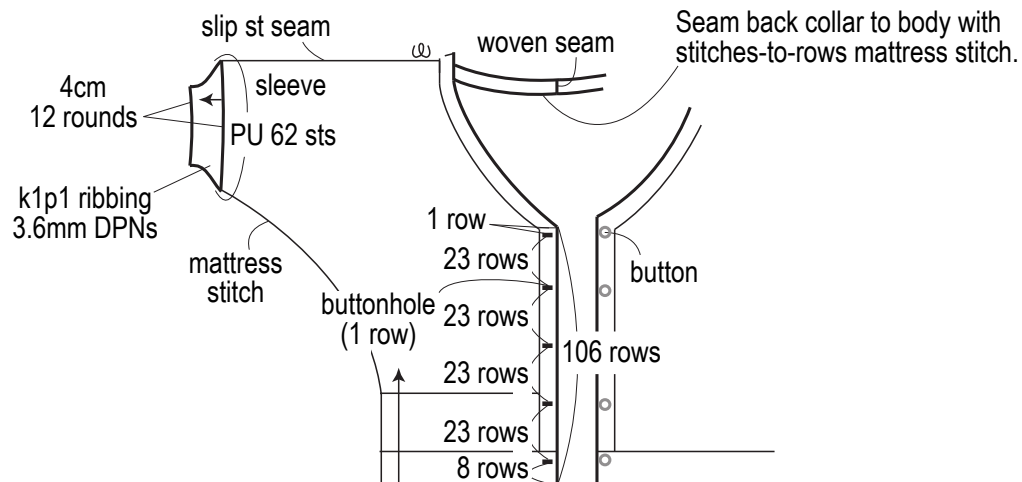


Right front

Instructions

Place paper to top of knitted fabric

Baste sheet of Japanese paper to top of knitted fabric. back
 Embroider on top of the paper.
 When embroidery is finished, remove paper by grasping embroidered area
 and gently tearing paper away.

※In place of Japanese paper, you may use tracing paper. However, take care, as tracing paper rips more easily than Japanese paper.
