

211F-13 Saumur Tunic



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Saumur [70% merino wool, 30% alpaca; 118 yds/108m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #01 beige, 8 skeins [240g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 91cm/35.83"
- cross back width 33cm/12.99"
- length 67.5cm/26.57"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 23 sts and 12 rows
- pattern stitch B: 24 sts and 12 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Front & back body: Work chain to begin. Work pattern stitch A towards hem. Then, working stitches into bottom loops of chain, work bodice in pattern stitch B towards shoulders.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with woven seam. Seam sides with chain seam (alternating chain and sc stitches as needed). Work edging in the round around neckline, armholes, and hem.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain
rep = repeat(s)
sc = single crochet (US)

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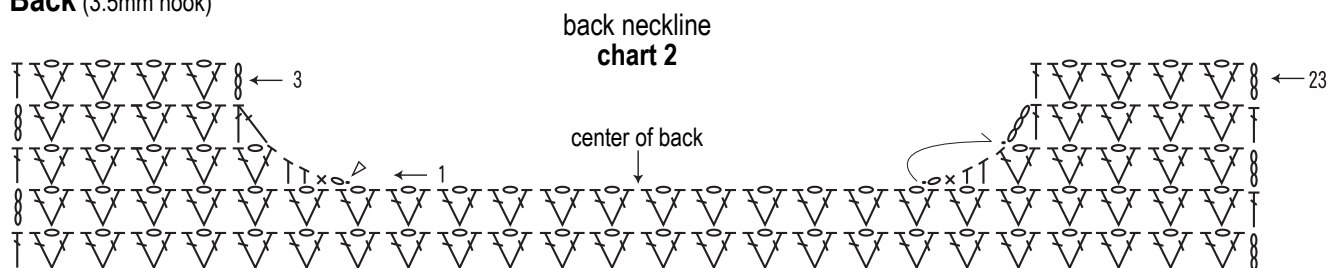

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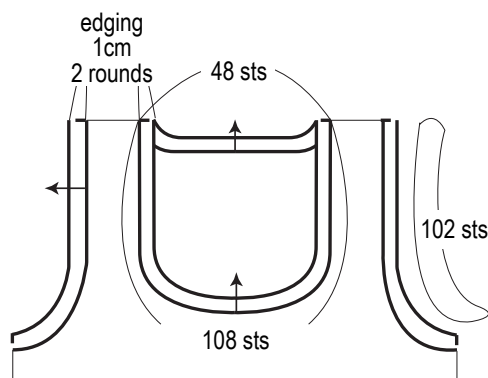
