211w-02 Retro Tippet



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Rover [100% Uruguayan wool; 61 yds/56m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #04 melange brown, 2 skeins [65g]
 - color #05 brown, 2 skeins [65g]

Tools/Notions:

- 5.5mm (US I) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2 pieces of cotton lace ribbon (25mm/0.98" wide, 0.5m/19.69" long)

Finished measurements:

- width 10cm/3.94"
- length 56cm/22.05"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• pattern stitch: 12 sts and 10.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

*Entire tippet is worked with 2 strands of yarn held together: 1 strand of color #04 melange brown and 1 strand of color #05 brown.


Body of tippet: Work chain to begin. Work alternating rows of sc and looped sc. Make another piece just like the first.

Finishing: Seam bind-off edges of the two pieces together from the wrong side using whipstitch. At each end, sew cotton lace ribbon to tippet.


Abbreviations:

ch = chain looped sc = see explanation on page 2 sc = single crochet (US)


Body (make 2) *1 strand each of #04 and #05.




Finished item



Pattern stitch (5.5mm hook)








Make loops using middle finger.




1 Carry yarn over hook, using middle finger of left hand to pull yarn down, lengthening the loop as needed.



2. Insert hook into stitch. 3. Wrap loop around hook, While keeping elongated loop on middle finger, draw new loop up from working yarn.



then draw through two loops on hook. You will now have a long loop on the side of the fabric facing away from you.
