

212s-2 French-sleeve Bolero



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Neat S [100% cotton; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #33 grage, 9 skeins [345g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- cross back width 50cm/19.69"
- length 50cm/19.69"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 23 sts and 14 rows
- pattern stitch B: 22 sts and 10 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Back body: Chain to begin, working first row into bottom loops of chain. Work half of back in pattern stitch A. Working into ends of rows, work remaining half in pattern stitch B sideways.

Front body: Begin right front just like right back, and work in pattern stitch A. Start left front from side seam edge; work in pattern stitch B.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with KUSARI-HAGI. Seam sides with KUSARI-TOJI. Work edging A in the round along armholes. Starting by working into wrong side of neckline, work collar in edging B. Work hem in edging B as well, but start from right side. Work front plackets in edging B.

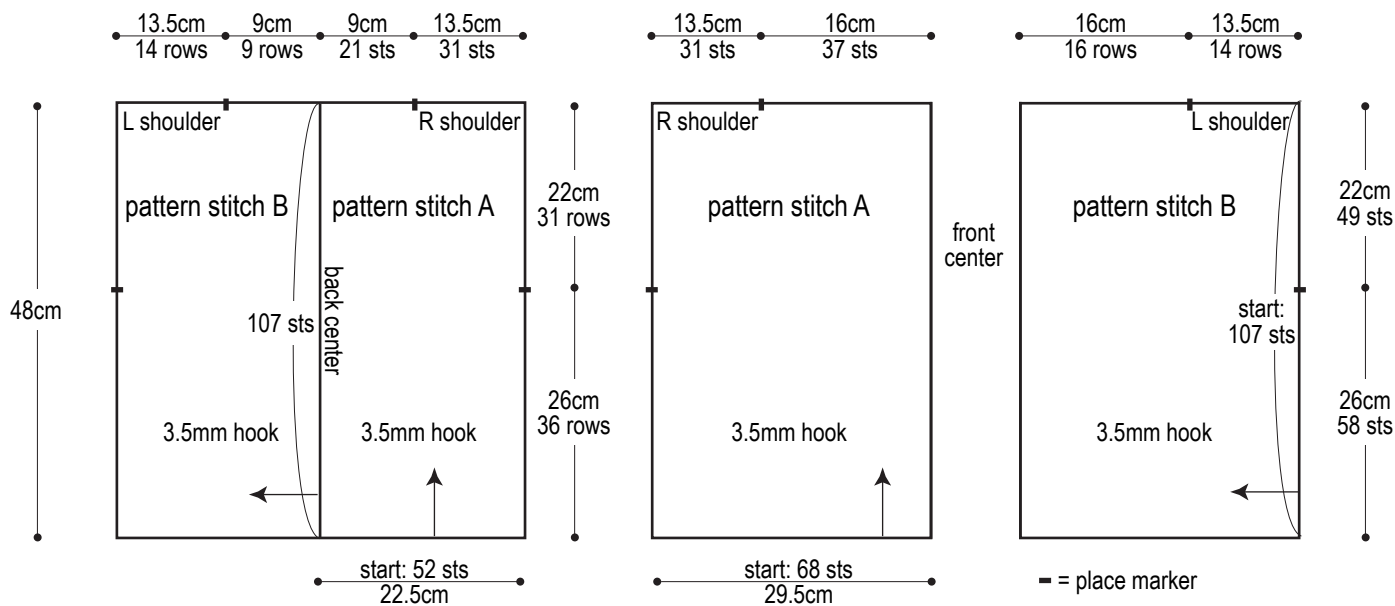

ch = chain

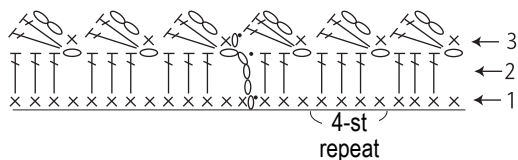
Back

Right front

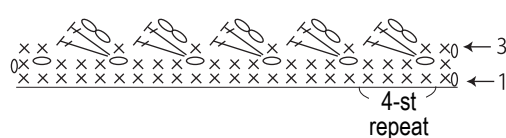
Left front



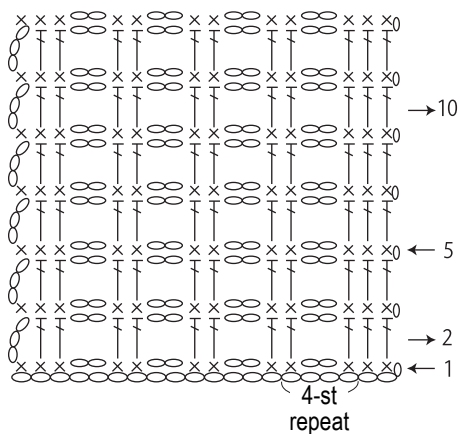
Edging A (3.5mm hook)



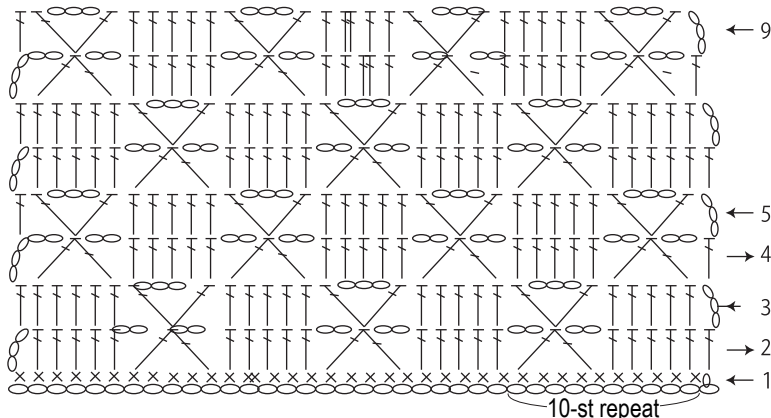
Edging B (3.5mm hook)



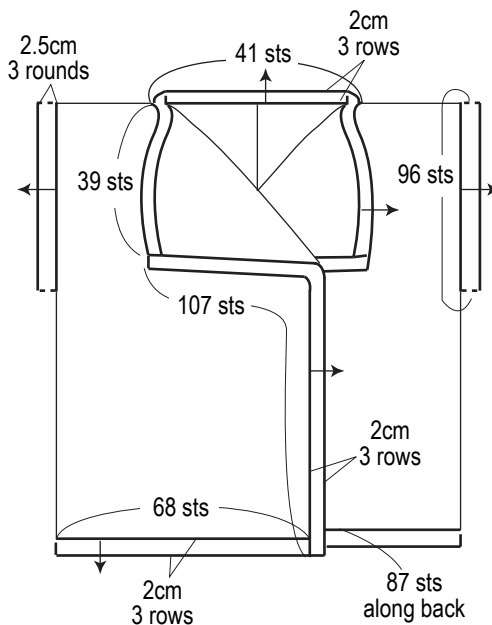
Pattern stitch A (3.5mm hook)
