

212ss-31 Shine Cotton Cap



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Shine Cotton [100% cotton; 155 yds/142m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - color #01 white, 2 skeins [35g]
 - color #05 leaf green, 1 skein [15g]
 - color #07 navy blue, 1 skein [10g]
 - color #12 red, 1 skein [15g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.0mm crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2 buttons (15mm/0.59")

Finished measurements:

- head circumference 49cm/19.29"
- depth 8.5cm/3.35"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US): 32.5 sts and 40 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Top: Chain to begin, working first row into bottom loops of chain. Work in sc stripes, increasing and decreasing as indicated. Work edging in the round around perimeter of top.

Side & belt: Cast on as for top; work side in sc stripes in the round. Slip stitch to begin belt as continuation from side. Decrease, then work 2 rounds of sc stripes and cut yarn. Work stitches into ch10 made for size adjuster, then continue to belt section, working sc stripes back and forth in rows.

Bill: Chain to begin, working first row into bottom loops of chain. Work in sc stripes, increasing and decreasing as indicated.

Finishing: Working stitches into first round of side piece, work edging in the round for 1 round, forming gathers where indicated. With WS of top and side facing, seam them together with slip stitch. With RS of bill and side facing, slip stitch together from wrong side. From belt, work edging to bill and size adjuster. Attach buttons. Use color #01 white for edging and slip stitch seams.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain
RS = right side
sc = single crochet (US)
WS = wrong side

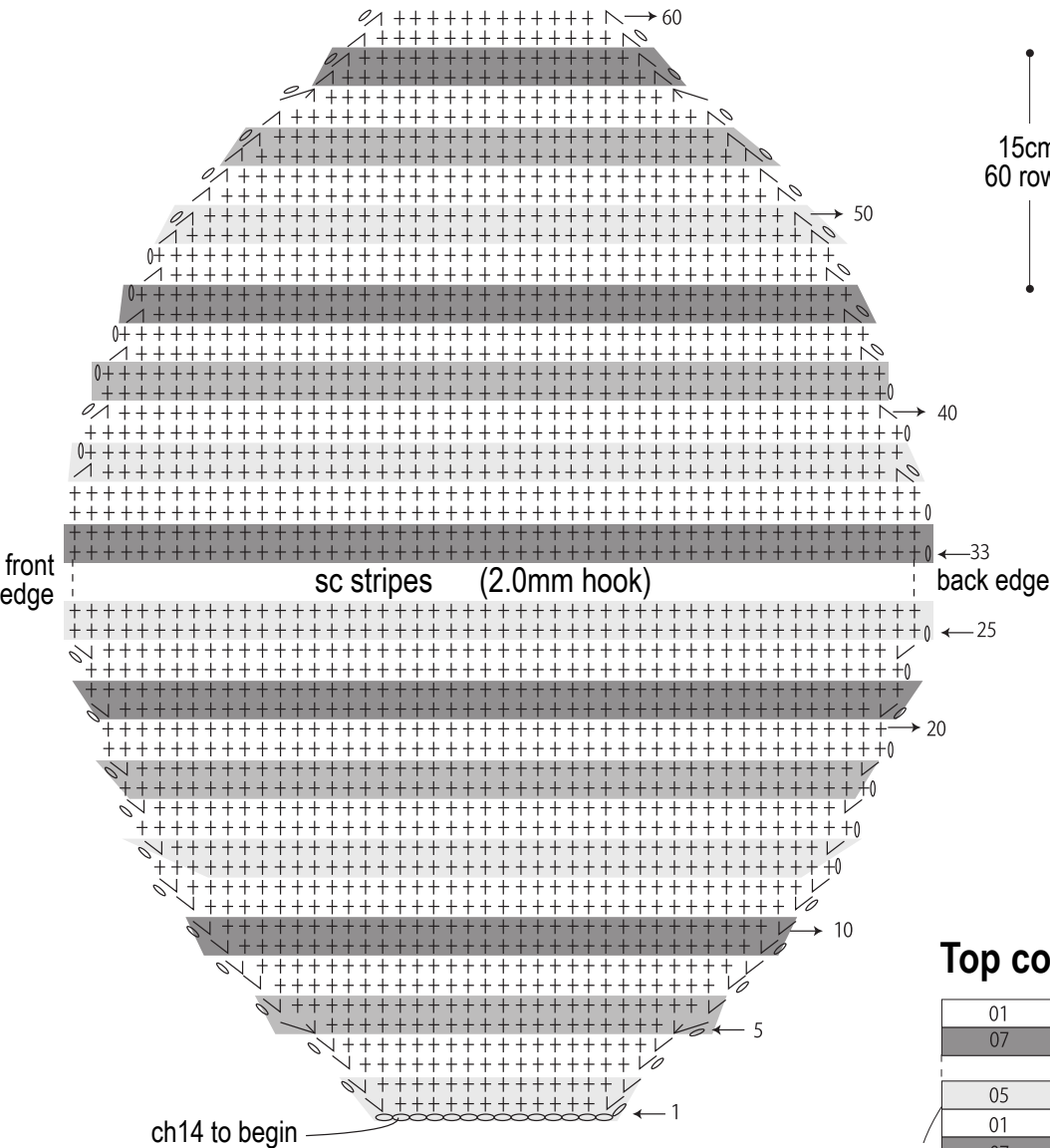

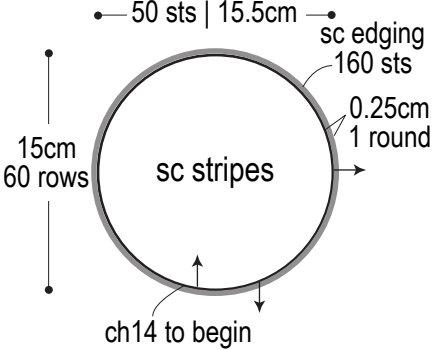

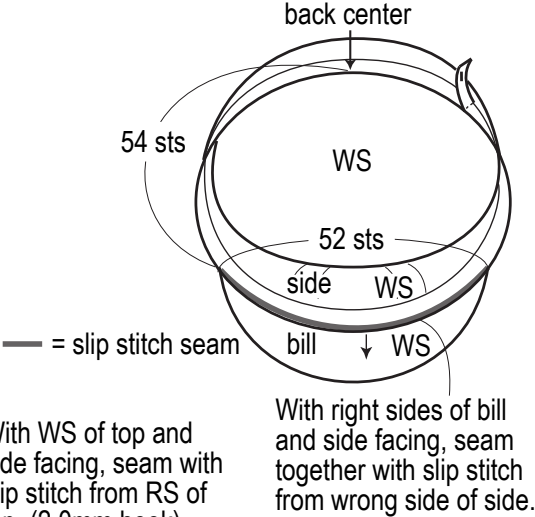

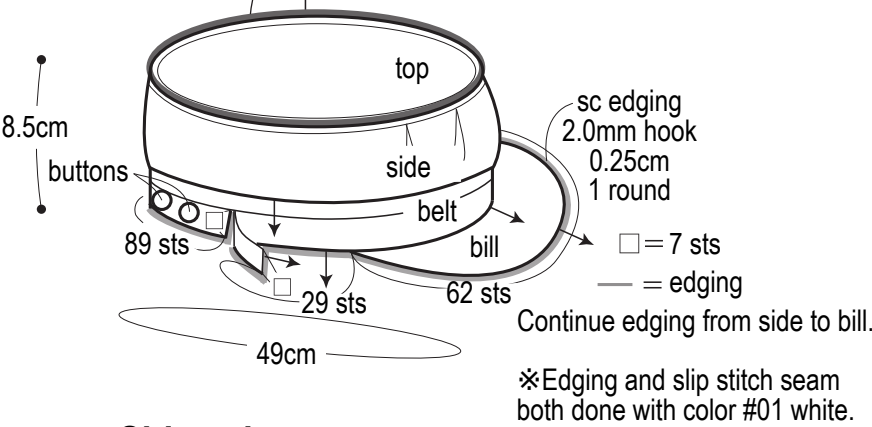
Top (2.0mm hook)
