

212s-6 Tours Tunic



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Tours [100% linen; 115 yds/105m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #02 natural beige, 11 skeins [305g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 94cm/37.01"
- cross back width 33cm/12.99"
- length 80cm/31.50"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 33 sts and 12 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

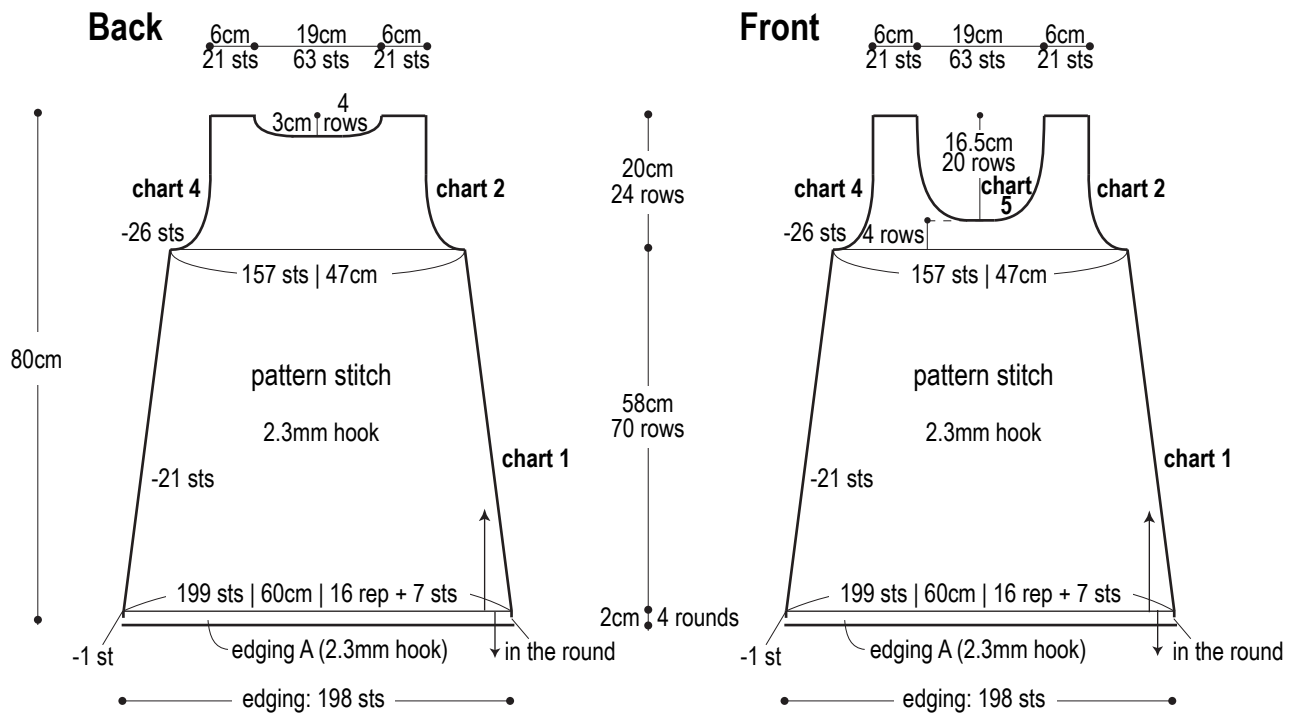
Crochet Tips

Front & back body: Chain to begin, working first row into bottom loops of chain. Work in pattern stitch.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with chain seam (alternation chain stitches and slip stitches as needed). Seam sides with chain seam as well. Work edging A in the round around hem. Work edging B in the round along armholes and neckline.

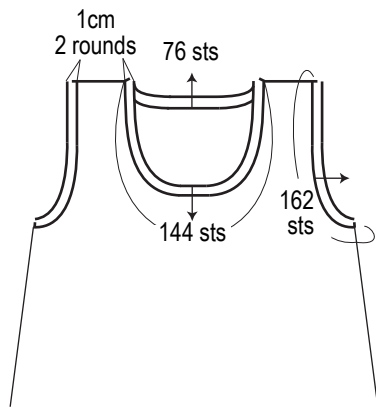
Abbreviations:

ch = chain
dc = double crochet (US)
rep = repeat(s)

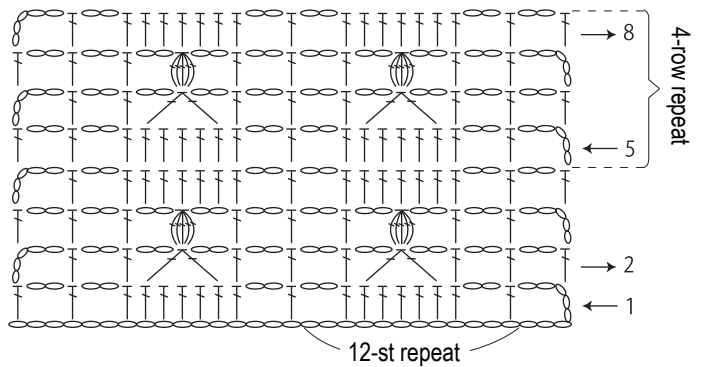


Edging B: armholes & collar

2.3mm hook

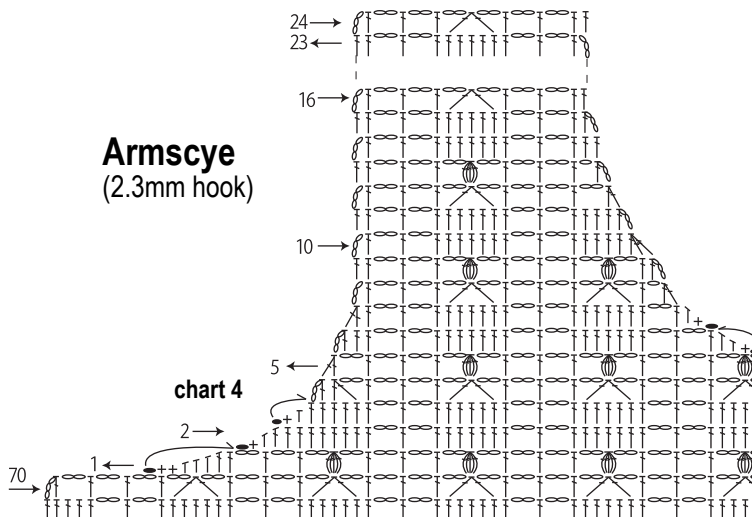


Pattern stitch (2.3mm hook)

Armhole (2.3mm hook)

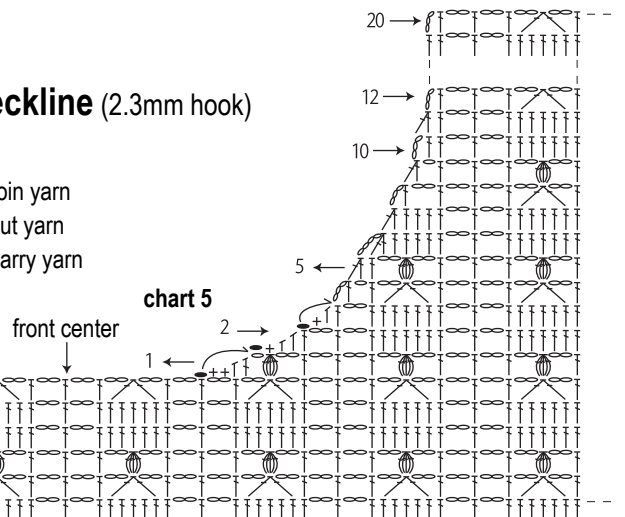


Front neckline (2.3mm hook)

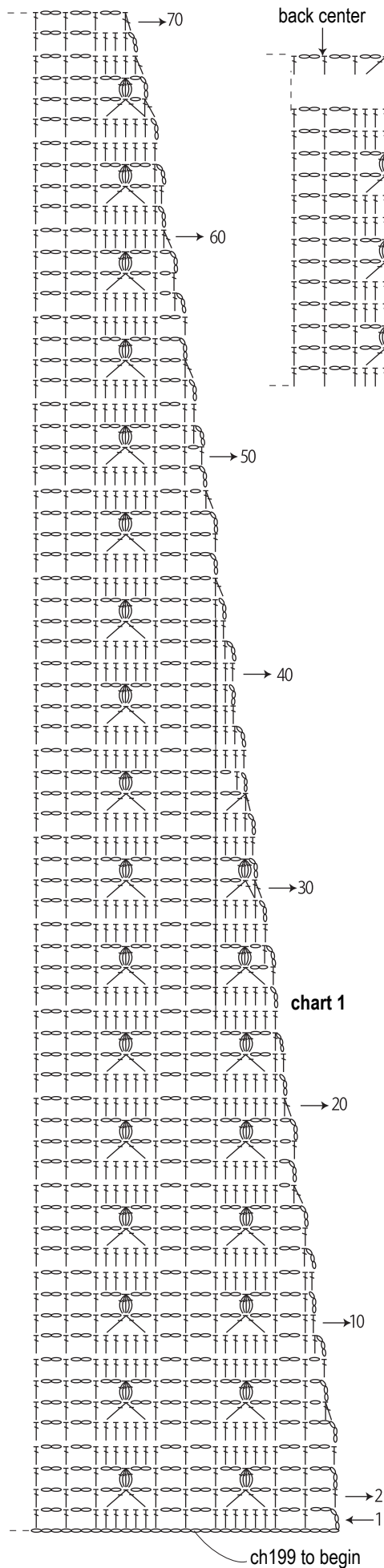
◁ = join yarn

◀ = cut yarn

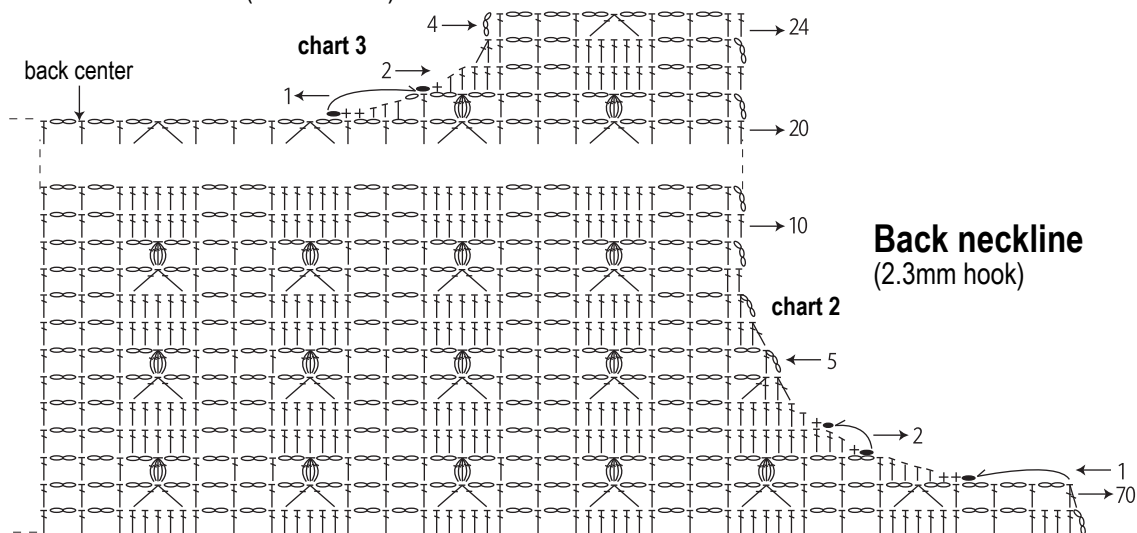
↪ = carry yarn



Side decreases (2.3mm hook)

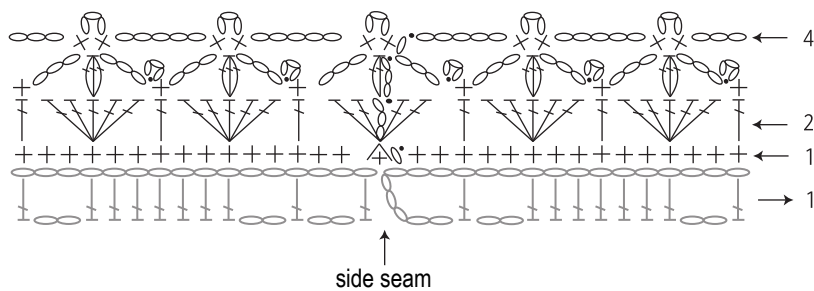


Back neckline (2.3mm hook)

Edging B (2.3mm hook)

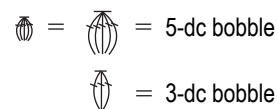
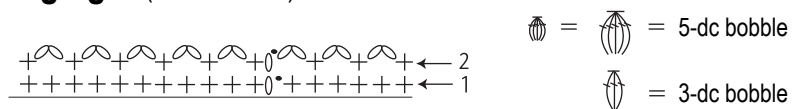
