

212s-3 Cotton Neat Shrug



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Neat S [100% cotton; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #20 limelight, 5 skeins [200g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- center back neck-to-cuff 39.5cm/15.55"
- length 57cm/22.44"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 20 sts and 32 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

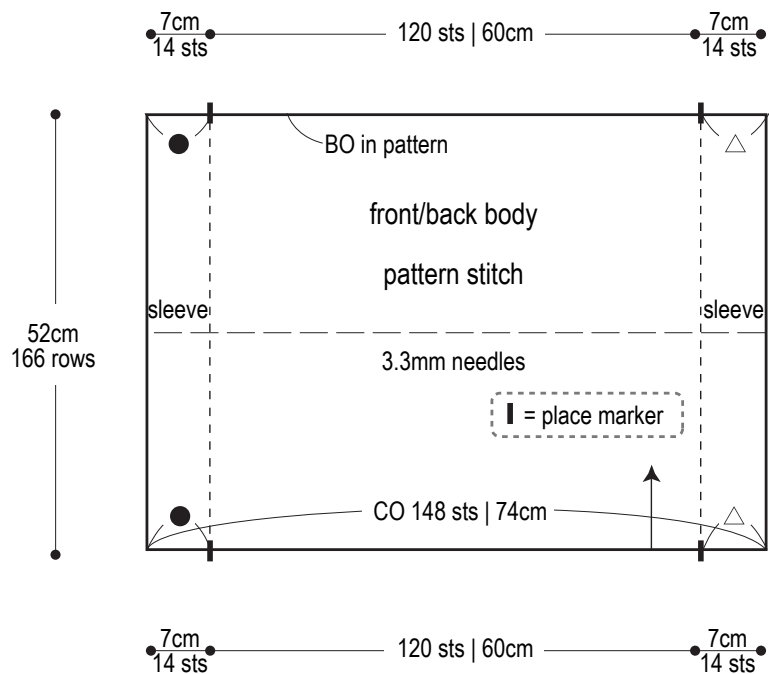
Front & back body; sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work square piece in pattern stitch.

Finishing: With right sides of front, back, and sleeves facing each other, seam together as shown. Seam underarm area with crochet slip stitch seam. Work edging in the round around sleeves and neckline/body.

Abbreviations:

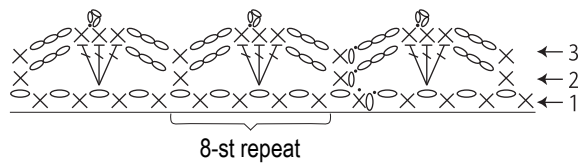
BO = bind off
CO = cast on
rep = repeat(s)

Front & back body; sleeves

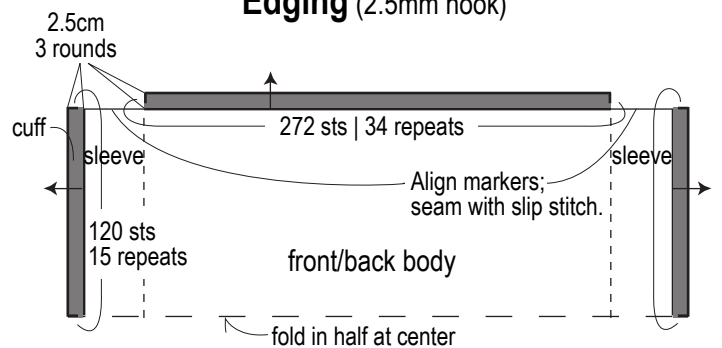


*Seam ● and ● as well as △ and △ with crochet slip stitch seam.

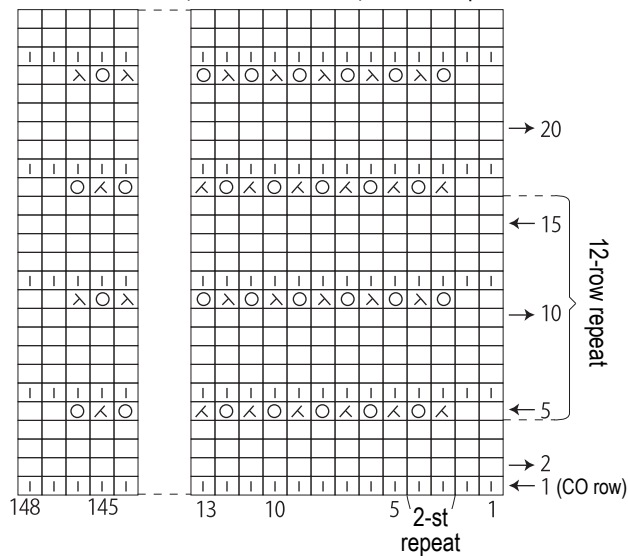
Edging (2.5mm hook)
