

212s-11 Rosetta Striped Beret



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Filati Torre Rosetta [100% cotton; 158 yds/145m per 1.76 oz./50g skein];
 - color #15 smoky blue, 1 skein [50g]
 - color #17 white, 1 skein [50g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- head circumference 54cm/21.26"
- length 23cm/9.06"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 23 sts and 14 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

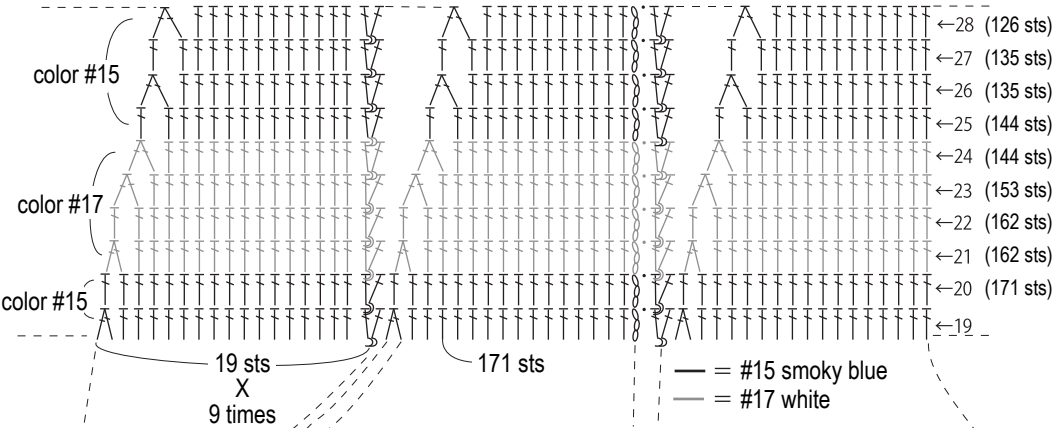
Top & sides: Create magic ring, and work 18 dc into it (including first post). Work through round 18, increasing as indicated. Starting from round 19 until round 28, work decreases as indicated. For entire body of hat, change color every 4 rounds as shown.

Belt: Working into sides, work belt in sc. Embroider anchor onto belt of hat.

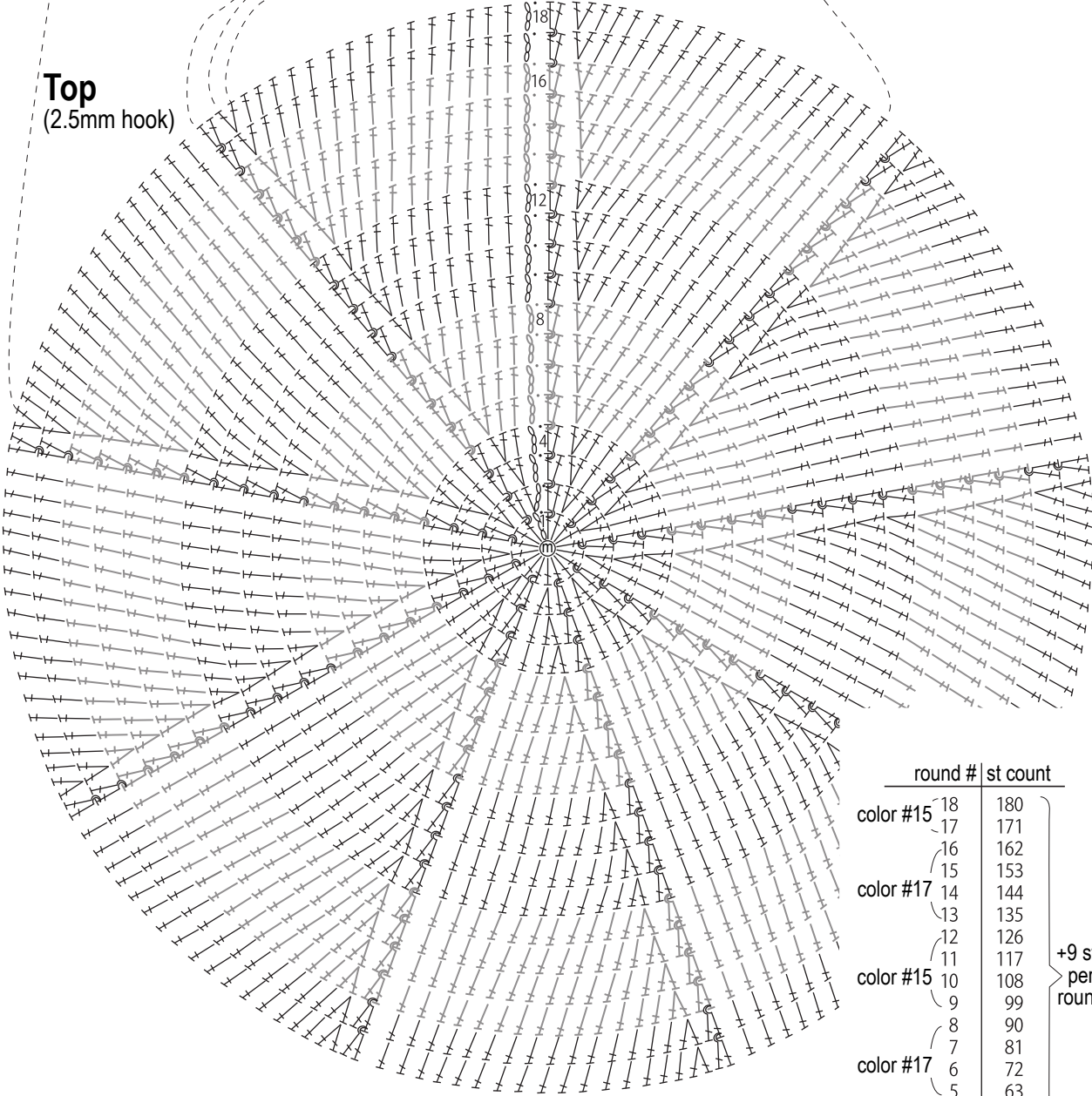
Abbreviations:

dc = double crochet (US)
fpdc = front post double crochet (US)
m = magic ring
sc = single crochet (US)

Top (2.5mm hook)

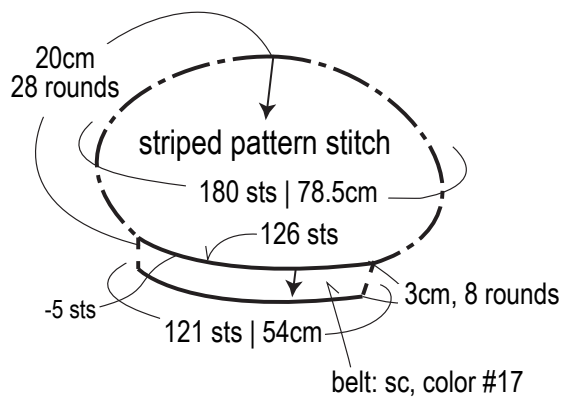

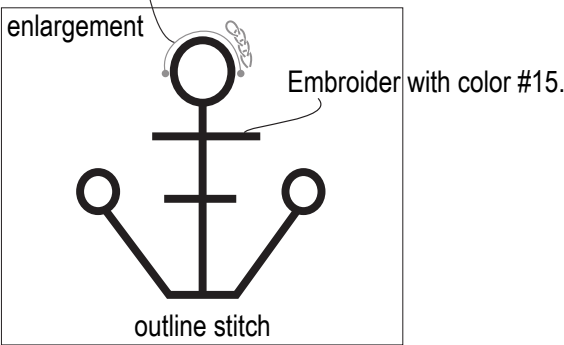
