

211F-4 Seed Stitch Mittens



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Fine Merino [100% extra fine merino; 103 yds/94m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #201 off-white, 2 skeins [45g]
- Pierrot Yarns Cutie Mohair [28% kid mohair, 28% acrylic, 14% superwash wool, 30% nylon; 339 yds/310m per 0.88 oz./25g skein];
 - color #22 sky blue, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #23 pale pink, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #24 light papaya, 1 skein [small amount]
 - color #32 light lime yellow, 1 skein [small amount]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.9mm (approx. US 6) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- embroidery needle

Finished measurements:

- palm circumference 20cm/7.87"
- length 23cm/9.06"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- seed stitch: 22 sts and 38 rows
- k1p1 ribbing: 26 sts and 42 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Mitten: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing and seed stitch in the round. When finished, seam sections marked with ☆ together with Kitchener stitch.

Thumb: Where indicated on palm side of mitten, knit thumb stitches with waste yarn (different than the main yarn). Pick out the waste yarn, and pick up the stitches on double-pointed needles. Work thumb in the round. Decrease on last round. Thread yarn through remaining stitches and cinch shut.

Finishing: Using 2 strands of Cutie Mohair held together, crochet 2 flower motifs. Leaving room for flower petal embroidery, seam 1 motif on the back of each hand. Seam each of the motifs in 6 places. On the back, embroider 2 flowers and their leaves using 8 strands of Cutie Mohair held together.

※Reverse shaping for left mitten.

Abbreviations:

CO = cast on

k2tog = knit two stitches together

m = magic ring

PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

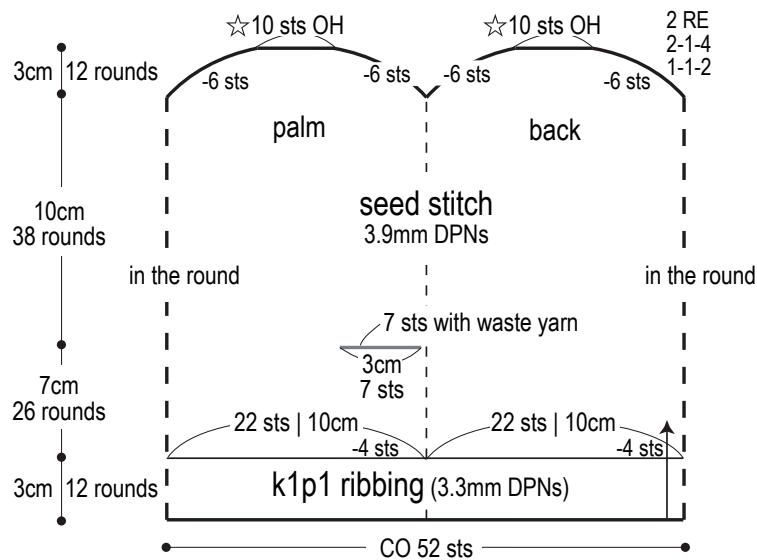
ssk = slip, slip, knit (slip 2 stitches knitwise, knit these 2 stitches together through back loop)

= rows-stitches-times (where # indicates a number; 2-1-3 means "every 2 rows/rounds, decrease 1 stitch; 3 times")

= rows-stitches-places-times (for example, 27-1-8-1 means "every 27 rows/rounds, decrease 1 stitch in 8 places evenly spaced across; do this 1 time total")

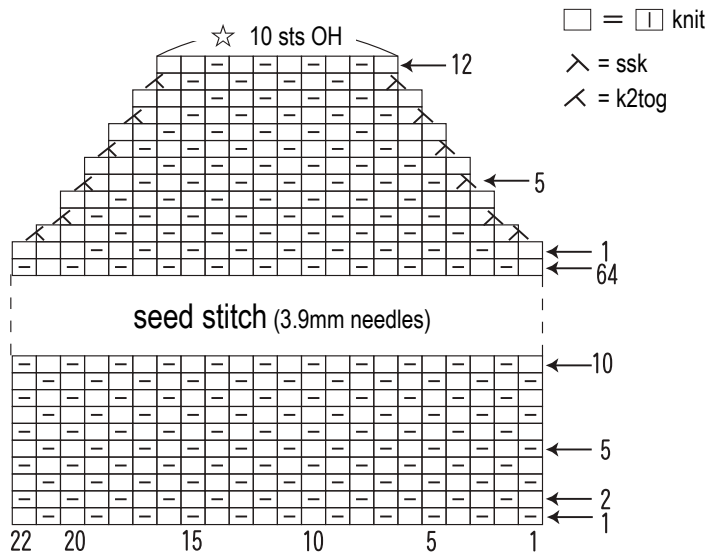

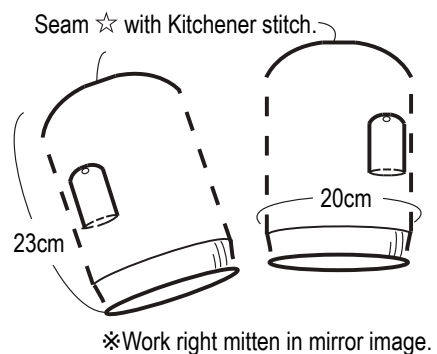

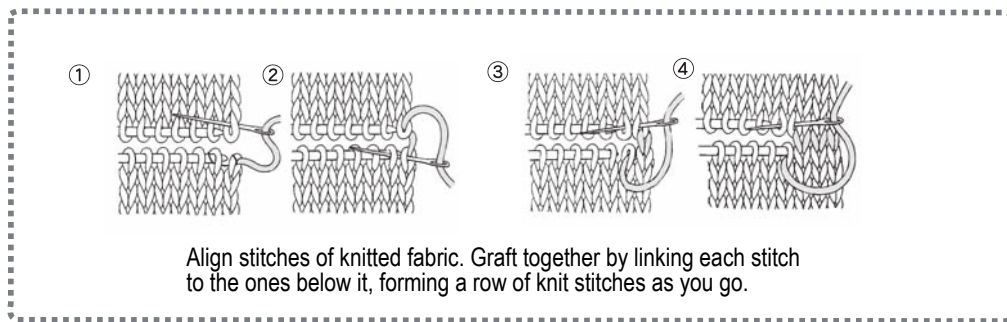


Thumb

(3.9mm DPNs)



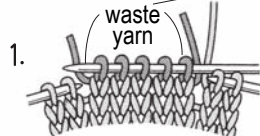
Kitchener stitch



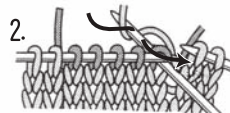
Thumb instructions (reference example)

Using waste yarn

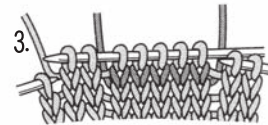
Note: the actual number of stitches to be worked in the pattern may differ from this example.



1. On palm side, knit thumb sts with waste yarn rather than main yarn.

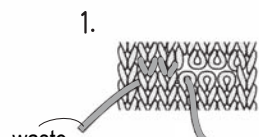


2. Return the sts knit with waste yarn to left needle. Knit across with main yarn.



3. Continue on with knitting.

Pick up stitches for thumb



1. Remove waste yarn; pick up live stitches.



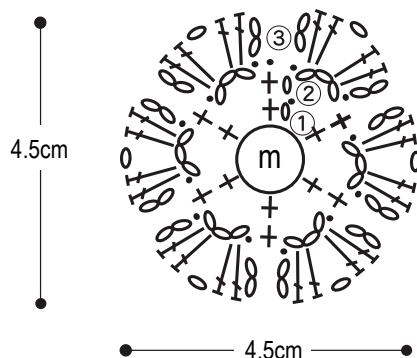
2. Work lifted increase here only. where to pick up stitches



3. Only this st was increased. Pick up stitches using the main yarn.

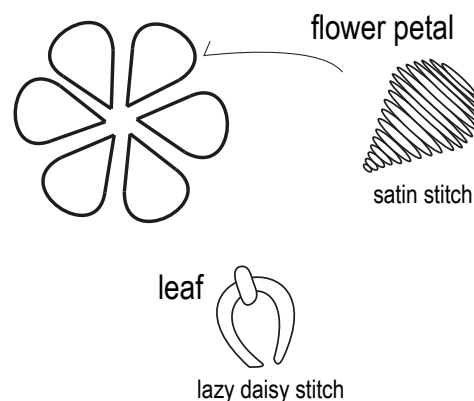
Motif instructions (2.5mm hook)

- ② Embroider leaves with lazy daisy stitch.
