

212-638bag Playa Purse



Suggested yarn:

- Oso Blanco Playa [48% cotton, 32% nylon, 20% acrylic; 109 yds/100m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #08 black, 6 skeins [285g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 1 pair bamboo purse handles (13cm/5.12" diameter)

Finished measurements:

- width 40cm/15.75"
- depth 27cm/10.63"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 19 sts and 16 rows
- single crochet (US): 20 sts and 22 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Body: Chain to begin, working into bottom loops of chain. Work in pattern stitch.

Sides: Working stitches into sides of body, work sides in single crochet (US).

Mouth: Working 5 stitches into end of side stitches and other stitches into side of body, work mouth edging in sc.

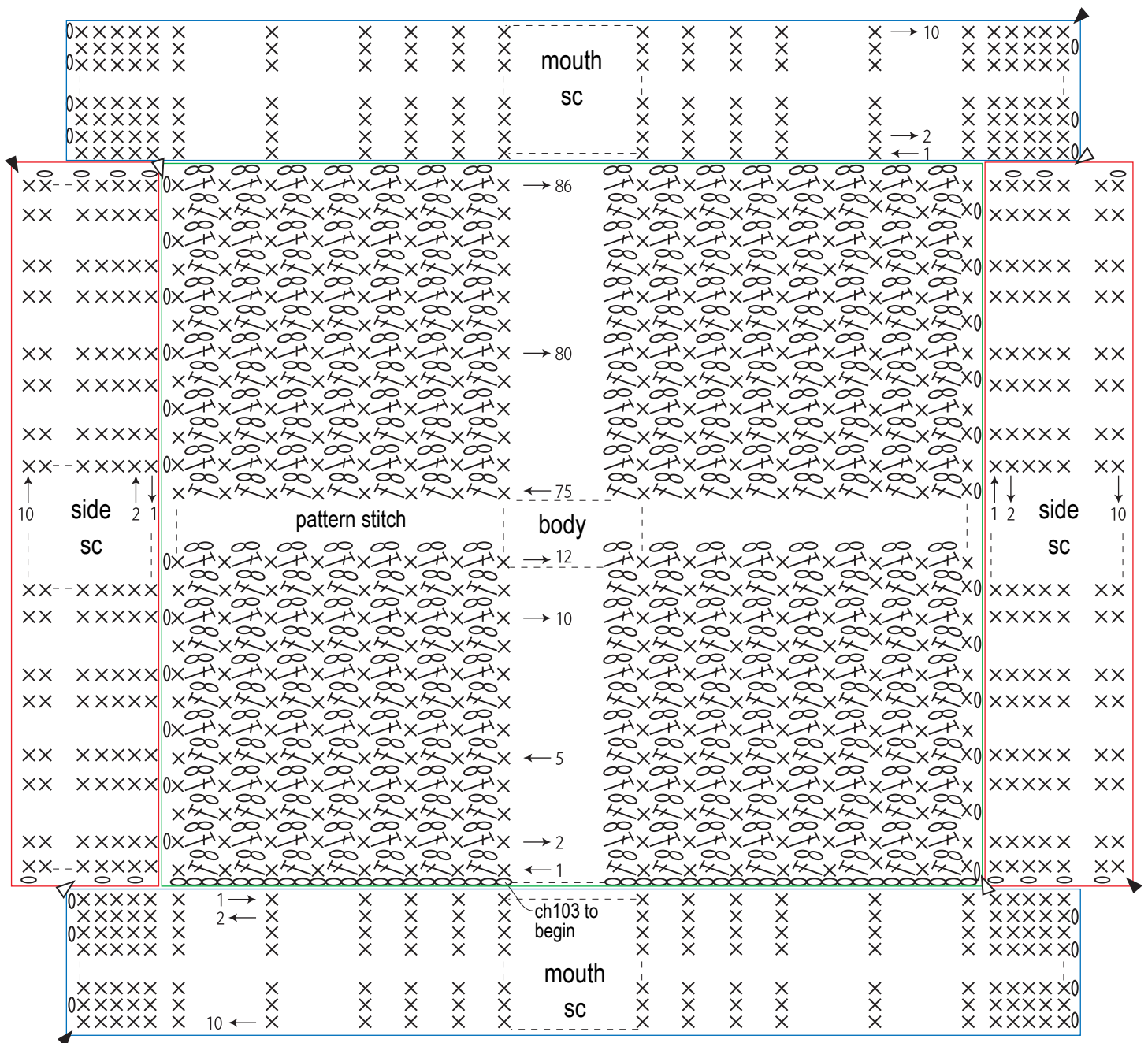
Finishing: Fold side edging to inside of body; whipstitch in place. Wrap mouth edging around handle, folding to inside of bag, and whipstitch in place.

Abbreviations:

ch = chain

sc = single crochet (US)

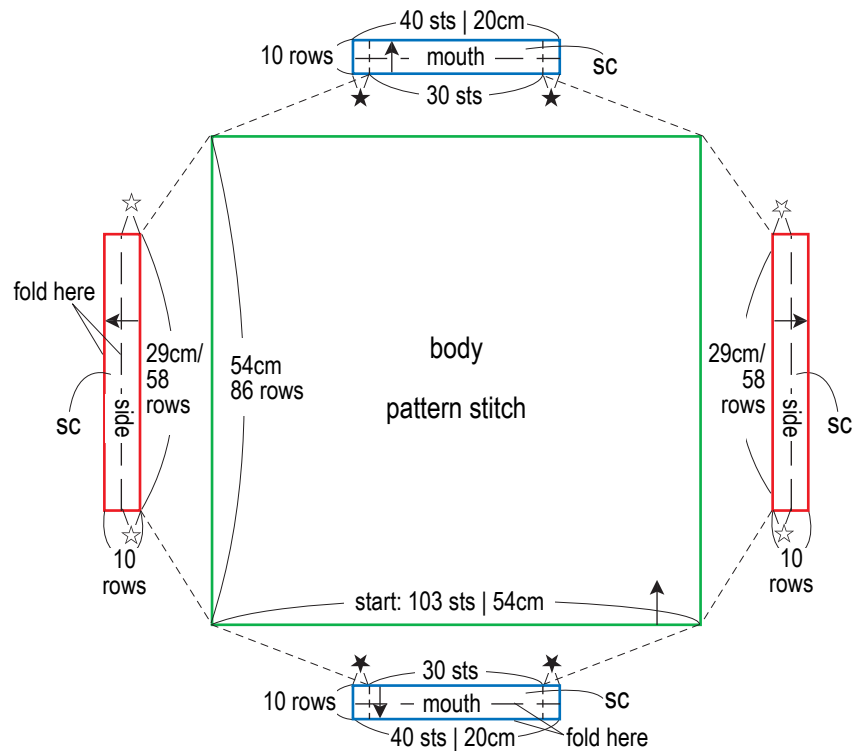
Bag instructions (3.5mm hook)



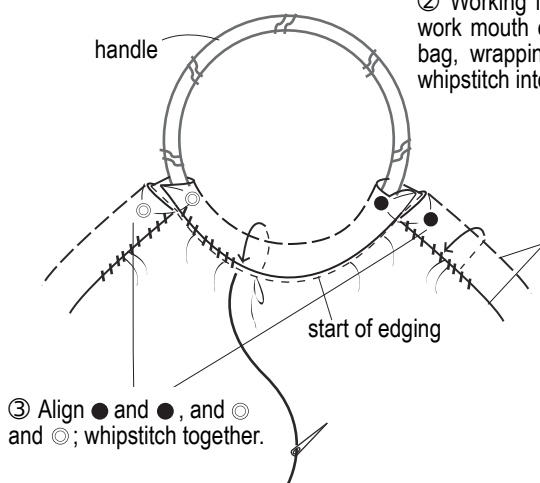
◀ = cut yarn

Finishing

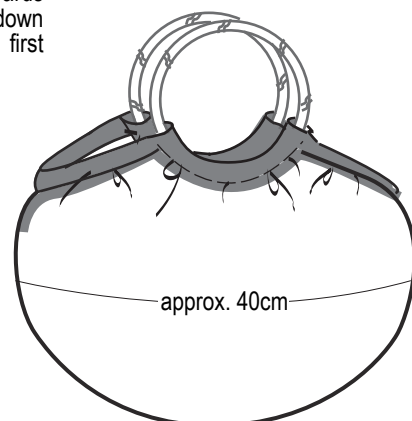


② Working into stitches along side of body and side edges, work mouth edging in sc for 10 rows. Fold towards inside of bag, wrapping around handle. Then tack down by working whipstitch into first row of sc.

① Working into stitches along side of body, work side edging in sc for 10 rows. Fold towards inside of bag, then tack down by working whipstitch into first row of sc.

③ Align ● and ●, and ○ and ○; whipstitch together.
