

Felicia Sleeveless Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Felicia [58% linen, 16% cotton, 26% viscose; 164 yds/150m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #01 pearl white, 4 skeins [185g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) straight knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 88cm/34.65"
- cross back width 34cm/13.39"
- length 57cm/22.44"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 23 sts and 33 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Front & back body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in garter stitch, then stockinette stitch. After working 190 rows (including the garter stitch section) on the front piece, work evenly spaced increases across neckline area. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Align shoulders with ☆ and ☆, and ★ and ★; seam with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline and armholes; work edging in garter stitch in the round. Bind off collar loosely in pattern.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

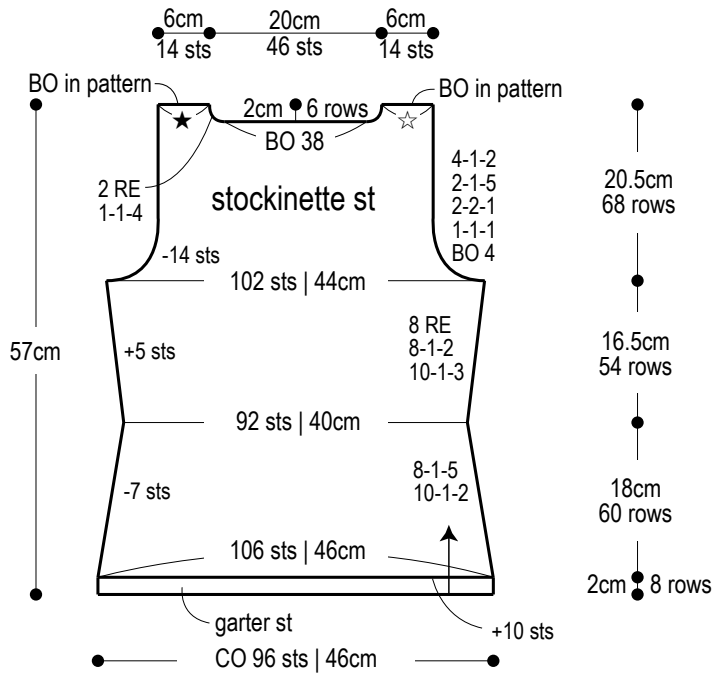
inc = increase

PU = pick up

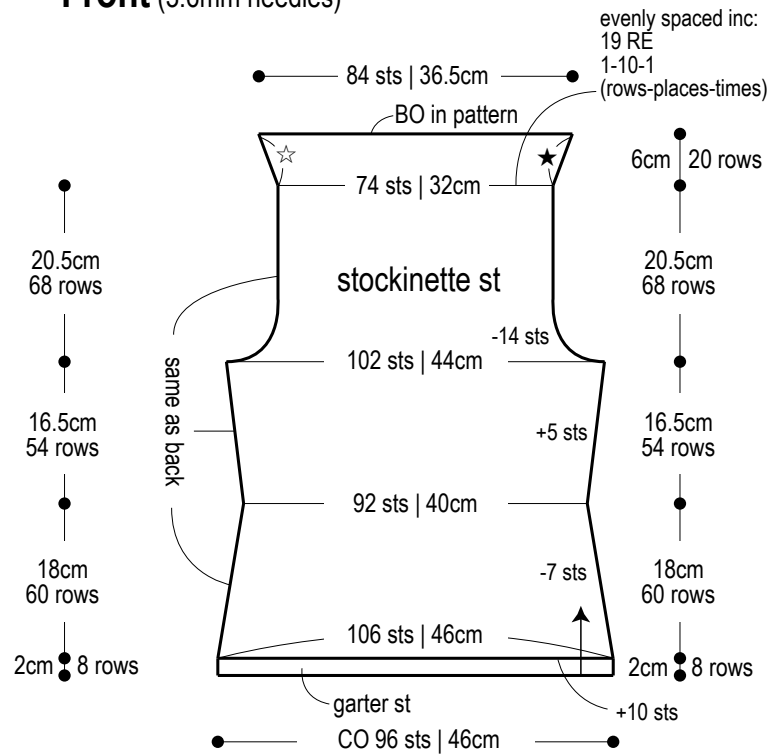
RE = row(s) even

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times (for example, 2-1-5 means "every 2 rows, increase/decrease 1 stitch; repeat 5 times in total")

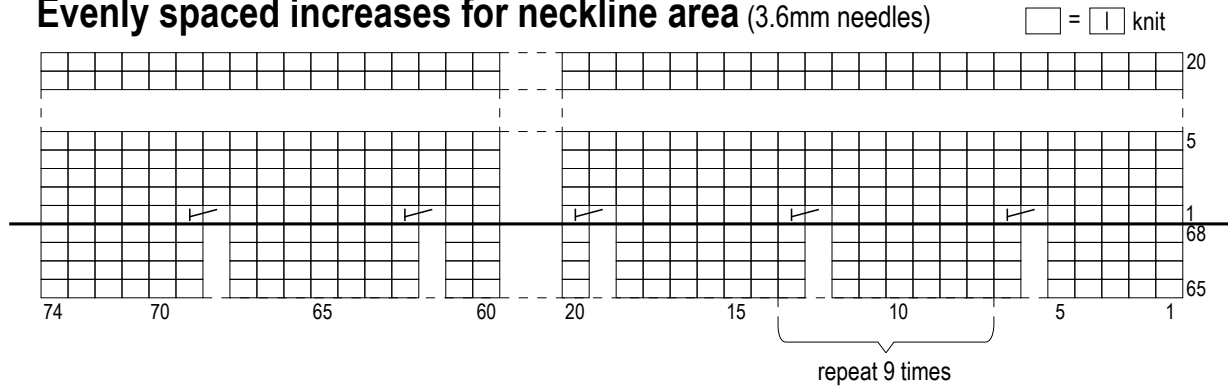
Back (3.6mm needles)
