

211F-12 Basic Bulky Mittens



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Basic Bulky [100% merino wool; 49 yds/45m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #1 ivory, 2 skeins [50g]
 - color #7 smoky Chinese green, 1 skein [30g]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.0mm (US 10) and 6.6mm (approx. US 10½) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

- palm circumference 19cm/7.48"
- length 24cm/9.45"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 13 sts and 19 rows
- pattern stitch: 17 sts and 19 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work k1p1 ribbing in the round. Continue, changing needle size and yarn color. Work palm side in stockinette stitch, and work back of hand side in pattern stitch. On palm side, work stitches where thumb will be in waste yarn. Bind off by grafting sections marked with ☆ with Kitchener stitch.

Thumb: Pick up live stitches from waste yarn. Work thumb in stockinette stitch in the round. Decrease on final round, then thread yarn through remaining stitches and cinch thumb shut.

※Reverse shaping of right mitten for left mitten.

Abbreviations:

CO = cast on

OH = on hold (i.e., place live stitches on stitch holder)

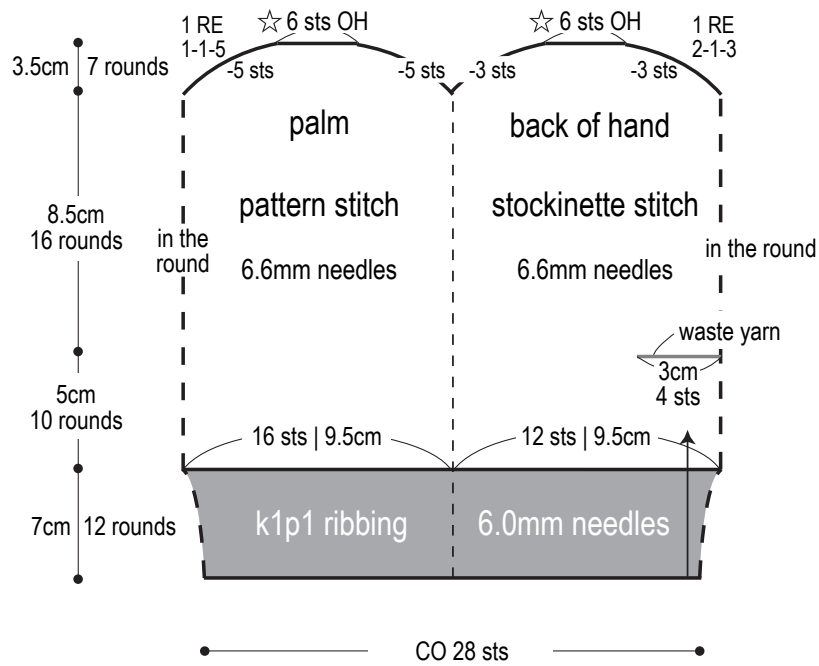
PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

= rows-stitches-times

Right mitten

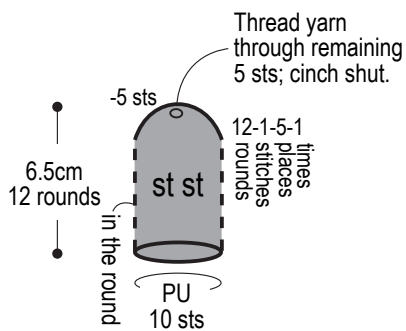
6.0mm & 6.6mm DPNs

Thumb

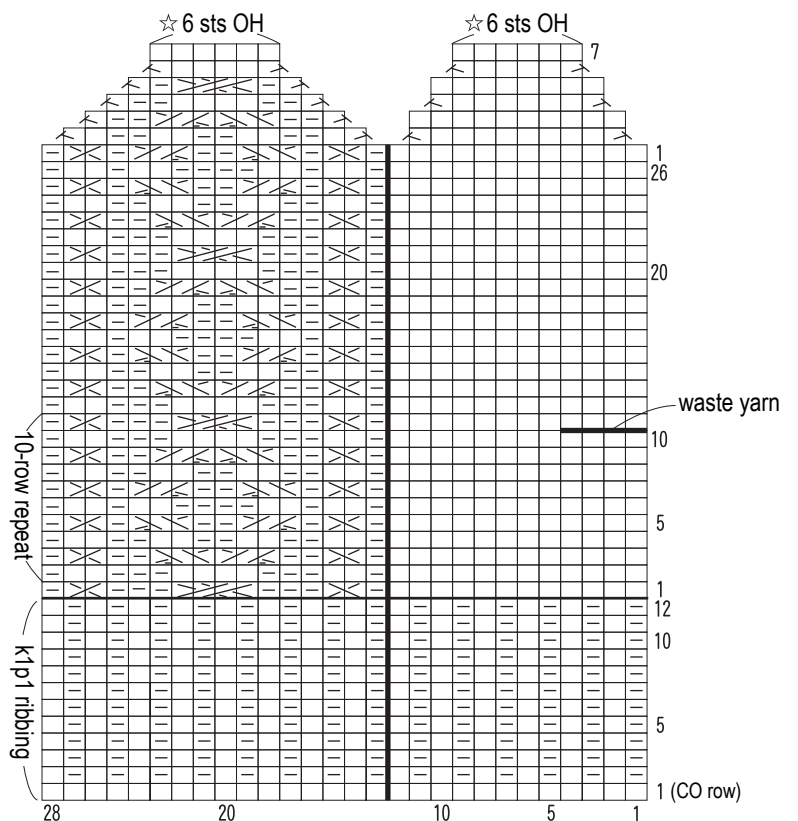


Stitch patterns

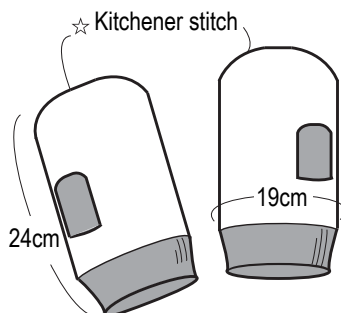
stockinette st/pattern stitch: 6.6mm DPNs
