

212fw-05 Fontaine Tunic



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Fontaine [80% wool, 20% baby alpaca; 103 yds/94m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #08 teal green, 10 skeins [400g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) and 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- length 76cm/29.92"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 22.5 sts and 13 rows
- pattern stitch B (2.5mm hook): 5.5 chain spaces and 9 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Yoke: Chain to begin, working first round into bottom loops of chain. Work from the neckline down in pattern stitch A in the round, increasing as indicated.

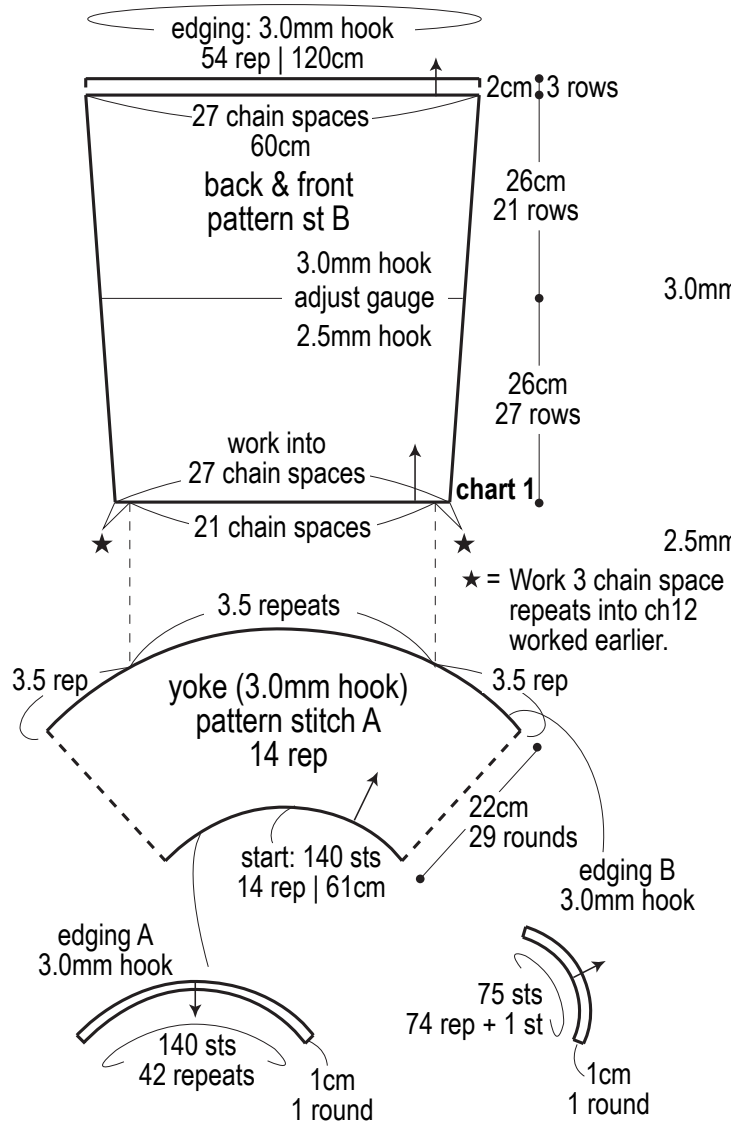
Back & front body: Make 4 separate chains (each ch12 in length) and save for later. When continuing down from yoke to body, work into stitches along bottom of yoke and into the chains made earlier (for underarm area). Work body in pattern stitch B. (Adjust gauge where shown by changing hook size - refer to pattern stitch B chart for instructions.)

Finishing: Seam sides of body with chain seam (alternating ch and sc stitches as needed to maintain pattern). Work edging A around neckline. Work edging B around armholes. Work edging C around hem. Make cord by working slip stitch through back loops only. Thread cord through body and tie in a knot at the front center, cinching in as desired.

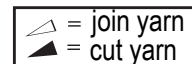
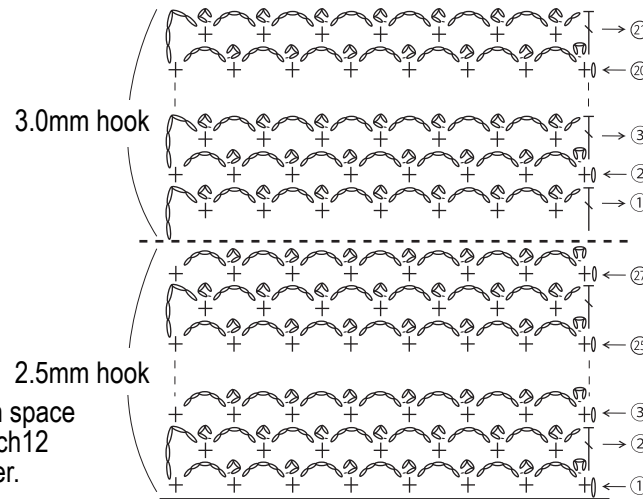
Abbreviations:

Back & front

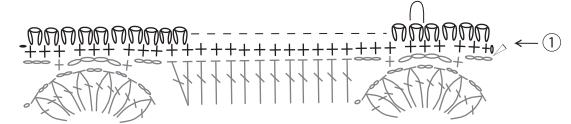


Pattern stitch B



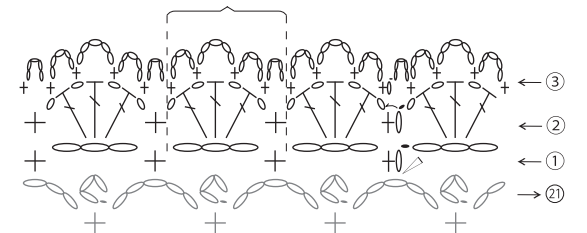
Edging B (3.0mm hook)

(sc + ch3)

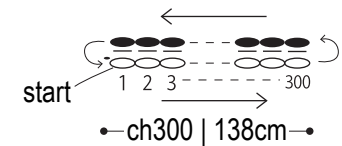


Edging C (3.0mm hook)

1 repeat



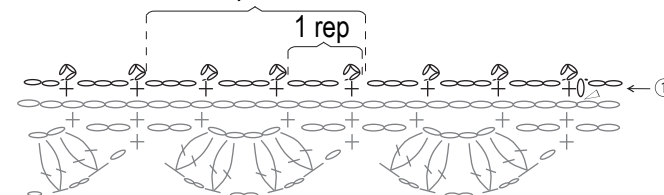
Cord (2.5mm hook)



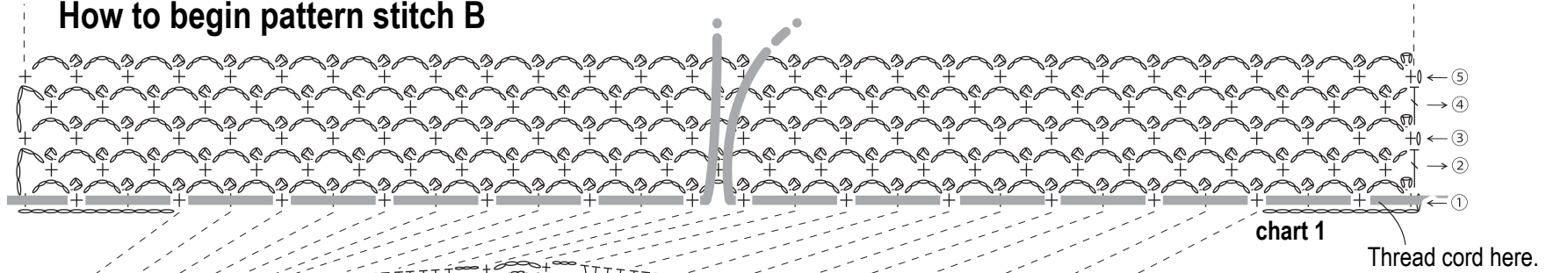
● = slip stitch into back loop only

These will be used for underarm area.
