

212fw-20 Cap-sleeve Tunic



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino Fingering [100% merino wool; 183 yds/167m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #15 purple, 8 skeins [300g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C), 3.0mm (approx. US C or D), and 3.5mm (US E) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- cross back width 36cm/14.17"
- length 72cm/28.35"
- sleeve length 10.5cm/4.13"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A (2.5mm hook): 30 sts and 12 rows
- pattern stitch B (2.5mm hook): 28 sts and 14 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Back & front body: Chain to begin, working first row into bottom loops of chain. Work in pattern stitch A and B. In "skirt" section, alter the gauge of pattern stitch B by changing hook size when indicated.

Sleeves: Chain to begin, working first row into bottom loops of chain. Work in pattern stitch A.

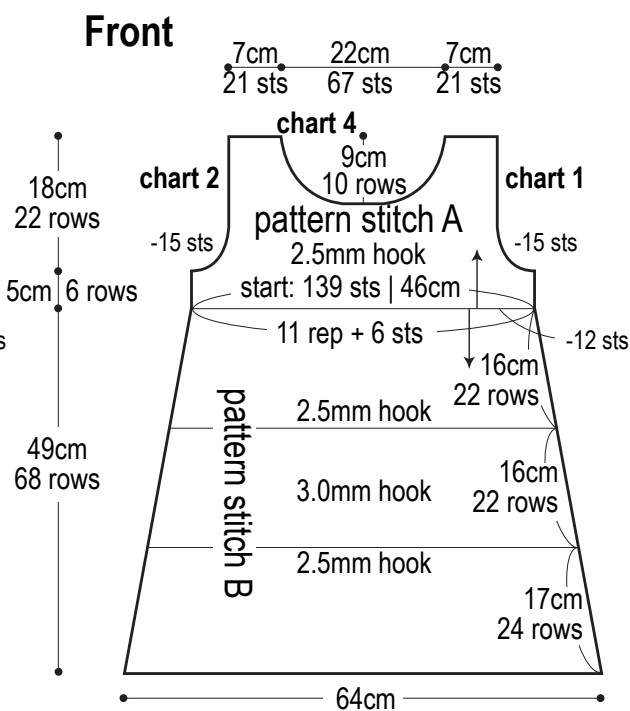
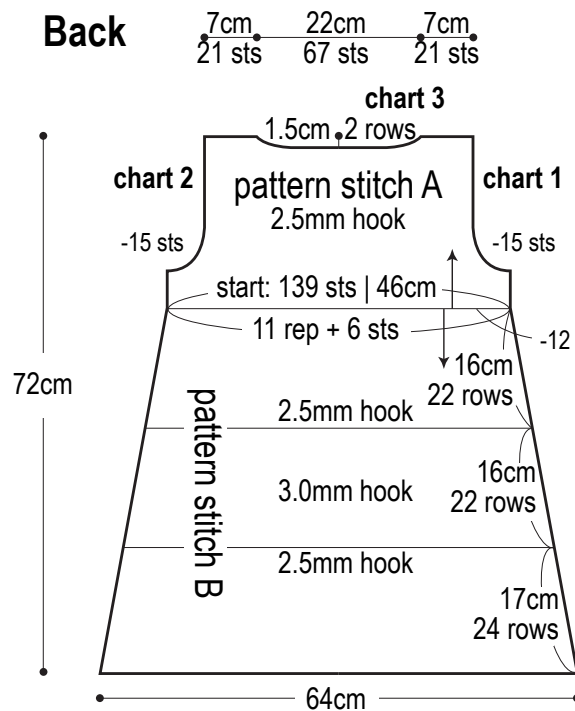
Finishing: Seam shoulders with slip stitch seam. Seam sides with chain seam (alternating ch and slip stitch as needed to maintain pattern). Seam sleeves to body with slip stitch. Referring to diagram, work edging at cuffs, armscye, and neckline in the round.

Abbreviations:

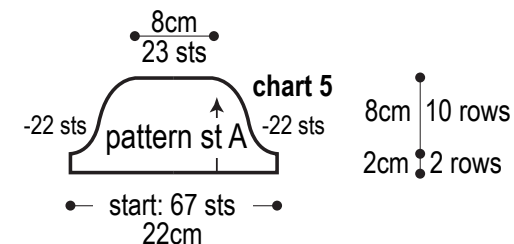
ch = chain

rep = repeat(s)

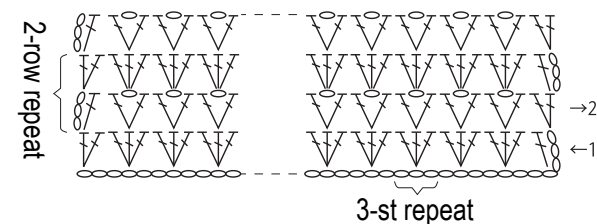
sc = single crochet (US)



Sleeve (2.5mm hook)



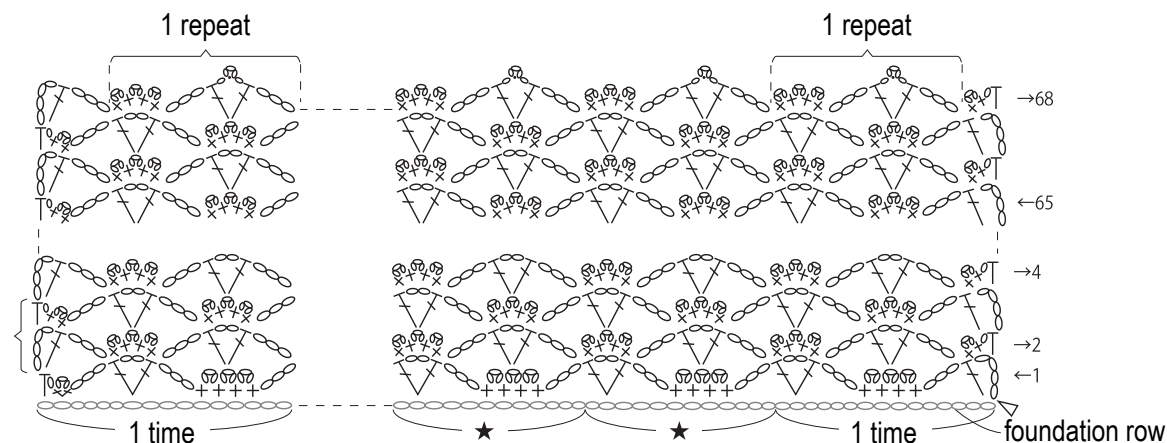
Pattern stitch A (2.5mm hook)



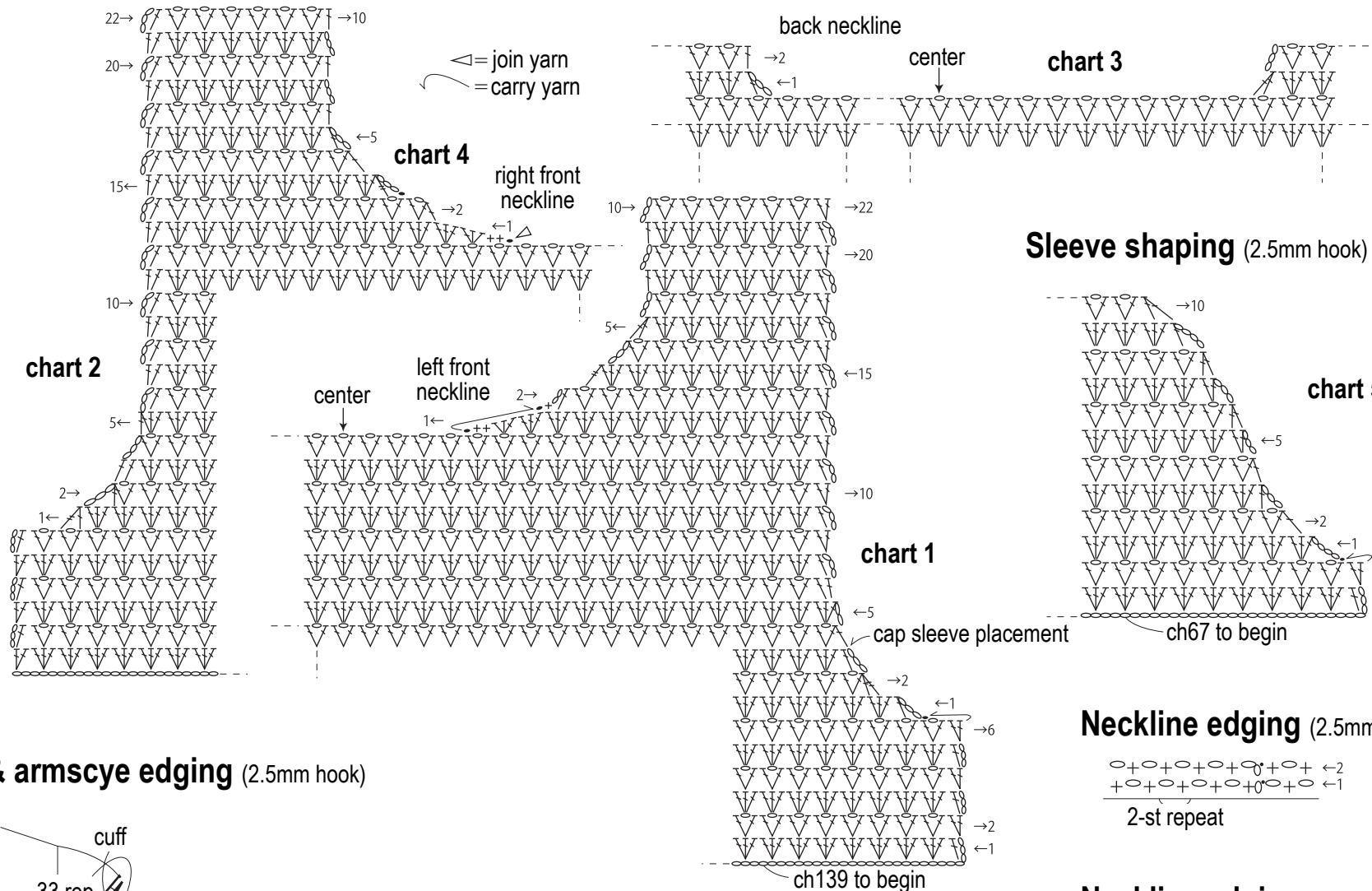
Pattern stitch B

Adjust gauge by changing hook size where indicated.

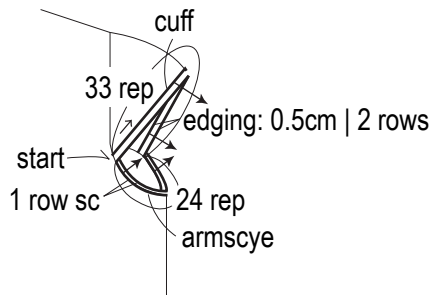
★ = repeat 9 times



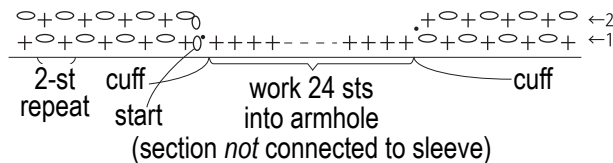
Armscye & neckline instructions (2.5mm hook)



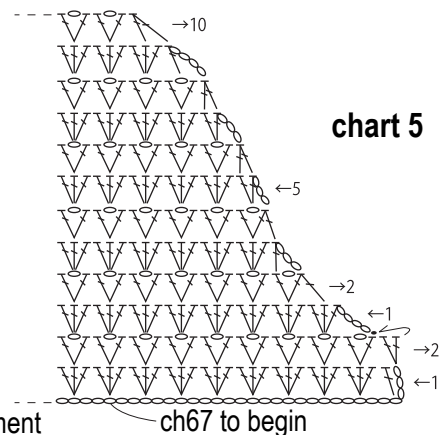
Cuffs & armscye edging (2.5mm hook)



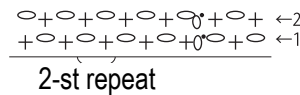
Cuffs & armscye edging (2.5mm hook)
