

212fw-35 Orange Baby Knit Cap & Mittens



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Orange [100% merino wool; 175 yds/160m per 1.76 oz./50g skein];
 - cap: color #03 red/blue/yellow/green, 1 skein [45g]
 - mittens: color #03 red/blue/yellow/green, 1 skein [15g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.6mm (approx. US 4) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

- cap: head circumference 40cm/15.75"
- cap: length 17.5cm/6.89"
- mittens: palm circumference 13cm/5.12"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 26 sts and 29 rows
- pattern stitch B: 29 sts and 31 rows
- stockinette stitch: 24.5 sts and 31 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Cap: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work k1p1 ribbing in the round, followed by pattern stitch A. Work decreases on last three rounds. Thread yarn through remaining stitches on last round; cinch shut. Seam pompom to top of cap.

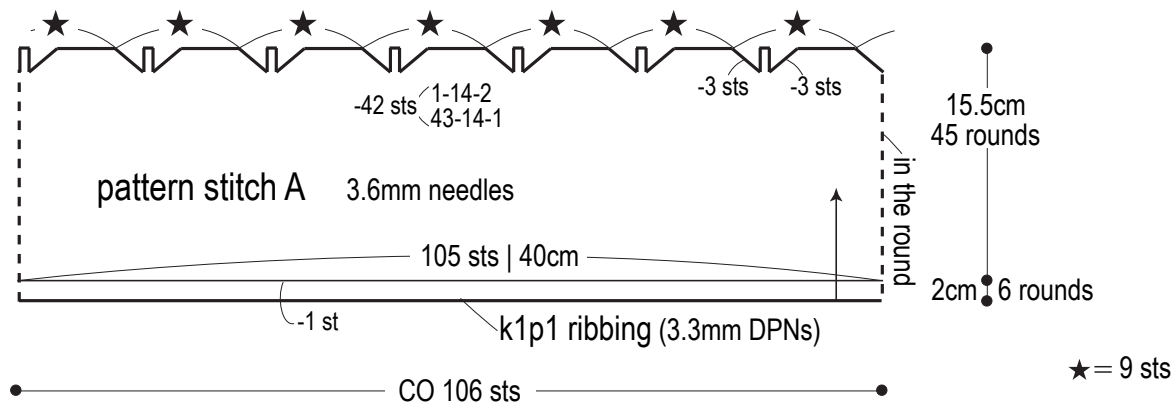
Mittens: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work k1p1 ribbing in the round. Continue body of hand in the round, working the back of the pattern in pattern stitch B and the palm of the hand in stockinette stitch. Work thumbhole stitches on palm side with waste yarn. When finished, seam ☆ and ☆ with Kitchener stitch. Work thumb as follows: remove waste yarn and pick up live stitches. Work thumb in stockinette stitch in the round. Decrease on last round. Thread yarn through remaining stitches on last round; cinch shut. Crochet cord; seam to inside of each mitten.

※Note: reverse shaping for second mitten. However, do not reverse the stitch pattern (such as the direction of the cable crossings).

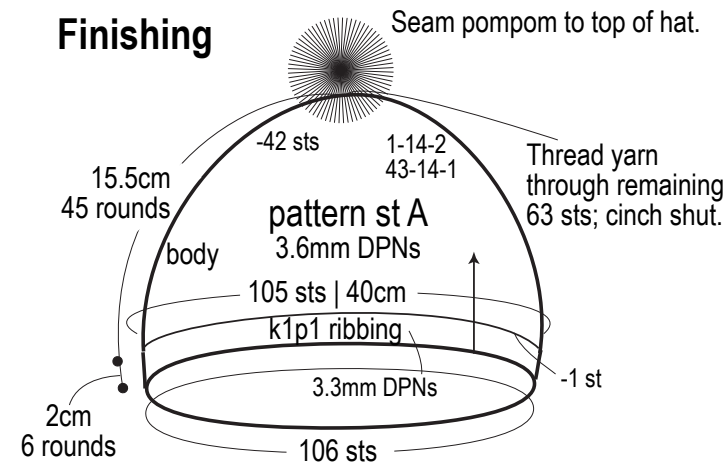
Abbreviations:

ch = chain CO = cast on OH = on hold (that is, place on stitch holder) PU = pick up RE = round(s) even #-#-# = rounds-stitches-times

Knit cap pattern stitches

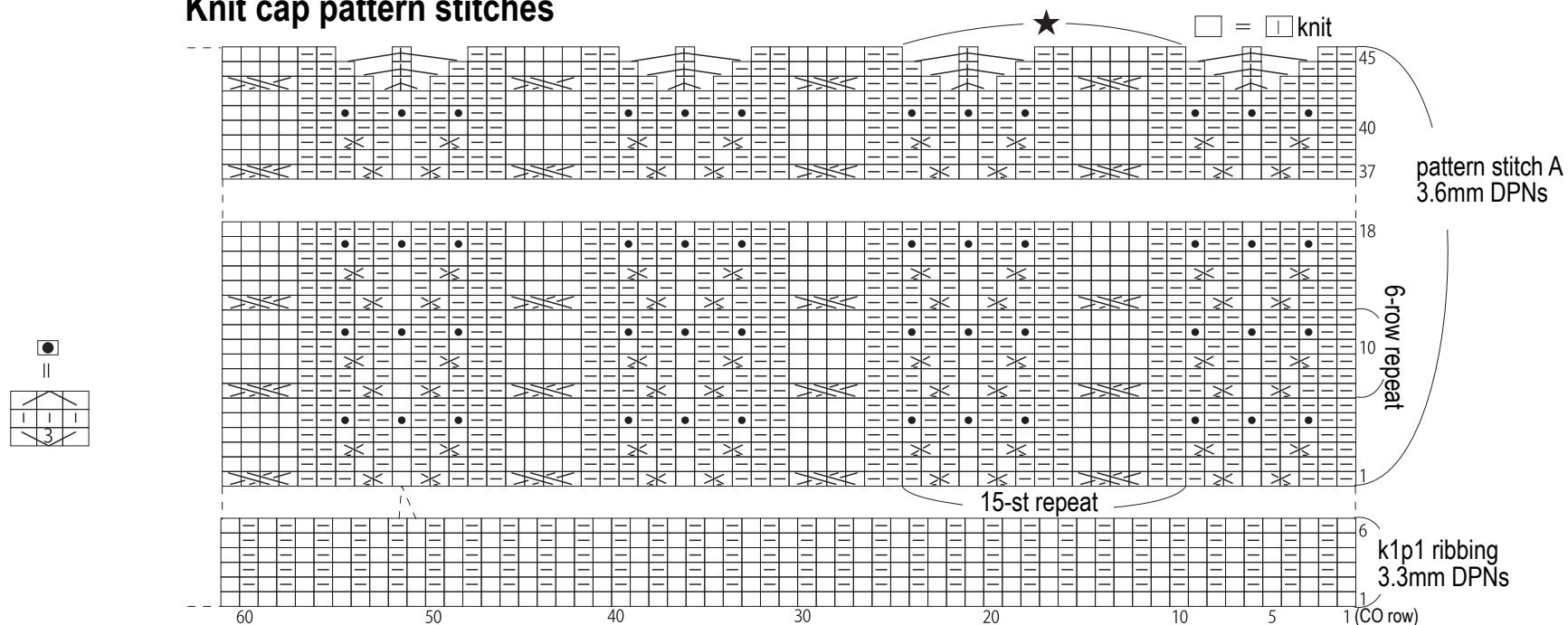


Diagram illustrating the layout of the right hand for a mitten, showing the placement of stitches and rounds.

Stitch Counts and Rounds:

- 1.5cm | 5 rounds
- 6.5cm | 20 rounds
- 2cm | 6 rounds

Stitch Patterns and Dimensions:

- 5 sts (5 stitches)
- 6 OH (6 stitches)
- 5 sts (5 stitches)
- 6 sts (6 stitches)
- 1 st (1 stitch)
- 6 OH (6 stitches)
- 6 sts (6 stitches)

Stitch Patterns:

- stockinette st
- pattern stitch B

Needles: 3.6mm needles

Waste Yarn: 5 sts on waste yarn

Thumb Garter: 2cm | 5 sts

Cuff: 16 sts | 6.5cm | 19 sts | 6.5cm | 3 sts

Knitting: k1p1 ribbing (3.3mm DPNs)

Total Width: CO 32 sts

Legend: ◎ = 2.5cm 8 rounds

Note: *Reverse shaping for left mitten.

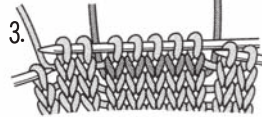
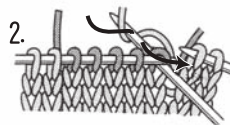
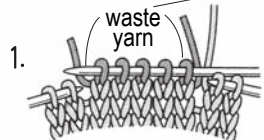

Pick up stitches for thumb

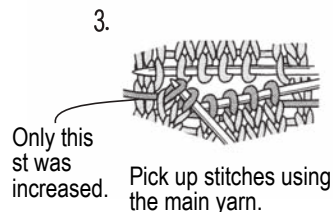
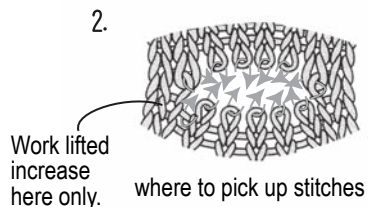
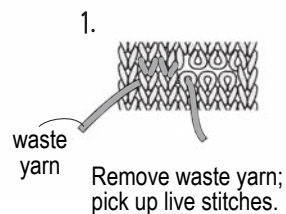


Diagram illustrating the construction of the mittens. The mittens are shown with a central cord. Key features and measurements include:
