

212w-01 Fontaine Hooded Jacket



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Fontaine [80% wool, 20% baby alpaca; 103 yds/94m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #07 brick, 18 skeins [690g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) and 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3 buttons (45mm/1.77" diameter)

Finished measurements:

- center back neck-to-cuff 71.5cm/28.15"
- length 70cm/27.56"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 26 sts and 29.5 rows
- pattern stitch B: 22.5 sts and 29.5 rows
- stockinette stitch: 19 sts and 27 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Back body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Starting from cuff, work in k2p2 ribbing, then change needles and work in pattern stitches A and B. Shape bottom part of right sleeve with backwards loop cast-on increase method. Then begin working right side of body by picking up stitches from a 35-stitch crochet chain worked in advance for this purpose. Shape left side by binding off stitches where indicated, and shape left sleeve by working decreases as indicated. Change needle size for cuff; work in k2p2 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

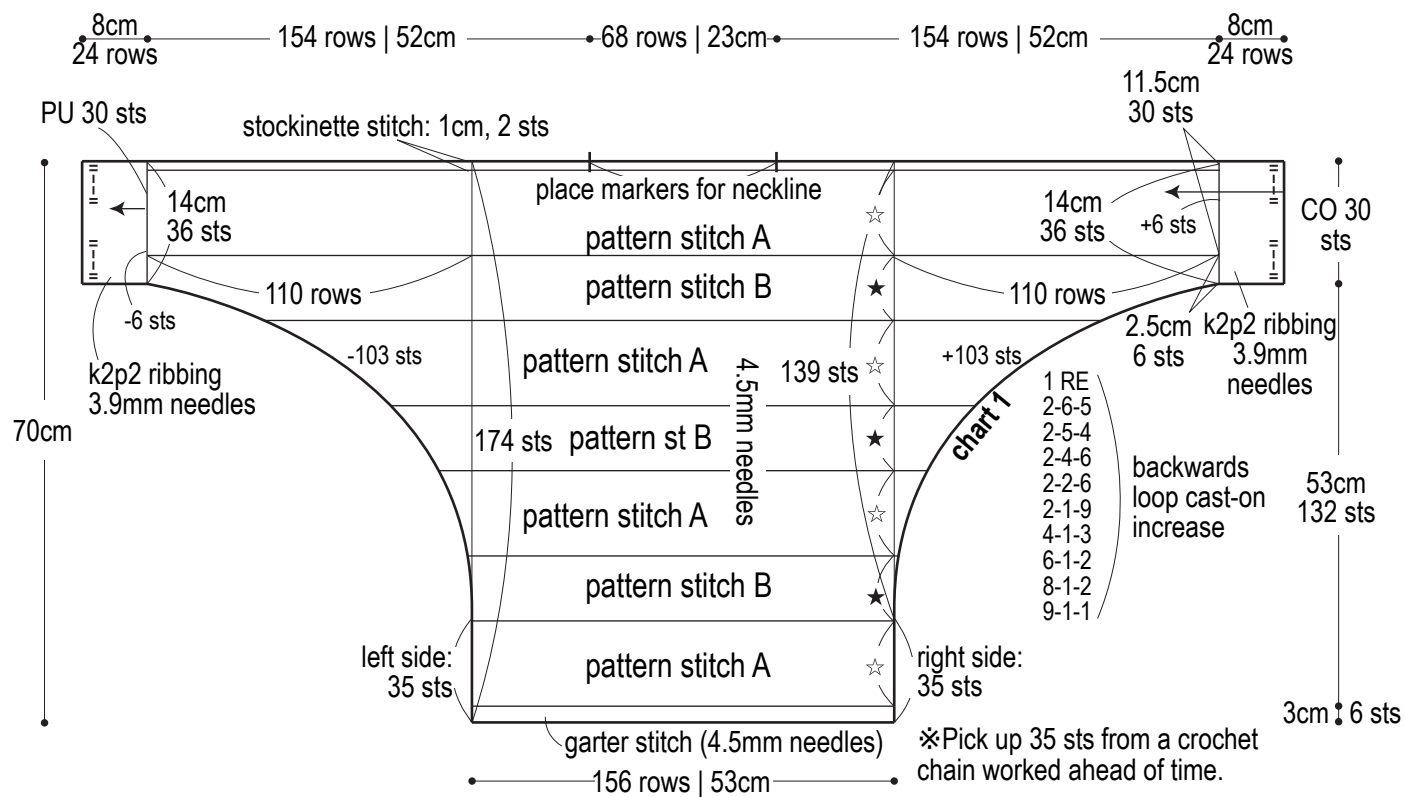
Left & right front body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Start left front at cuff, but start right front from front center edge. Shape sleeves and sides as for back (increases & decreases).

Finishing: Seam shoulders from cuff to neckline opening. Seam sleeve undersides from cuff down the side of the garment with crochet slip stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; knit hood in stockinette stitch. When finished with hood, seam with crochet slip stitch with right sides facing. Pick up stitches around front edges and hood edge; work edging in k2p2 ribbing. Bind off in pattern. Crochet loops, then seam to right and left front bands. Sew buttons to left front band.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on inc = increase OH = on hold (that is, place sts on stitch holder) PU = pick up RE = row(s) even #-#-# = rows-stitches-times

pattern stitch B = ★ = 8cm, 18 sts

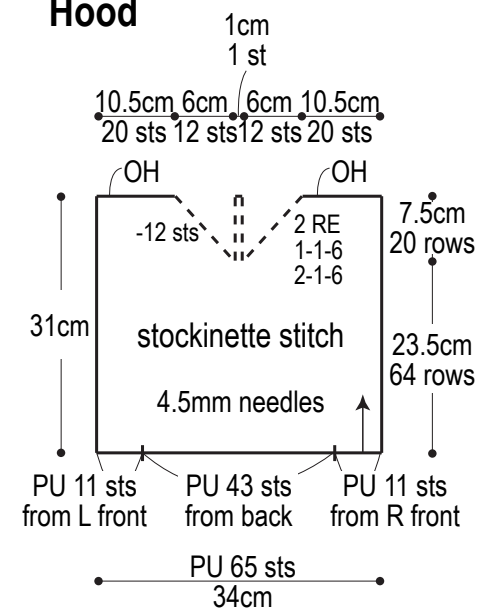

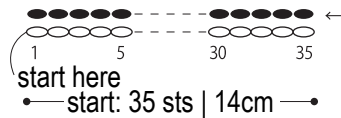

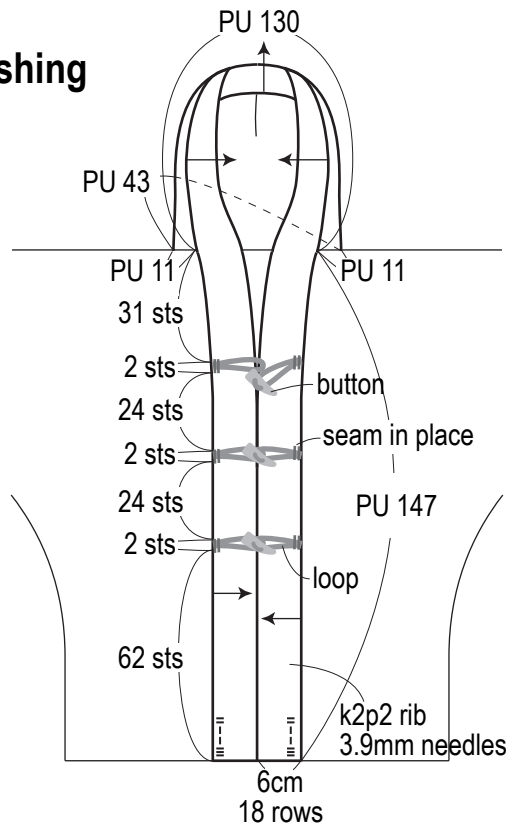


Loops (make 6)

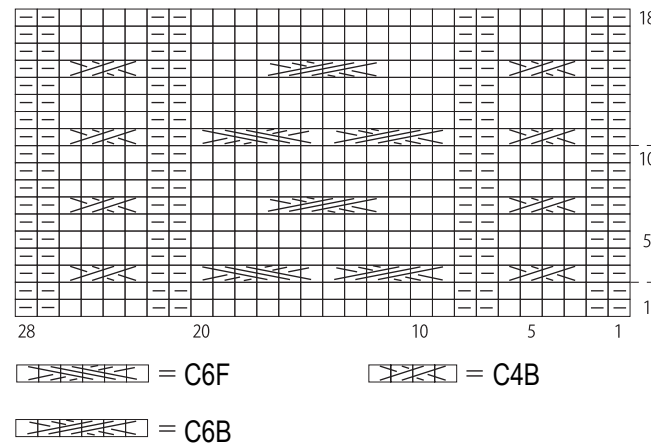
3.5mm hook

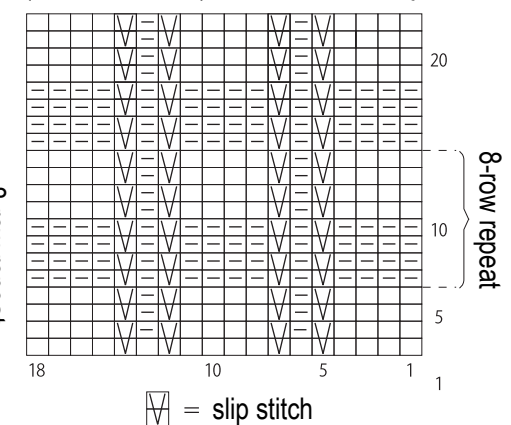


Pattern stitch A (4.5mm needles)



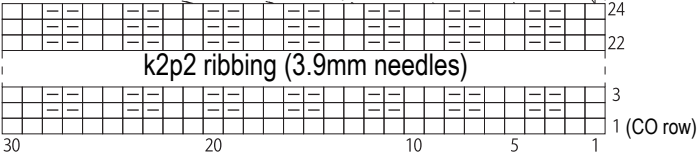
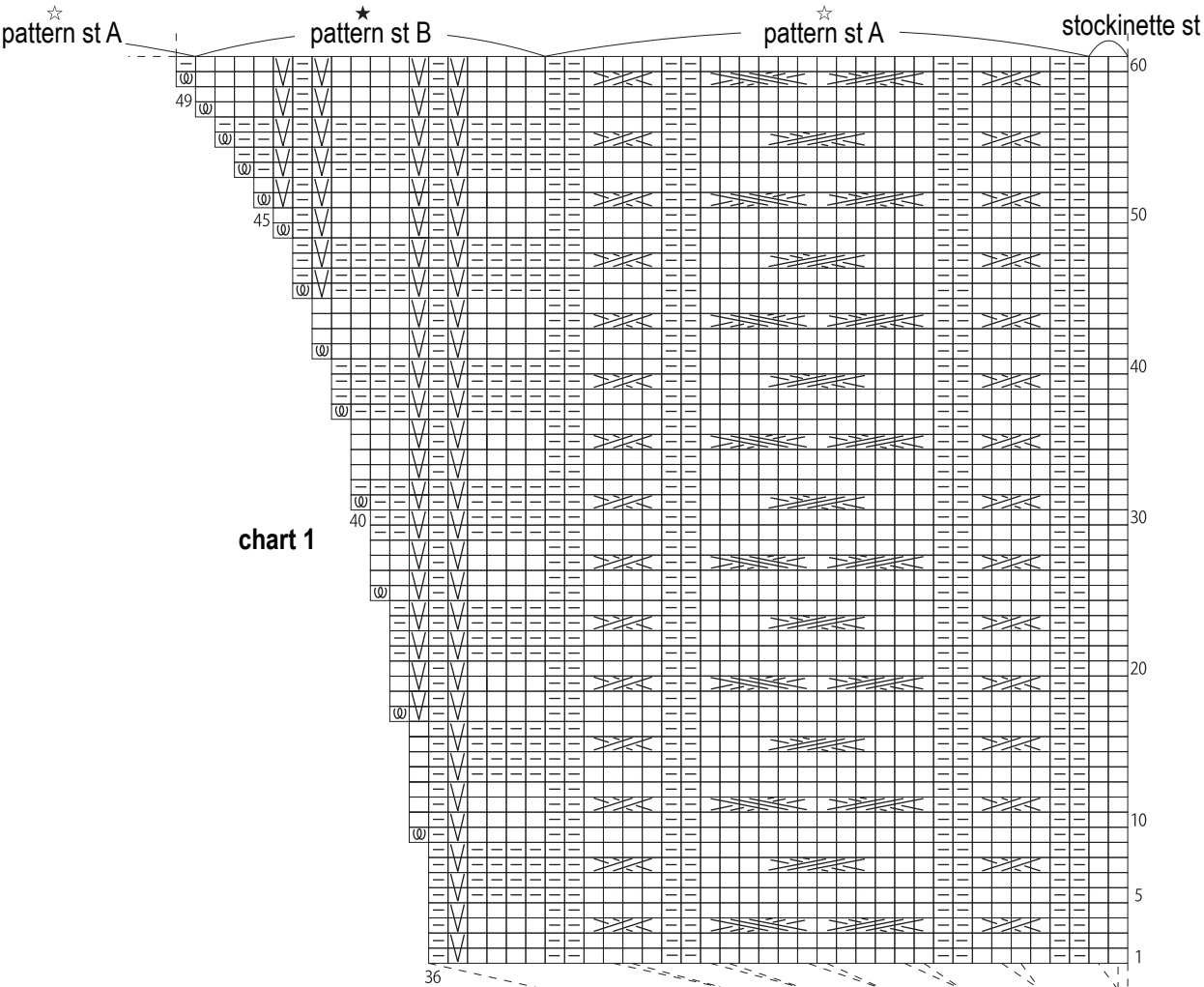
Pattern stitch B
