

# 212w-11 Orange Beanie



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Orange [100% merino wool; 175 yds/160m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #07 old rose/olive, 2 skeins [60g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 2½) and 3.3mm (approx. US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- head circumference 57.5cm/22.64"
- length 21.5cm/8.46"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A (3.0mm needles): 24 sts and 55 rounds
- pattern stitch B (3.3mm needles): 23.5 sts and 36 rounds

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Knitting Tips

Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch A in the round, then pattern stitch B, changing needle size when indicated. Work decreases for top as shown in chart. Thread yarn through remaining stitches and cinch top shut. Make pom-pom and sew to top of hat.


## Abbreviations:

CO = cast on


RE = round(s) even

## Body of hat




## Finishing
