

# 212w-24 Erfurt Pullover



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Erfurt [20% baby alpaca, 80% natural wool; 96 yds/88m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #03 brownie, 10 skeins [385g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) straight knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5.1mm (approx. US 8) and 5.7mm (approx. US 9) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- chest 104cm/40.94"
- cross back width 46cm/18.11"
- length 67cm/26.38"
- sleeve length 55cm/21.65"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 16 sts and 22 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Knitting Tips


**Back, front, and sleeves:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in stockinette stitch.

**Finishing:** Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch. Align sleeves and sleeve gussets (where marked with ★ and ★, and ☆ and ☆, respectively), then seam with stitches-to-rows mattress stitch. Seam sides and sleeve undersides in one continuous seam with mattress stitch. Work collar in stockinette stitch in the round. Bind off in pattern.


## Abbreviations:

- BO = bind off
- CO = cast on
- PU = pick up
- RE = row(s) even
- #-# = rows-stitches-times



## Front




## Sleeve
