

amicomo9-2 Simple Stranded Hat



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Fine Merino [100% merino wool; 103 yds/94m per 1.06 oz./30g skein];
 - color #208 aqua green, 1 skein [11g]
 - color #212 old rose, 1 skein [13g]
 - color #229 brown, 2 skeins [43g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 2½) and 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) circular or double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- head circumference 54cm/21.26"
- length 24cm/9.45"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch & stranded pattern stitch: 28 sts and 30 rounds
- k2p2 ribbing: 29 sts and 32 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work k2p2 ribbing in the round. Continue in stranded pattern stitch, working evenly spaced increases. Shape top of hat by decreasing as indicated in chart. When 12 stitches remain, thread yarn tail through those 12 stitches and cinch shut.

Abbreviations:

CO = cast on

inc = increase(s)

k = knit stitch


p = purl stitch

RE = round(s) even


= rounds-stitches-times [For example, 2-1-4 means "every 2 rounds, decrease 1 stitch; do this 4 times total." In this pattern, the location of the ★ symbol indicates where to work the decrease. Work the decrease at each ★ symbol.]

= rounds-stitches-places-times [Used for evenly spaced decreases worked across entire width of an item. For example, 2-1-12-1 means "every 2 rounds, decrease 1 stitch in each of 12 places across the round; do this 1 time total."]
