Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Hokkori Acryl [100% acrylic; 60 yds/66m per 1.56 oz./50g skein];
 - · color #10 broccoli, 1 skein [15g]
 - color #11 lettuce, 1 skein [10g]
 - color #18 black sesame, 1 skein [small amount]

Tools/Notions:

- · 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- · small amount polyfiber stuffing
- 1 button (15mm/0.59" diameter)

Finished measurements:

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

· No gauge information is provided in the original pattern.

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Soybeans: Create magic ring to begin. Work in single crochet (US), increasing and decreasing as indicated. Before crocheting last round, insert stuffing. Then thread yarn through remaining stitches on last round and cinch shut. Embroider eyes and mouths.


Pea pod: Work chain to begin. Work 2 pieces in double crochet (US) and single crochet (US). Crochet 2 loops and attach in 2 places on opposite sides. Place the 2 pieces of the pod together with wrong sides facing, then seam together with whipstitch. Sew button to pod.







Draw out embroidery thread, knot & leave a tail approximately 1cm/0.39" long.
