

amicomo11-1 3-way Margaret Shrug



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Saumur [70% merino wool, 30% baby alpaca; 118 yds/108m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #02 light pink beige, 8 skeins [240g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 8 buttons (21mm/0.83")

Finished measurements:

- width 40cm/15.75"
- length 129cm/50.79"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 25 sts and 13.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.


Crochet Tips

Chain 90 to begin (not counting any chain stitches needed for turning post). Work in pattern stitch for 169 rows, then cut yarn and bind off. Referring to chart, join yarn and work 3 rounds of edging. Sew buttons to shrug. Use eyelets in edging as buttonholes.


Abbreviations:
