

211w-16 Guell Tunic



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Guell [40% mohair, 33% acrylic, 18% wool, 7% nylon, acetate 2%; 157 yds/144m per 2.47 oz./70g skein]; color #12 mille crepe, 4 skeins [220g]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.6mm (approx. US 10½) and 8.0mm (US 11) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 6.6mm (approx. US 10½) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- cross back width 26.5cm/10.43"
- length 78.5cm/30.91"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 11.5 sts and 15.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

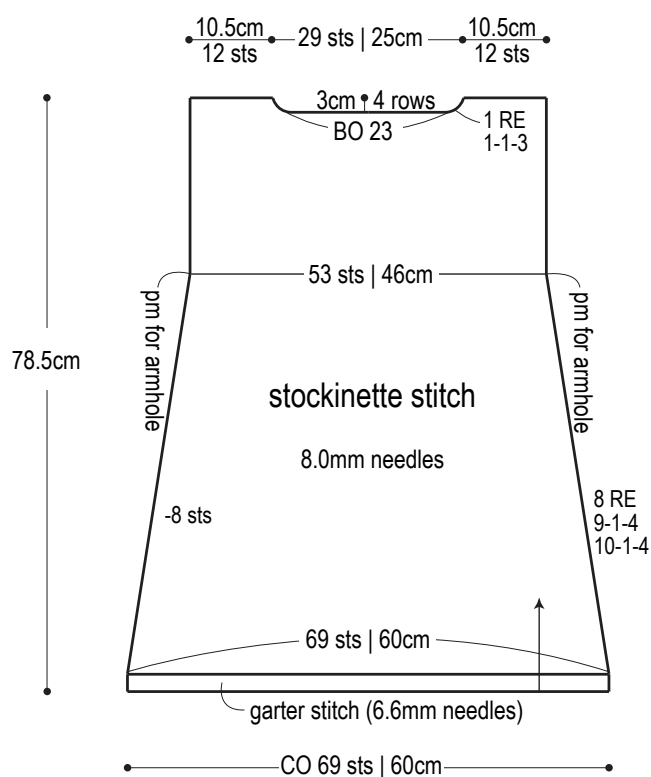
Back & front body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in garter stitch, then in stockinette stitch.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with three-needle bind-off method. Seam sides (up until armhole openings) with mattress stitch. Work garter stitch in the round at neckline and armhole openings. Bind off in pattern.

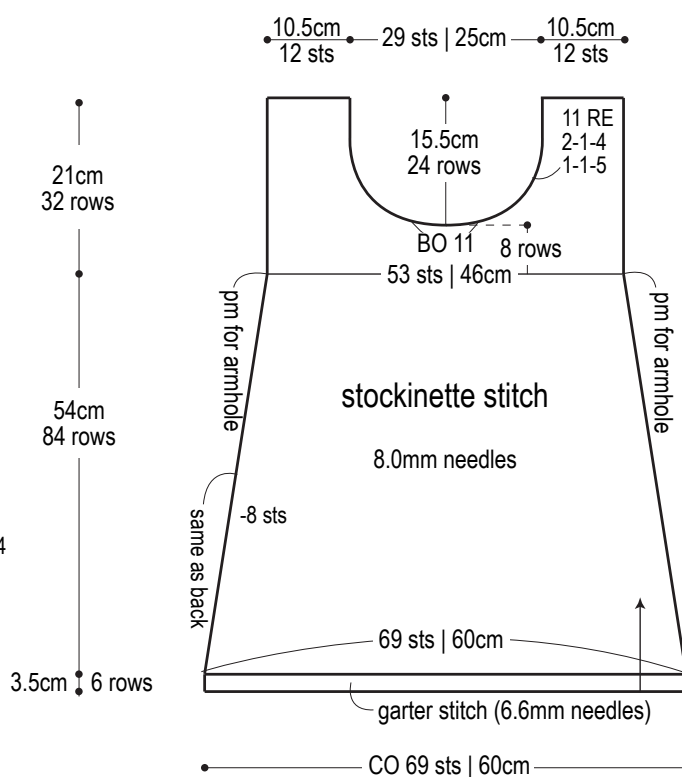
Abbreviations:
