

213ss-21 Rosetta Bolero



Suggested yarn:

- Filati Torre Rosetta [100% cotton; 159 yds/145m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #07 golden yellow, 8 skeins [375g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 95cm/37.40"
- center back neck-to-cuff 43cm/16.93"
- length 48.5cm/19.09"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 24 sts and 34 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Back & front body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch. Shape raglan edge by decreasing at edge. Shape front curve using backwards loop cast-on increase.

Sleeves: Start as for body. and work in pattern stitch.

Finishing: Seam sides, raglan edges, and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Seam gusset with Kitchener stitch. Work edging in the round along neckline, hem, and front edges. Work edging in the round along cuffs.

Abbreviations:

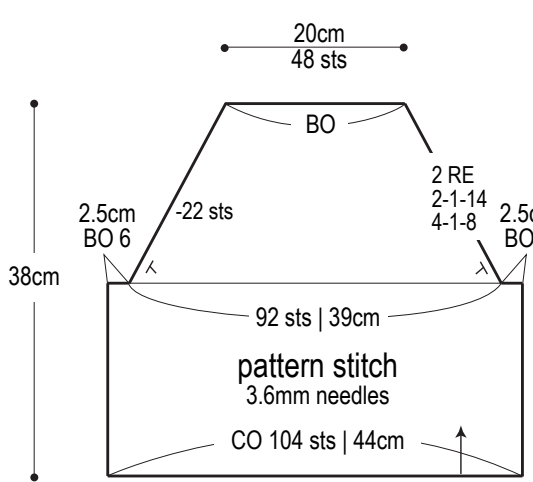
BO = bind off

CO = cast on

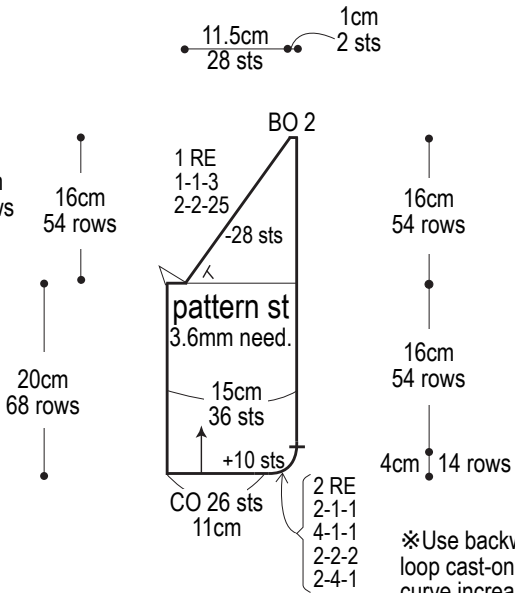
RE = row(s) even

= rows-stitches-times

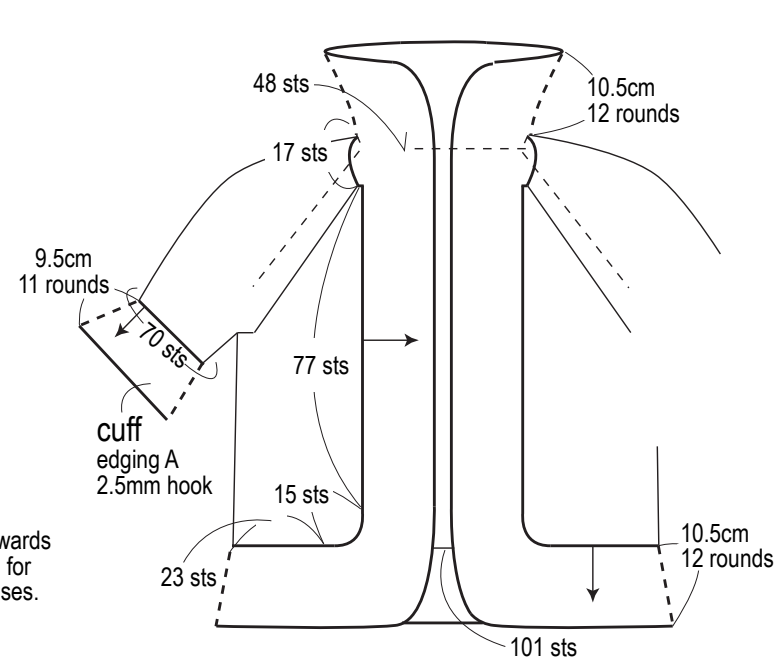

Right front

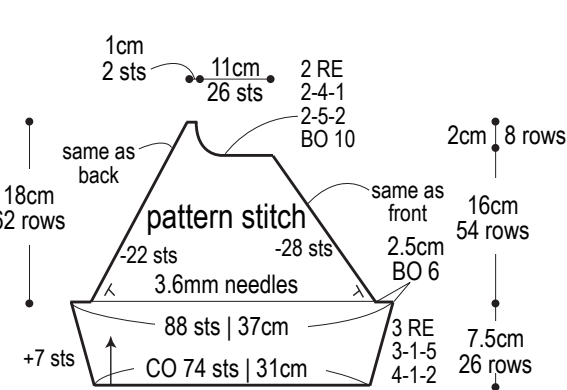


Hem, front placket, and collar

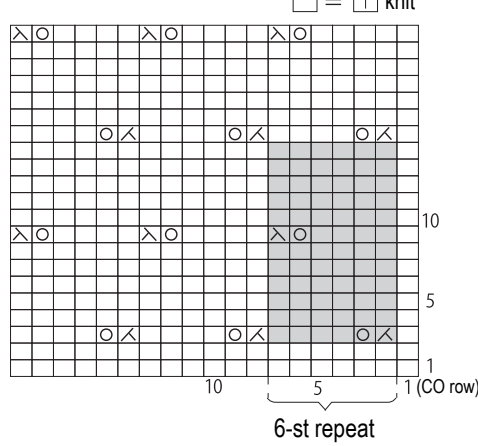


※Reverse shaping of right front and right sleeve for left front and left sleeve. (Pattern stitches remain the same.)

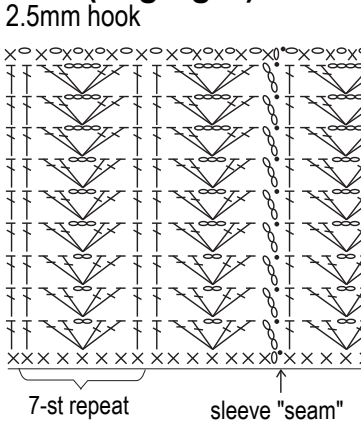
Right sleeve



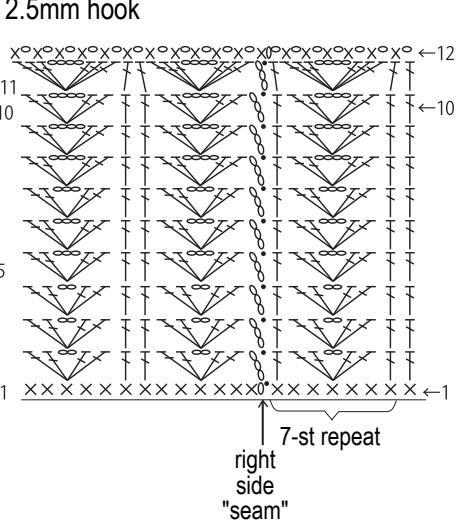
Pattern stitch
