

213ss-25 Striped French Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Giza 45 Cotton [100% Egyptian cotton; 109 yds/100m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #08 navy, 2 skeins [70g]
- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Neat S [100% cotton; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #09 navy, 6 skeins [240g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 94cm/37.01"
- center back neck-to-cuff 27cm/10.63"
- length 58.5cm/23.03"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 22 sts and 32 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch, alternating between Giza 45 Cotton and Cotton Neat S to form wide stripes. Shape neckline by binding off stitches where indicated and by working decreases at edges. Shape shoulders with short rows. Remove provisional cast-on edge, picking up the live stitches. Work hem in k2p2 ribbing, then bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline and armholes; work collar and cuffs in k2p2 ribbing, then bind off in pattern.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
pm = place marker
PU = pick up
RE = row(s) even
rep = pattern repeat(s)
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

Dimensions:

- Top width: 12cm (26 sts), 23cm (51 sts), 12cm (26 sts)
- Left side length: 58.5cm
- Bottom width: 102 sts (100 sts + 2 sts)

Construction Details:

- Top Edge:** 2 RE 2-2-3, 2.5cm | 8 rows BO 39, 5 sts even 2-5-3 2-6-1
- Body:** pattern stitch A, 3.6mm needles
- Bottom Edge:** CO 103 sts | 47cm, -1 st, k2p2 ribbing (3.3mm needles)
- Bottom Width:** PU 102 sts

- Back width: 12cm (26 sts) | 23cm (51 sts) | 12cm (26 sts)
- Shoulder width: 15cm (48 rows)
- Back length: 30 rows
- Pattern stitch A (3.6mm needles)
- CO 103 sts | 47cm
- 1 st
- k2p2 ribbing (3.3mm needles)
- PU 102 sts
- 29 RE (4-1-1, 3-1-1, 2-1-3, 1-1-6)
