

213s-09 Cotton Neat Tee



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Neat S [100% cotton; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #01 white, 3 skeins [95g]
 - color #11 baby blue, 3 skeins [85g]
 - color #12 sapphire blue, 3 skeins [90g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.5mm (US 7) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 4.0mm (US G) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 88cm/34.65"
- center back neck-to-cuff 23cm/9.06"
- length 60cm/23.62"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 22 sts and 28 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

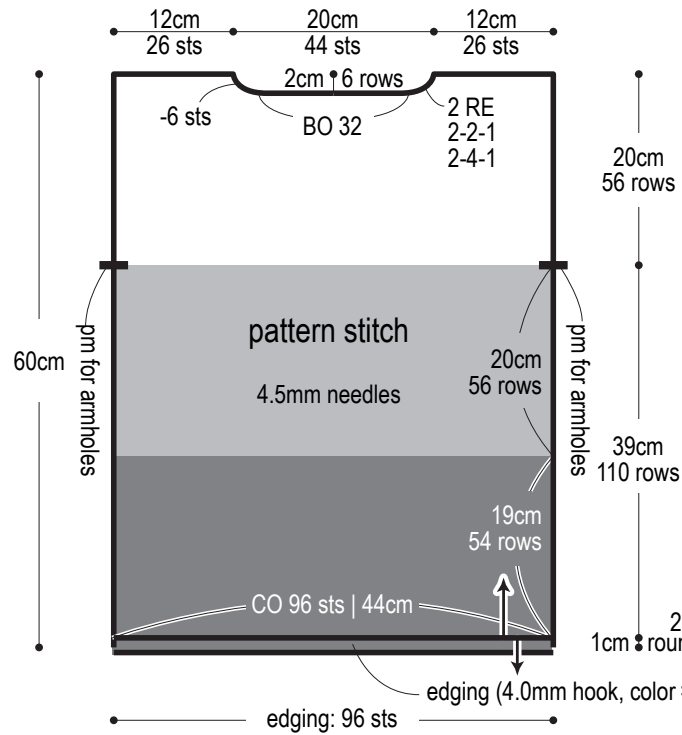
Back & front body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch, changing colors where indicated. Shape neckline as follows: when decreasing two or more stitches, bind those stitches off. When decreasing 1 stitch, use fully fashioned decrease (1 stitch in from edge).

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides up until armhole markers using mattress stitch. Work edging in the round around hem, neckline, and armholes. Crochet 2 cords, then thread one through each side to create ruched effect.

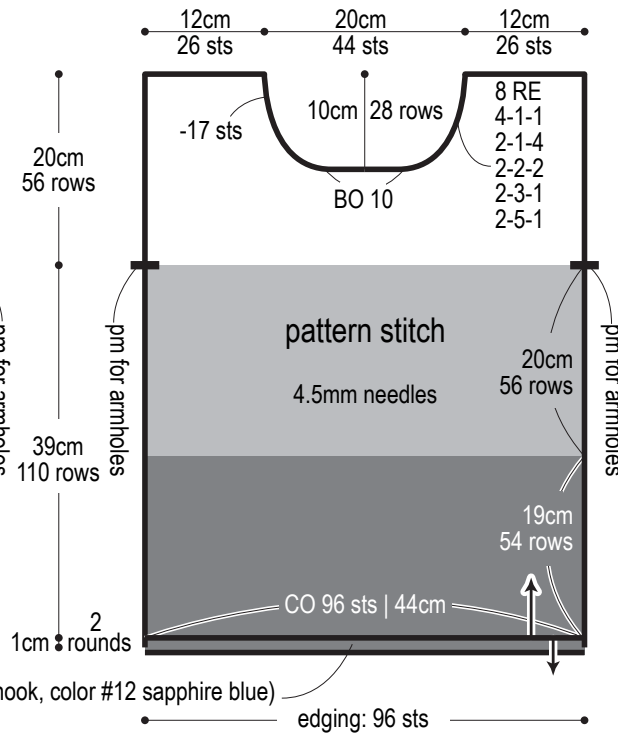

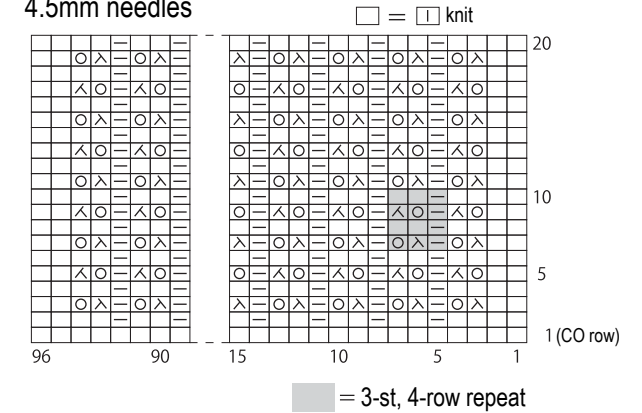

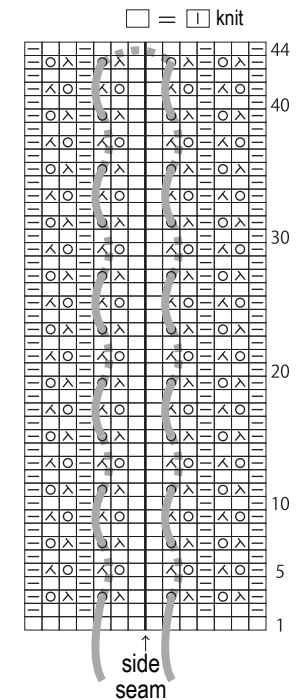


Pattern stitch

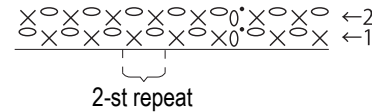
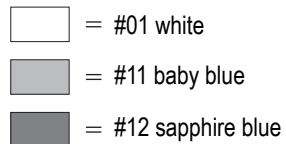
4.5mm needles

Edging (4.0mm hook)



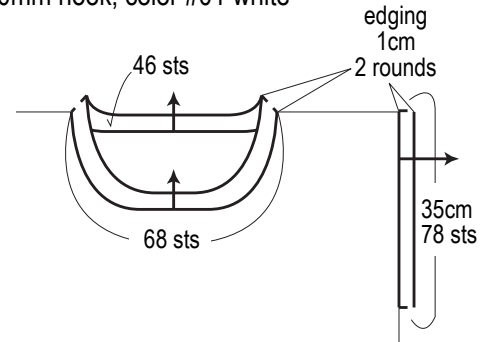
Cord (make 2)
