

213s-10 Square Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Nagomi Cotton [100% cotton; 323 yds/295m per 3.53 oz./100g cone]; color #02 gentian, 2 cones [175g]
- Pierrot Yarns Cyryp [52% acrylic, 29% nylon, 15% plant fiber, 6% polyester; 492 yds/450m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #17 confetti, 2 cones [55g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- center back neck-to-cuff 23.5cm/9.25"
- length 48cm/18.90"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 23 sts and 7 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

※Note: entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together: 1 strand of Nagomi Cotton and 1 strand of Cyryp.

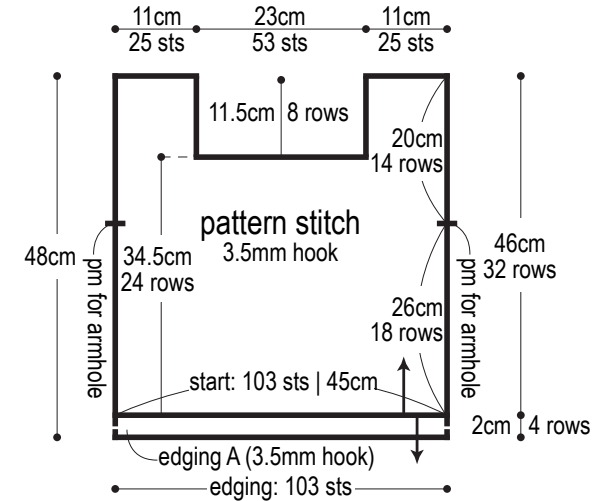
Back & front body: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in pattern stitch.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with chain seam (alternatin chain stitches and slip stitches as needed to maintain pattern). Seam sides up until marker for armholes using chain seam. Work edging A in the round along hem. Work edging B in the round along neckline and armholes.

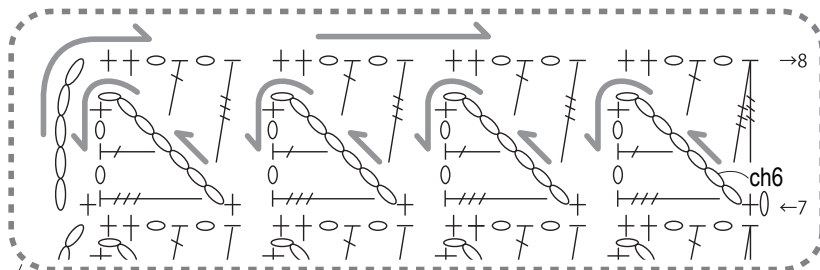
Abbreviations:

dtr = double treble crochet (US)
pm = place marker
sc = single crochet (US)

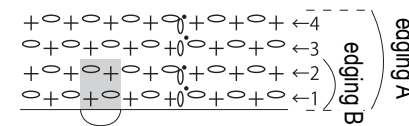
Back & front (make 2)



Pattern stitch instructions

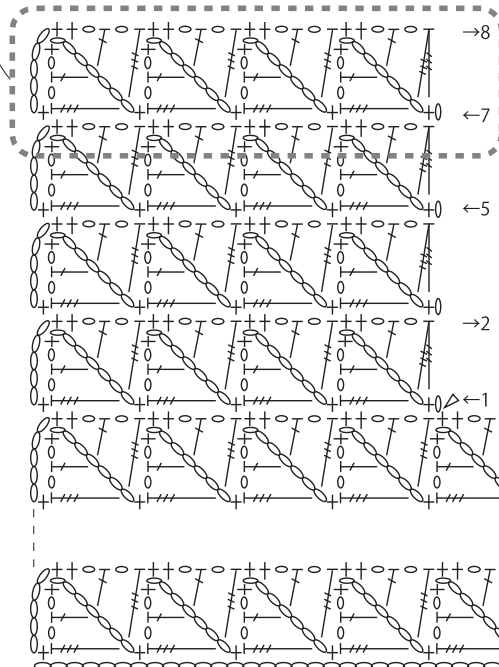


Edging (3.5mm hook)

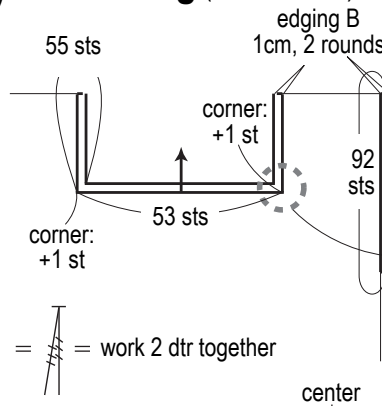


2-sts & 2-rows = 1 repeat

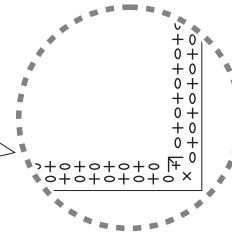
Pattern stitch for body (3.5mm hook)



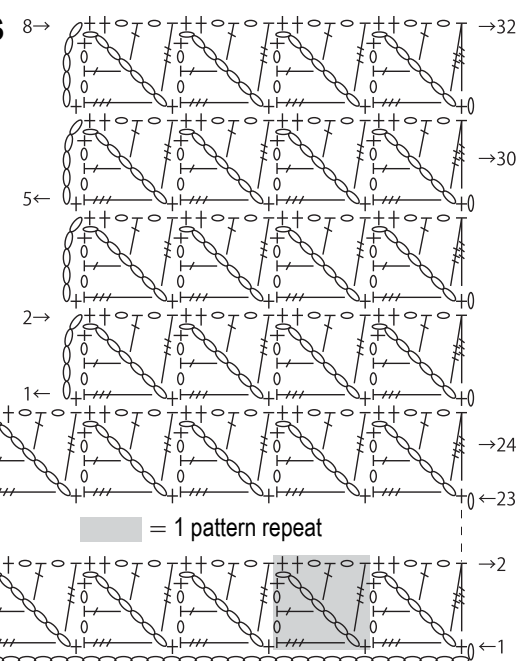
Finishing (3.5mm hook)
