

213s-11 Julien Bolero



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Julien [95% silk, 5% polyester; 192 yds/176m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #76 powder pink beige, 6 skeins [215g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.3mm (approx. US B) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- cross back width 38cm/14.96"
- length 49cm/19.29"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 40 sts and 13.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Back body: Work foundation chain to begin, then work in pattern stitch.

Front body: Start right front with foundation chain, then work in pattern stitch according to chart and schematic. Start left front by loosely chaining 70 sts, then cut yarn. Join yarn again where indicated, then work in pattern stitch according to chart and schematic.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with woven seam. Seam sides with chain seam (alternating chain stitches and slip stitches as needed to maintain pattern). Working edging around hem, front edges, and neckline in one continuous round. Work the same edging around each cuff.


※In the event that seaming the shoulders with a woven seam is difficult, work the woven seam through front loops of chain stitches only.


ch = chain

rep = pattern repeat(s)






Pattern stitch (2.3mm hook)




Hem, front band, neckline & cuff edging


2.3mm hook




Edging A

2.3mm hook







Right front & armhole
