

# 213s-18 Cotton Neat Beret



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cotton Neat S [100% cotton; 104 yds/95m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - color #13 turquoise blue, 2 skeins [45g]
  - color #14 teal green, 1 skein [25g]
  - color #34 beige, 1 skein [25g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) and 3.5mm (US E) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- head circumference 49cm/19.29" to 55cm/21.65"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch B (3.5mm hook): 17 sts and 12 rounds
- single crochet (US) (2.5mm hook): 23 sts and 25 rounds

*Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Crochet Tips

**Top & sides:** Create magic ring to begin, then work in pattern stitches A and B.

**Hat band:** Change hook size, then work sc into stitches on side of hat as well as into chain (loosely chained in advance for this purpose). Work sc back and forth in joined rounds.

※Knot ribbon to base of chain stitches in hat band, then use it to adjust the hat's size.


## Abbreviations:

- ch = chain
- dc = double crochet (US)
- fp dc = front post double crochet (US)
- m = magic ring
- sc = single crochet (US)


## Beret chart

2.5mm hook

-  = fp dc
-  = fp dc right cross cable
-  \*Insert hook from the side into sc st 2 rounds below.
- = #13 turquoise
- = #14 teal green
- = #34 beige



## Beret schematic




\*For hat band, work 2 chains in advance: with #13 turquoise, ch48.
