

213ss-13 Carta Cropped Pullover



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Carta [90% cotton, 10% silk; 133 yds/122m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #64 coral orange, 7 skeins [255g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) straight or circular knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- center back neck-to-cuff 50.5cm/19.88"
- length 35.5cm/13.98"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 22 sts and 33 row
- pattern stitch B: 27.5 sts and 33 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Back & front body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. (Because there are so many stitches to cast on, you may find it easier to cast on using 4 double-pointed knitting needles, rather than 2 straight knitting needles.) Work back in pattern stitch A. Work front in pattern stitches A and B.

Finishing: Seam shoulders loosely with crochet slip stitch seam up until markers for neckline. Seam sleeve undersides with whipstitch from cuff until markers for sleeve. Work edging in the round around neckline, cuffs, and hem.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

center double dec = slip two stitches knitwise, k1, pass two slipped stitches over the knit stitch

CO = cast on

dec = decrease

k2tog = knit two stitches together knitwise

left double dec = slip one stitch knitwise, k2tog, pass slipped stitch over the k2tog stitch

pm = place marker

RE = row(s) even

= rows-stitches-times
