

213s-03 Short-sleeved French Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Pont du Gard [100% linen; 188 yds/172m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #02 fromage, 4 skeins [140g]
- Pierrot Yarns Cyryp [52% acrylic, 29% nylon, 13% plant fiber, 6% polyester; 492 yds/450m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #11 lemon yellow, 2 cones [60g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 98cm/38.58"
- center back neck-to-cuff 27.5cm/10.83"
- length 45.5cm/17.91"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 26 sts and 17.5 rows
- edging: 26 sts and 2.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

✳️**Note:** entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together: 1 strand of Pont du Gard and 1 strand of Cyryp.

Body: Starting with foundation chain, work in pattern stitch according to chart and schematic. Work edging along hem.

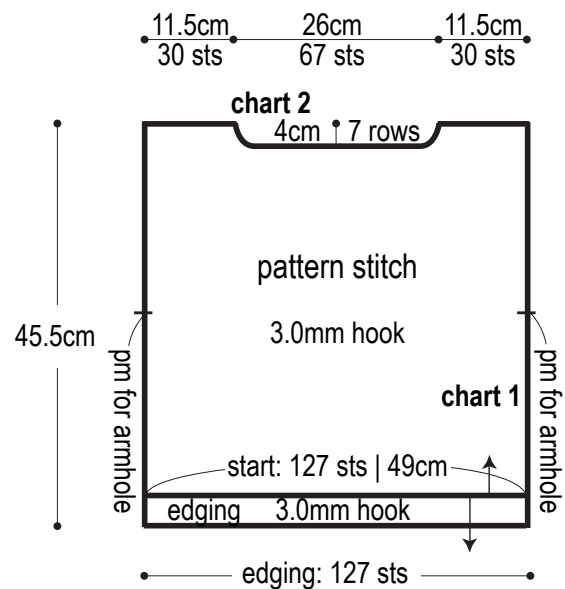
Finishing: Seam shoulders with chain seam (alternating chain stitches and slip stitches as needed to maintain pattern). Seam sides with chain seam. Work edging back and forth in joined rounds along armholes and neckline.

Abbreviations:

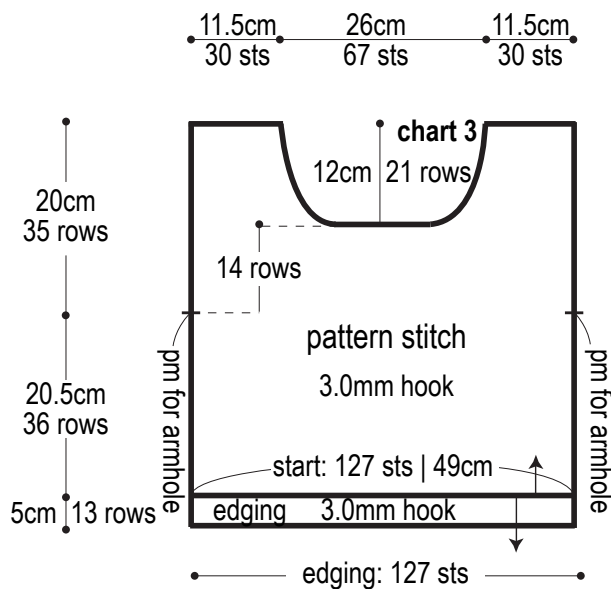
ch = chain

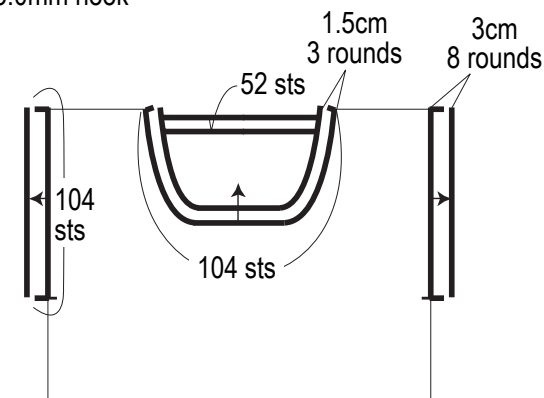

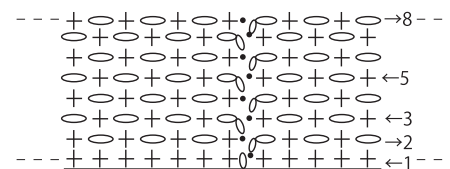
Arm & neckline edging

3.0mm hook



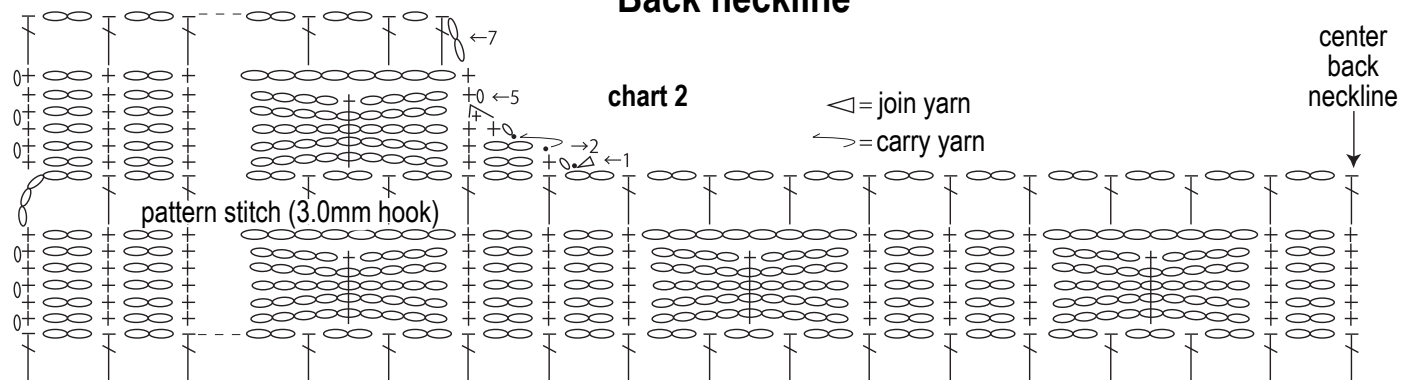
Cuff & neckline edging

3.0mm hook



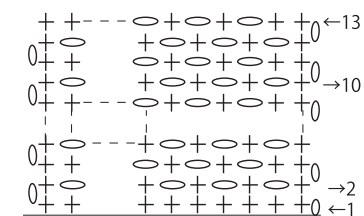
