

213s-08 Draped Vest



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Cyryp [52% acrylic, 29% nylon, 13% plant fiber, 6% polyester; 492 yds/450m per 1.76 oz./50g cone]; color #20 sour cherry, 4 cones [160g]
- Pierrot Yarns Beauty Silk Cotton [90% cotton, 10% silk; 180 yds/165m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #03 light beige, 10 skeins [280g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.9mm (approx. US 6) straight knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- cross back width 41cm/16.14"
- length 60cm/23.62"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch (3.6mm needles): 26 sts and 36 rows
- pattern stitch (3.9mm needles): 30 sts and 30 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

※Note: entire garment worked with 2 strands of yarn held together (1 strand of Cyryp and 1 strand of Beauty Silk Cotton).

Back, right front, and left front: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch. Bind off in pattern. Seam sides (except for armhole sections) with mattress stitch. Crochet 1 round of edging in the round around each armhole.

Ruffle: Pick up stitches around body. Work 2 sections each in stockinette A and stockinette B, referring to schematic. While doing this, work evenly spaced increases. Bind off in pattern. Double-pointed needles (or a circular needle) are suggested due to the high number of stitches.

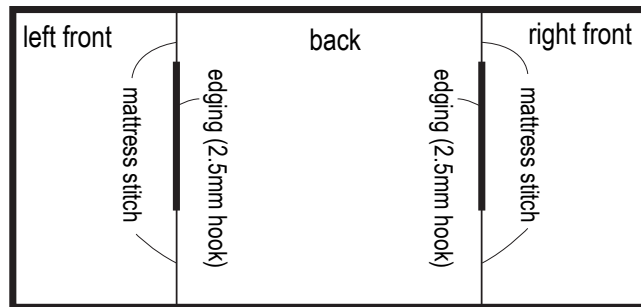
Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CO = cast on PU = pick up RE = row(s) even, round(s) even rep = pattern repeat(s)

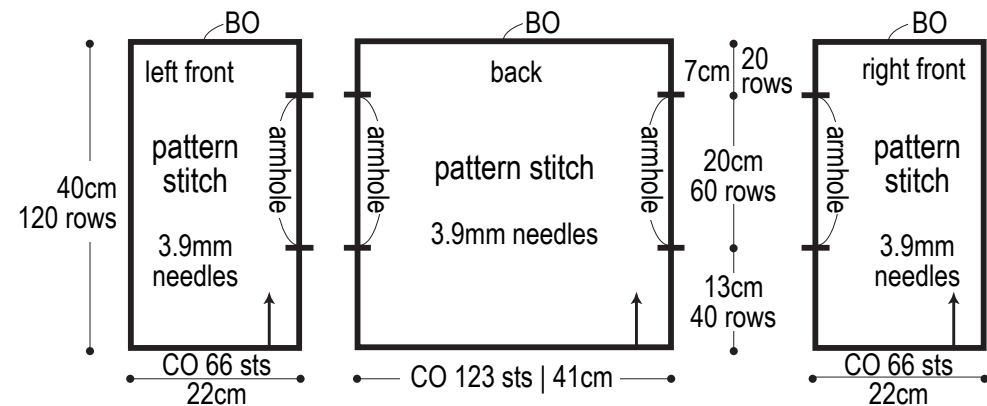
#-#-# = rows-stitches-times

#-#-#-# = rows-places-stitches-times [for evenly spaced increases worked across entire width of an item]. For example, 1-2-3-4 means "every 1 row, increase 3 stitches in each of 2 places across the row; do this 4 times total."

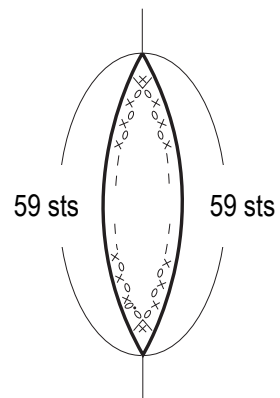


Back, right front, left front



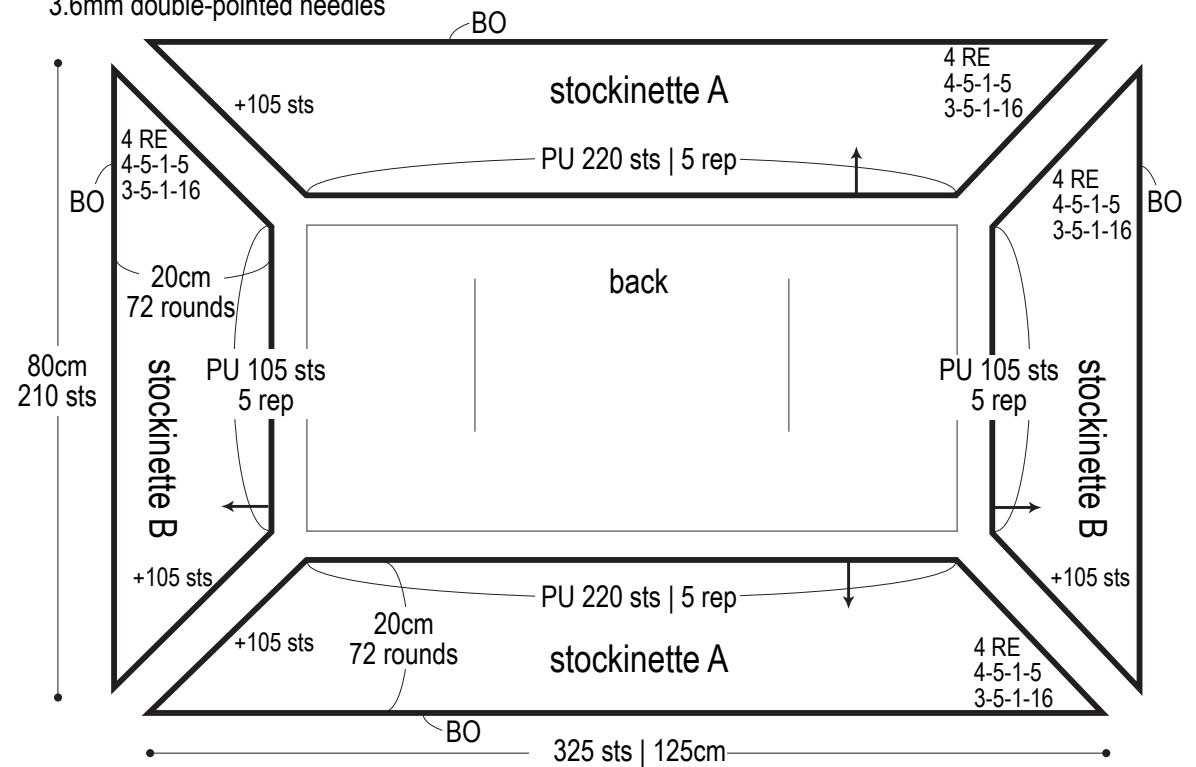
Armhole edging

2.5mm hook

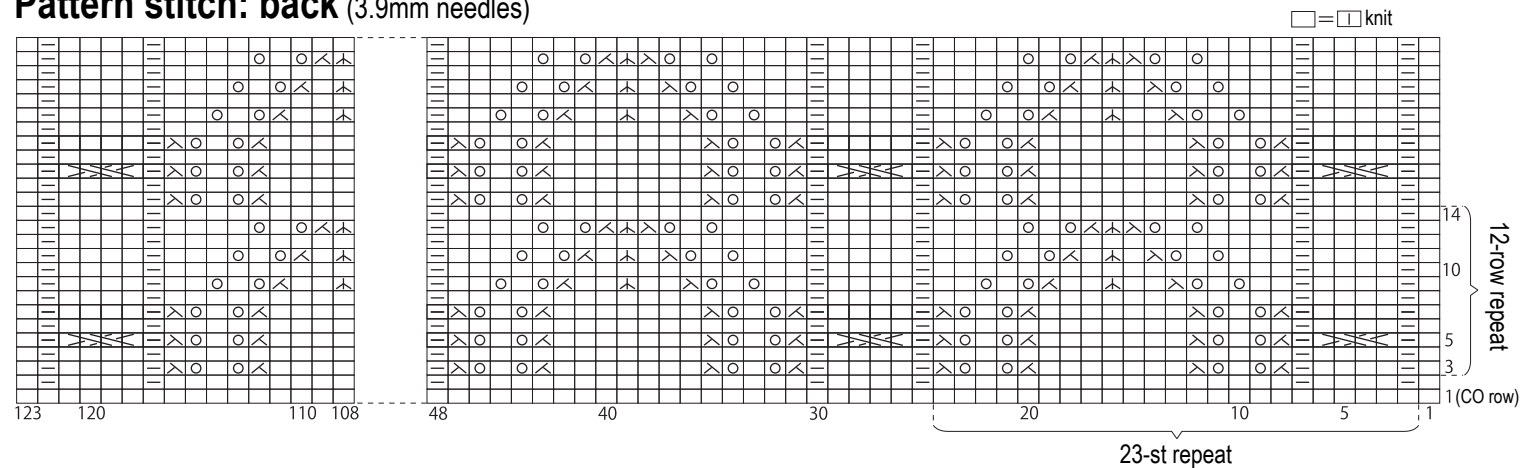


Ruffle

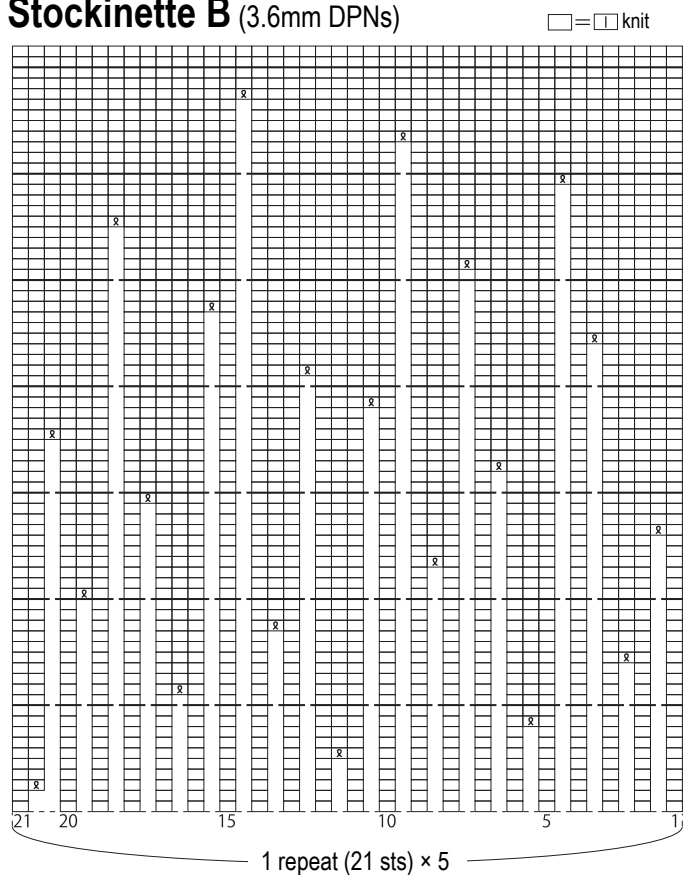
3.6mm double-pointed needles



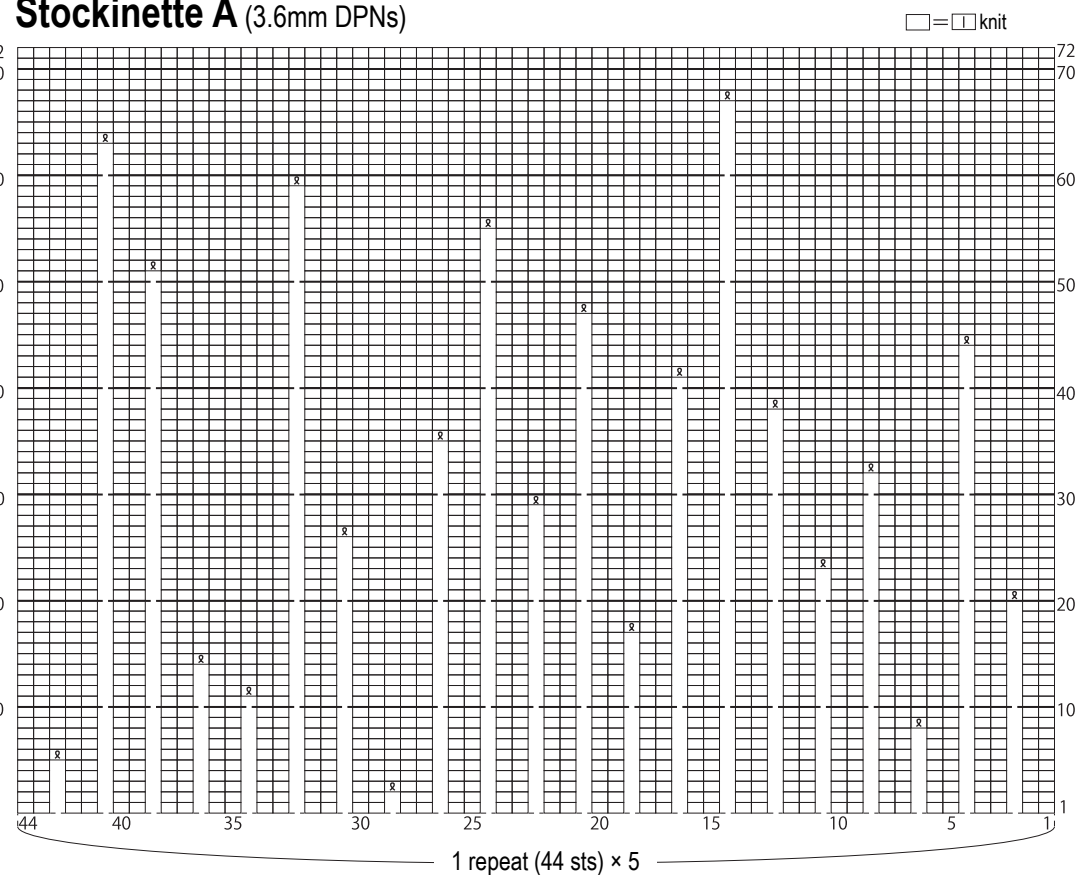
Pattern stitch: back (3.9mm needles)
