

213ss-15 Marine Hat



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Amian [100% washable Japanese paper; 94 yds/86m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #24 biscuit, 3 skeins [90g]
 - color #22 teal green, 1 skein [15g]
 - color #23 poppy red, 1 skein [10g]
 - color #25 Naples yellow, 1 skein [10g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- head circumference 58cm/22.83"
- depth 18cm/7.09"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US): 17.5 sts and 19 rounds

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

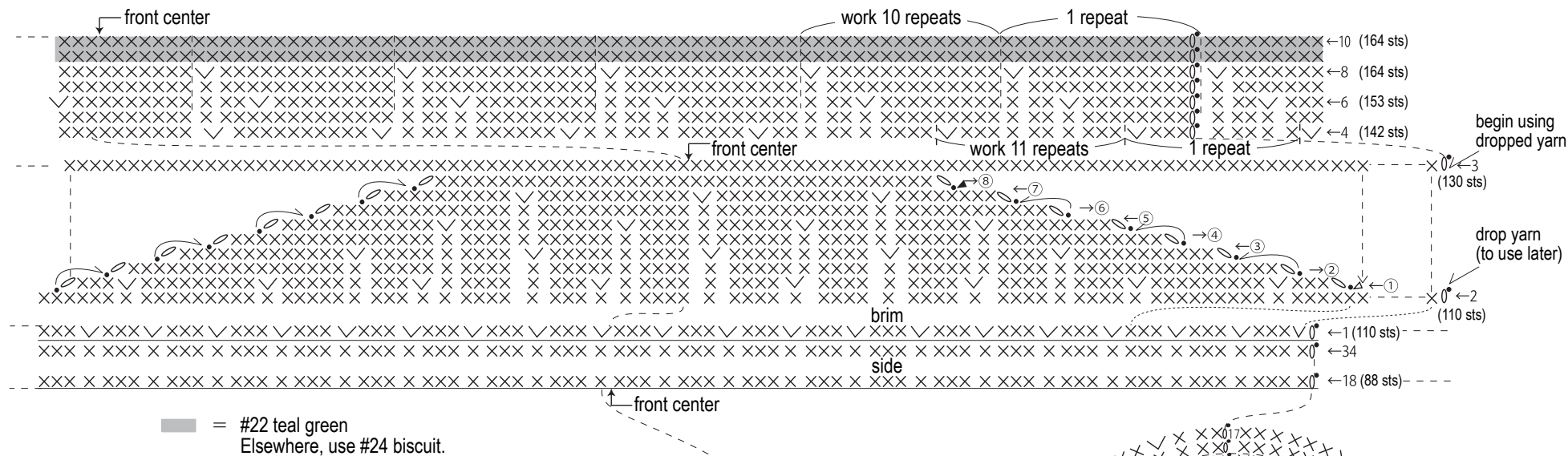
Crochet Tips

Create magic ring to begin. Work in sc according to chart, increasing as shown. After crocheting round 2 of the brim, drop yarn and leave it for later use. Join new yarn where indicated, then work short rows from ① to ⑧. Resume round 3 with dropped yarn; work remaining rounds. Change colors to work rounds 9 and 10 of brim. With #22 teal green and #23 poppy red, use slip stitch to create thin stripes on sides of hat. Crochet yacht appliqué and seam to hat.

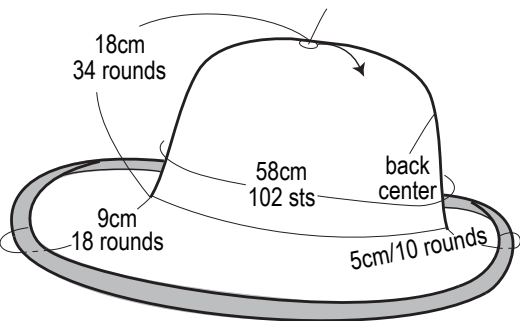

Hat instructions (3.0mm hook)

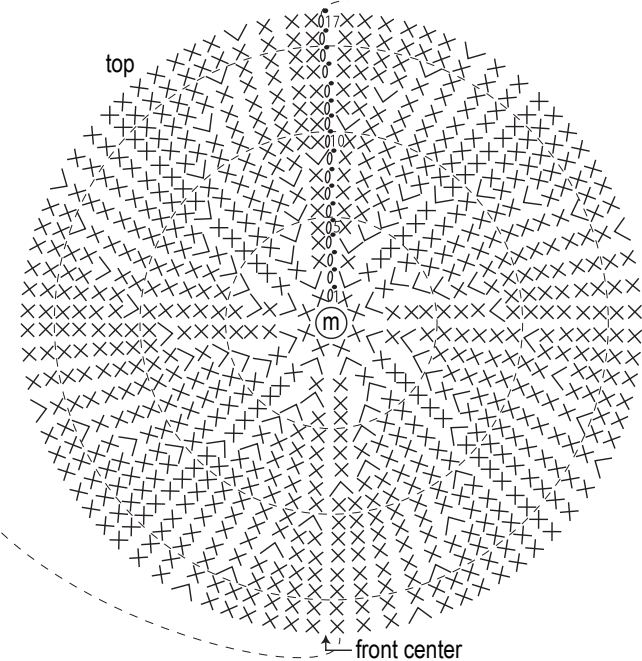


Hat schematic (3.0mm hook)

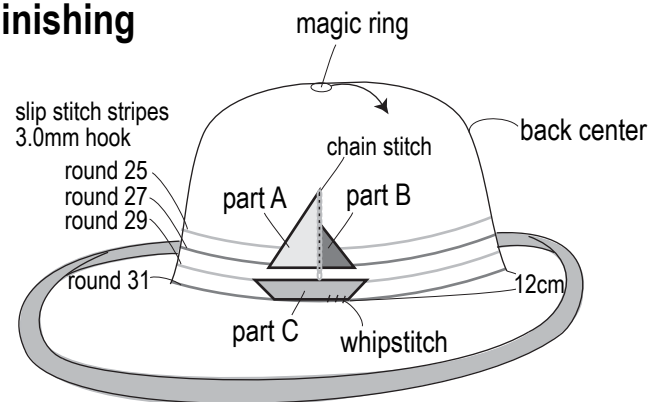

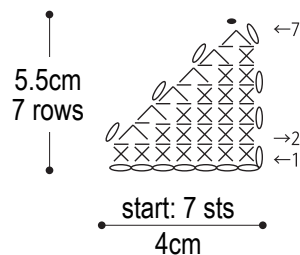

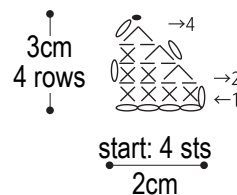

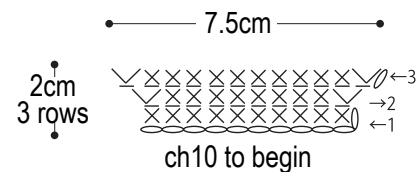
