

213ss-23 Noble Silk Suit



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Noble Silk [100% silk; 159 yds/145m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #02 China clay, 16 skeins [640g]
 - color #11 olive drab, 7 skeins [260g]

Tools/Notions:

- 2.5mm (approx. US B or C) and 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hooks or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- elastic for waistband (2cm/0.79" wide, 70cm/27.56" long)
- 3 buttons (21mm/0.83")

Finished measurements:

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 31 sts and 18.5 rows
- pattern stitch B: 4cm/1.57" square = 12 sts and 14.5 rows
- stockinette stitch A: 24 sts and 36.5 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Jacket body & sleeves: Work foundation chain to begin. Changing color every row (refer to chart for color sequences), work in pattern stitch. When changing color, carry unused yarn up the sides rather than repeatedly cutting and joining yarn.


Finishing: Seam sides and sleeve undersides with chain seam (alternating chain st and slip st as needed to maintain pattern). Seam shoulders with chain seam. Work edging in the round along hem, front edges, and neckline. Work edging in the round at cuffs as well. Seam sleeves to body with chain seam.

Skirt: First work waistband in stockinette stitch. Seam ends with mattress stitch, forming a circle, but leave a gap to thread elastic through later. Working stitches into cast-on row of waistband, crochet in pattern stitch (working top-down towards the hem). Fold waistband to the inside, and seam bind-off row to cast-on row with whipstitch. Thread elastic through waistband.








Hem, front band, and collar edging


2.5mm hook




Buttonholes




Right front



Left front



Pattern stitch B


2.5mm & 3.0mm hooks
#02 China clay



*Rounds 1 to 80: use 2.5mm hook.
*Rounds 81 to 109: use 3.0mm hook.

Skirt

2.5mm & 3.0mm hooks, 3.6mm needles



Finishing

Leave approx. 3cm unseamed for elastic.

Cut elastic to 68cm. Overlap by approx. 1.5cm; sew ends together.

Fold to wrong side of garment; tack down with whipstitch.
