

213ss-24 Silk Garden Cardigan



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Silk Garden [100% silk; 208 yds/190m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #01 off white, 1 skein [25g]
 - color #05 biscuit, 10 skeins [375g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.3mm (approx. US 3) and 3.6mm (approx. US 4 or 5) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 5 buttons (15mm/0.59")

Finished measurements:

- bust 94cm/37.01"
- cross back width 35.5cm/13.98"
- sleeve length 29.5cm/11.61"
- length 58.5cm/23.03"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch [2 strands, 3.6mm needles]: 24 sts and 33 rows
- stockinette stitch [1 strand, 3.3mm needles]: 24 sts and 32 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Hem & CC part of cuff: With 1 strand of color #01 off-white, cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work ribbing and then stockinette stitch. Place stitches on stitch holder.


Body and MC of sleeve: With 2 strands of yarn, cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch. On row 14, place hem/cuff section (color #01) together with body/sleeve, and join these pieces together by working row 14 through both layers of fabric. Shape armscye and neckline by binding off stitches where indicated and by working fully fashioned decreases (1 stitch in from the edge). Work sleeve increases (at sides) with fully fashioned lifted increases (1 stitch in from the edge). Bind off stitches at sleeve cap.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline; work edging in k1p1 ribbing, then bind off in pattern. Pick up stitches along front edges; work button bands in k1p1 ribbing, then bind off in pattern as for neckline edging. Be sure to work buttonholes in right front button band as you go. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.


Abbreviations:

BO = bind off CC = contrasting color CO = cast on MC = main color PU = pick up RE = row(s) even #.## = rows-stitches-times




Right front



Collar & button band




Sleeve




Pattern stitch
