

211F-03 Scarf with Ruffles



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino Fingering [100% merino wool; 183 yds/167m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
 - color #09 grage, 2 skeins [60g]
 - color #16 gray, 2 skeins [60g]
- Pierrot Yarns Pure Wool Lace [50% merino wool, 50% wool; 820 yds/750m per 3.53 oz./100g cone]; color #401 off-white, 1 cone [30g]

Tools/Notions:

- 7.0mm (US 7) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge; no equivalent US needle size
- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 22cm/8.66"
- length 163.5cm/64.37" (length of scarf only: 156.5cm/61.61")

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 14 sts and 17 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

✳️**Note:** Work body of scarf with 2 strands of Soft Merino Fingering held together (1 strand of color #09 grage and 1 strand of color #16 gray). Work ruffles with 2 strands of Pure Wool Lace held together.

Scarf: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in stockinette stitch, slipping the first stitch of each row. Bind off.

Ruffles: Work chain to begin, then crochet according to chart.

Finishing: Seam ruffles to body of scarf where shown using whipstitch.

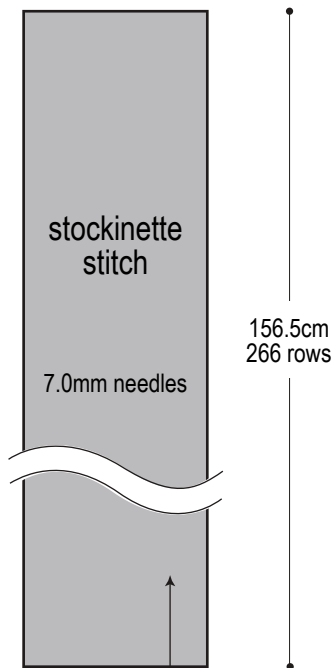
Abbreviations:

Scarf schematic

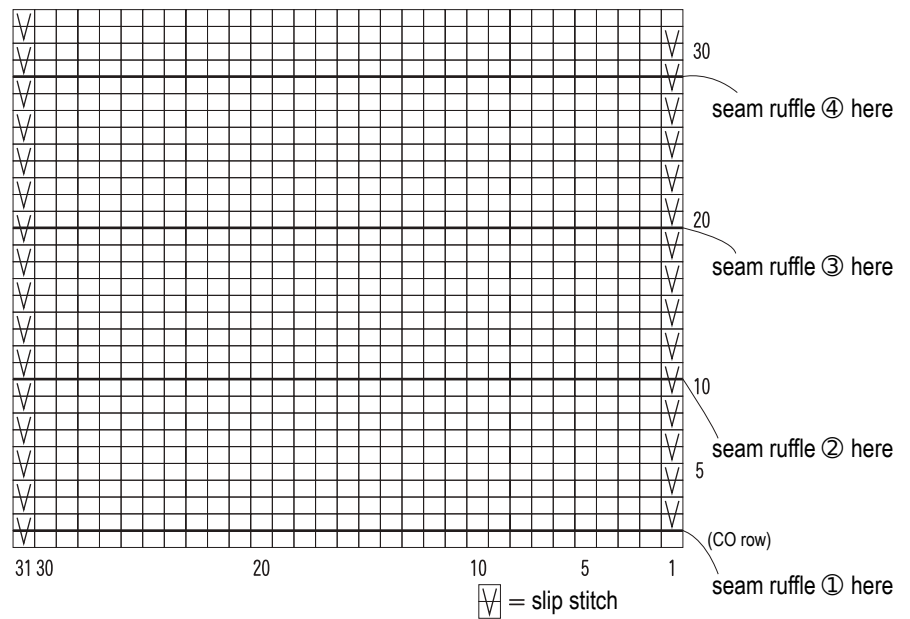
Soft Merino Fingering

7.0mm needles

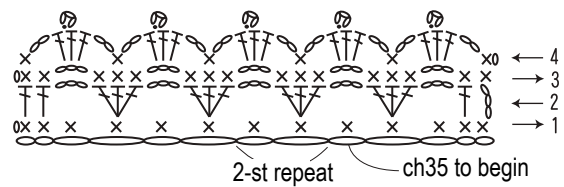
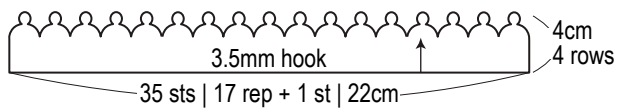

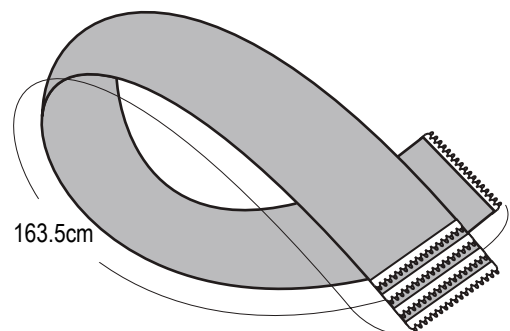
