

# 213s-17 Kids' Fedora



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Amian [100% washable Japanese paper; 94 yds/86m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - color #22 teal green, 1 skein [10g]
  - color #28 burnt umber, 2 skeins [70g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- head circumference 57.5cm/22.64"
- length 10cm/3.94"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- single crochet (US): 18 sts and 19 rounds

*Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Crochet Tips

**Top & sides:** Work foundation chain to begin, then work sc in the round, increasing as indicated. Starting from round 9 of sides, work in colorwork pattern stitch. Refer to chart for color sequences.

**Brim:** Continuing from sides, work 1 round of fp sc. Work sc from round 2 of brim onwards, increasing as indicated.


**Finishing:** Using steam iron, gently steam the hat, forming a depression at the top. Take care not to scald yourself when using steam iron.

## Abbreviations:

- ch = chain
- fp sc = front post sc (US)
- sc = single crochet (US)

## Hat schematic


3.5mm hook




## Hat instructions
