

808bag Miel Shoulder Bag



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Miel [100% jute; 120 yds/110m per 3.88 oz./110g cone];
 - color #5 cork, 1 cone [90g]
 - color #8 bleu, 1 cone [65g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 2 metal hooks
- 2 sets of snaps

Finished measurements:

- mouth circumference 23.5cm/9.25"
- depth 12.5cm/4.92"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- double crochet (US): 20 sts and 8 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Crochet Tips

Body of bag: Crochet foundation chain to begin. Work dc in alternating stripes (2 rows of dc per color). Work 1 round of sc edging around edge of bag.

Gusset: Crochet foundation chain to begin. Work in sc. Crochet a loop and attach to gusset. Make 2 gusset pieces.

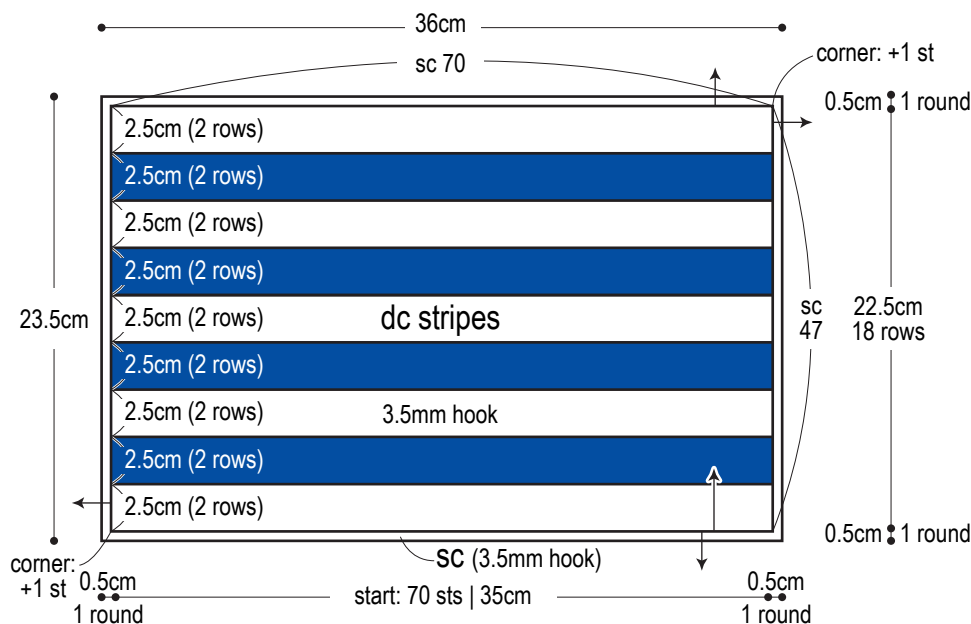
Strap: Crochet lobster stitch cord. Tie one hook to each end of cord using yarn tails.

Finishing: With wrong sides facing each other, seam body of bag to gusset using slip stitch seam (working through back loops only). Fasten snaps to bag.


Abbreviations:

ch = chain
dc = double crochet (US)
RS = right side
sc = single crochet (US)
WS = wrong side

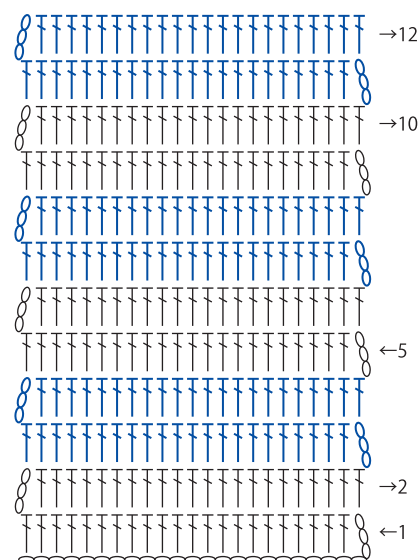


☐ = #5 cork

 = #8 bleu

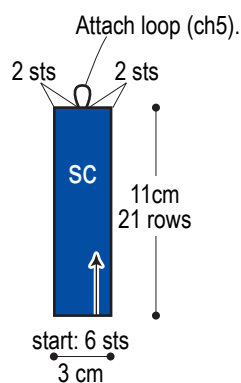
Dc stripes

3.5mm hook



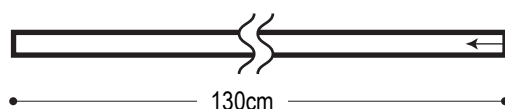
Gusset (make 2)

3.5mm hook



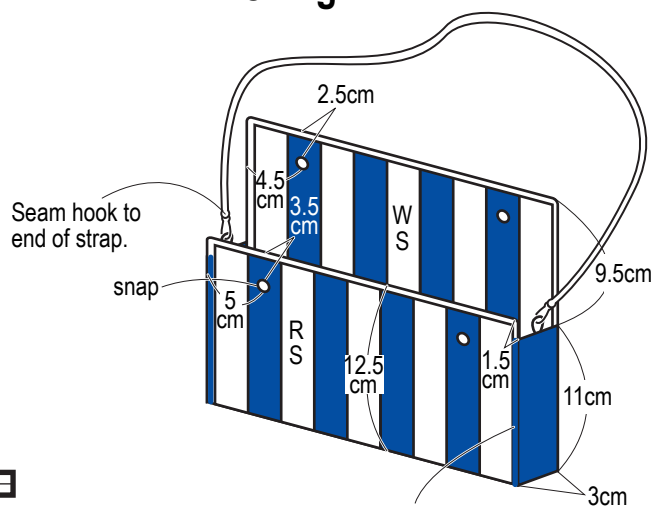
Strap: lobster stitch cord

3.5mm hook



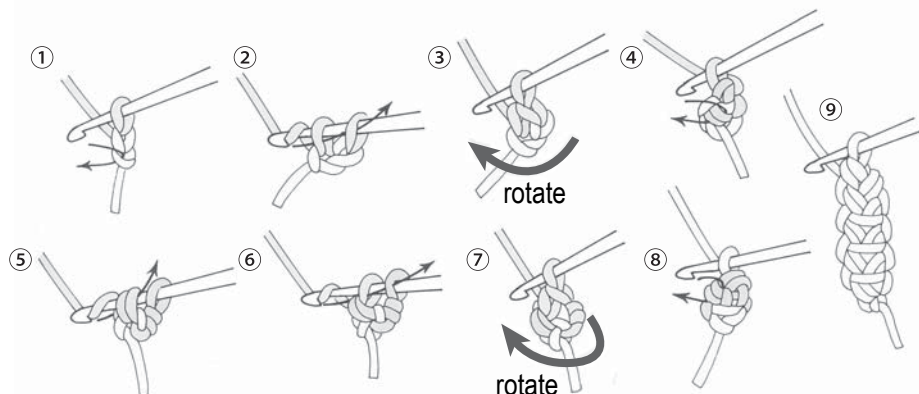
※Leave tail approx. 10cm long on each end to use to seam hooks to straps later.

Finishing



With color #8 and 3.5mm hook, seam body and gusset together (with wrong sides facing) using slip stitch seam worked into back loops only.

Lobster stitch cord



- ① ... ch1
- ② ... Turn cord to the left.
- ③ ... Insert hook into base of sc stitch.
- ④ ...
- ⑤ • ⑥ ... sc 1
- ⑦ ... Turn cord to the left.
- ⑧ ... Insert hook into base of sc stitch.
- ⑨ ... Repeat ④ ~ ⑦ .
