

21-22-4 Bolero & Scarf



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Lamé Wool [95% wool, 5% polyester lamé; 179 yds/164m per 3.17 oz./90g hank]; color #912 deep rose diamond
 - bolero: 6 hanks [460g]
 - scarf: 2 hanks [110g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.5mm (US 7) & 4.8mm (approx. US 8) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 3.0mm (approx. US C or D) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 89.5cm/35.24"
- cross back width 36cm/14.17"
- back length 50cm/19.69"
- sleeve length 54cm/21.26"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 19 sts and 28 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body & sleeves: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Referring to chart and schematics, work in pattern stitch.

Bolero finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Work edging in one continuous round along neckline, front edges, and hem.

Scarf: Cast on with crochet provisional cast-on method. Work in k1p1 ribbing. Bind off in pattern.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

k = knit

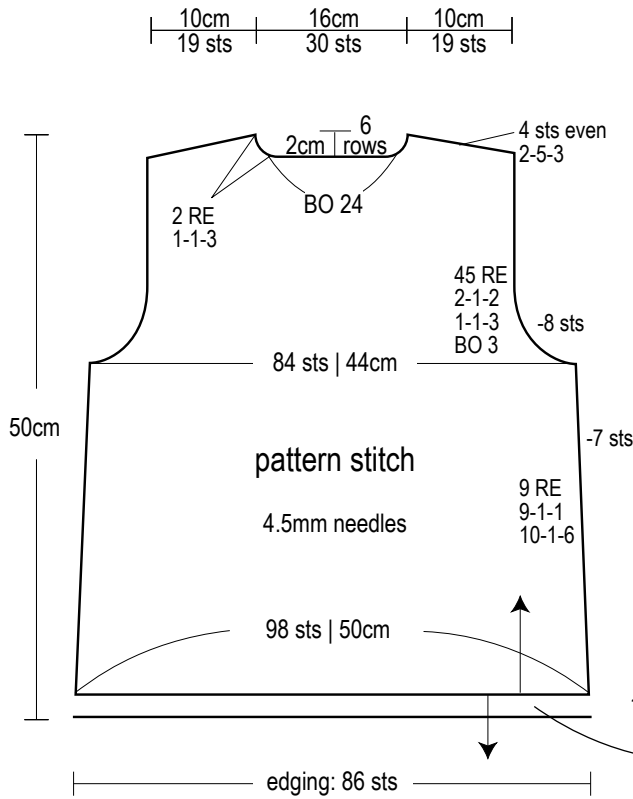
p = purl

RE = row(s) even

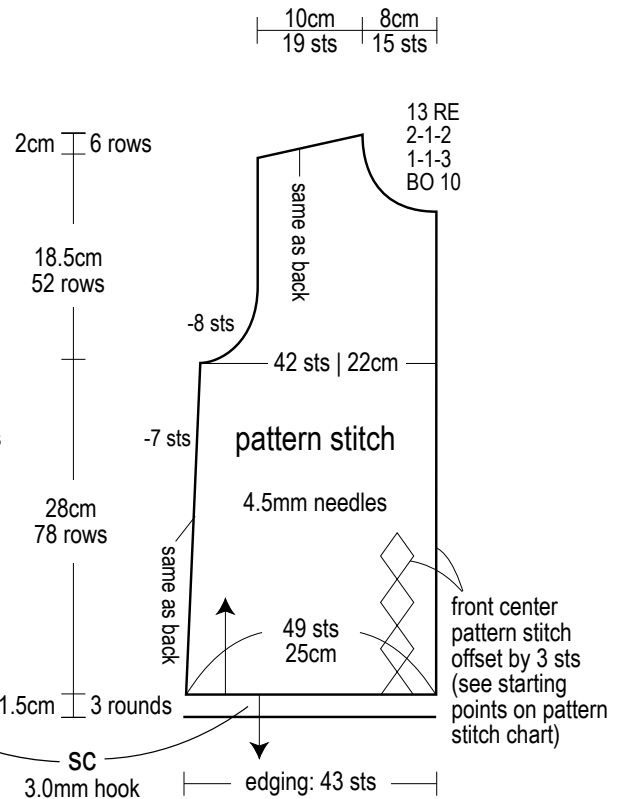
sc = single crochet (US)

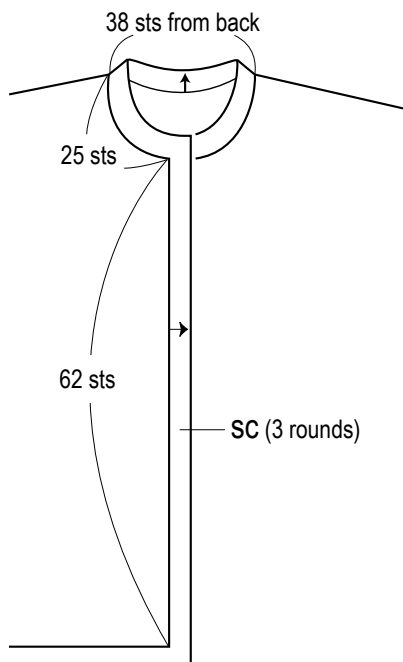


Right front

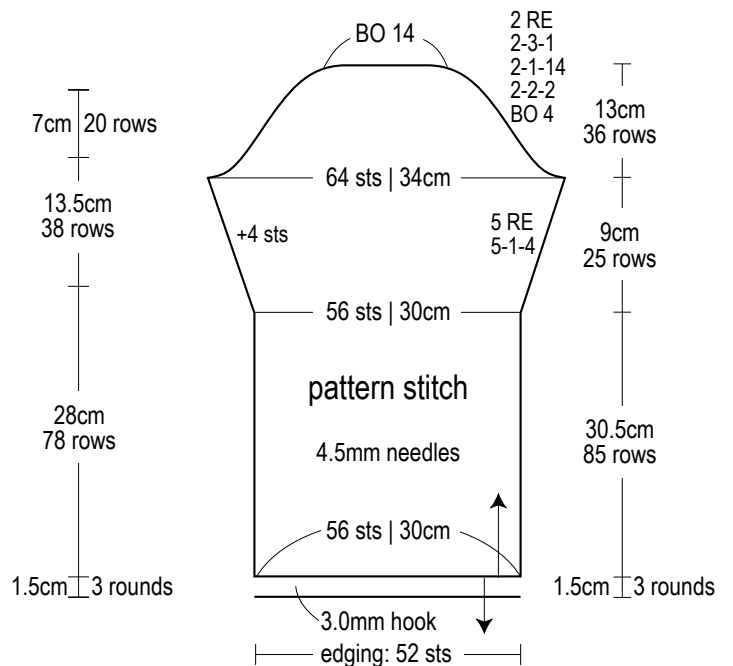


Front, hem & collar edging

sc, 3.0mm hook

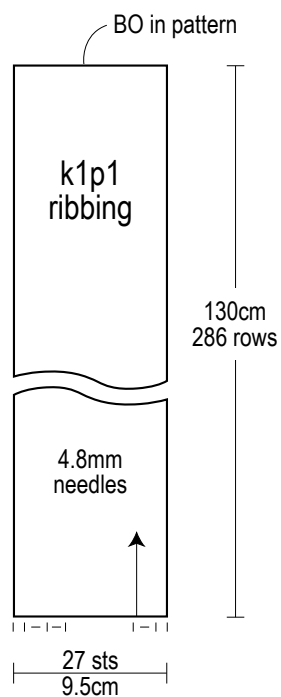
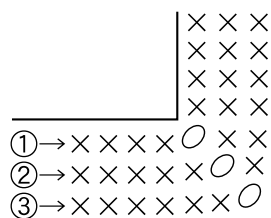


Sleeve
