

# 213fw-813sn Bubble Cowl



## Suggested yarn:

- Grignasco Bubble [68% wool, 32% acrylic; 24 yds/22m per 1.76 oz./50g skein];
  - version A: color #1362 erva, 3 skeins [115g]
  - version B: color #1360 sole, 5 skeins [230g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 15.0mm (US 19) knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- version A:
  - width 25cm/9.84"
  - length 60cm/23.62"
- version B:
  - width 25cm/9.84"
  - length 120cm/47.24"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 5 sts and 7 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Knitting Tips

**Body of cowl:** Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch. Every 4 rows, work drop stitch pattern. Bind off from wrong side.


**Finishing:** Seam short sides together with whipstitch.

※Note that finished size may differ depending on how tightly you wrap stitches for the drop stitch technique.


## Abbreviations:

BO = bind off  
CO = cast on  
k = knit stitch  
p = purl stitch  
RS = right side  
WS = wrong side


