809-1 Lara Pullover



Suggested yarn:

 Pierrot Yarns Kara [57% cotton, 43% alpaca; 104 yds/95m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #06 lady blue, 6 skeins [290g]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.6mm (approx. US 10½) and 7.0mm (no US equivalent) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 6.6mm (approx. US 101/2) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- bust 92cm/36.22"
- · cross back width 36cm/14.17"
- length 59cm/23.23"
- sleeve length 55cm/21.65"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

• stockinette stitch: 13 sts and 18 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Body & sleeves: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k2p2 ribbing. Change needle size, then continue in stockinette stitch. Shape armscye, neckline, and sleeve cap as follows: bind off stitches where indicated, and work fully fashioned decreases (1 stitch in from edge) at right and left edges of rows. Shape sleeve edges (the long edges that will be seamed together) by working lifted increases. Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam.

Finishing: Pick up stitches around neckline; work collar in k2p2 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattres stitch. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch seam.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

PU = pick up

RE = row(s) even

#-#-# = rows-stitches-times
