

# Kansha Wool Earflap Hat



## Suggested yarn:

- Keito-Zakka Stores Kansha Wool [100% wool; 33 yds/30m per 1.23 oz./35g skein]; color #01 navy, 5 skeins [170g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 6.0mm (US 10) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 5.0mm (US H) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- head circumference 53cm/20.9"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 12.5 sts and 16 rounds

*Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*


## Knitting Tips

Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Knit earflap, then crochet a chain, leaving a generous yarn tail. Knit a second earflap and join it to crochet chain, forming a loop. Pick up 66 sts from earflaps and crochet chain; work stockinette stitch in the round. Work decreases as indicated on chart. Thread yarn through remaining 11 sts, then cinch top of hat shut. Make pompom and two braided ties (3-strand braids), then attach to hat where indicated.

## Abbreviations:

ch = chain stitch  
CO = cast on  
inc = increase  
k = knit stitch  
st = stitch  
ssk = slip, slip, knit  
YO = yarn over
