

# 213fw-08 Fontaine Scarf



## Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Fontaine [80% wool, 20% baby alpaca; 103 yds/94m per 1.41 oz./40g skein];
  - color #01 vanilla, 2 skeins [60g]
  - color #07 brick, 5 skeins [130g]

## Tools/Notions:

- 3.5mm (US E) crochet hook or size necessary to achieve gauge

## Finished measurements:

- width 17cm/6.69"
- length (including fringe) 180cm/70.87"

## Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch: 22 sts and 12.5 rows

*Gauge may vary according to individual crochet style. Change hook size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.*

## Crochet Tips

**Scarf:** Work foundation chain to begin. Changing color every other row, work in pattern stitch.

**Finishing:** Attach fringe to ends of scarf where indicated.


## Abbreviations:

ch = chain

fp hdc = front post half double crochet (US)

rep = pattern repeat(s)

# Scarf schematic




— = #01 vanilla

※To make fringe, fold 4 strands (each 24cm long) in two. Tie at end of scarf in one of the 11 places indicated at each end. Repeat for all fringe locations.
