

213fw-17 Yuyake Skirt



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Yuyake no Sora L [100% superwash wool; 219 yds/200m per 3.17-3.53 oz./90-100g hank]; color #202 dark blue variegated, 5 hanks [430g]

Tools/Notions:

- 4.2mm (approx. US 6) straight knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- 4.2mm approx. (US 6) double-pointed knitting needles or size necessary to achieve gauge
- elastic for waistband: 25mm/0.98" wide, 70cm/27.56" long

Finished measurements:

- waist circumference 68cm/26.77"
- hip circumference 92cm/36.22"
- length 63cm/24.80"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A, B, and stockinette stitch: 20 sts and 29 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Skirt: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in pattern stitch B, referring to chart for increases (worked in purl sections). Continue in pattern stitch A; work even. Bind off loosely in pattern. Knit two skirt pieces, then seam sides with mattress stitch.

Finishing: Pick up stitches around cast-on edge; work waistband in stockinette stitch in the round. Bind off loosely in pattern. Fold waistband toward inside where indicated, wrapping fabric around elastic. Seam waistband to inside of skirt with waistband, leaving a 3cm/1.18" opening. (Overlap ends of elastic by 2cm/0.79", forming a ring, then seam them together.)

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit

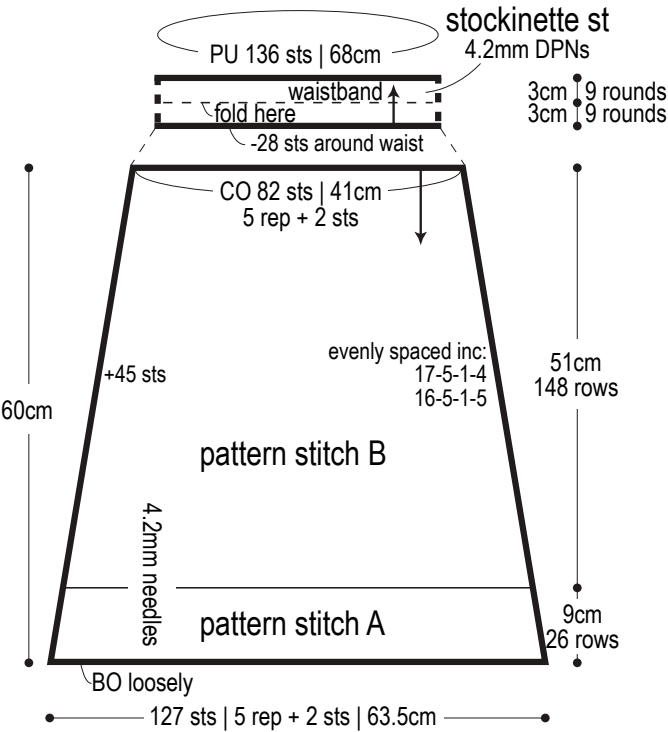
inc = increase(s)

PU = pick up

rep = repeat(s)

= rows-places-stitches-times [for evenly spaced increases worked across entire width of an item]. For example, 1-2-3-4 means "every 1 row, increase 3 stitches in each of 2 places across the row; do this 4 times total."

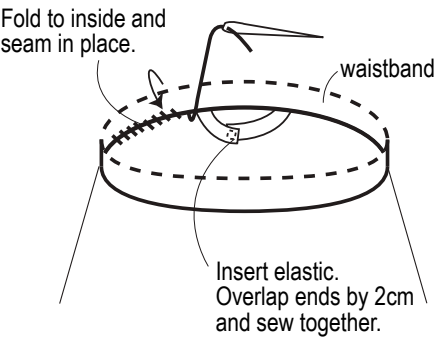


Chart 1
4.2mm needles

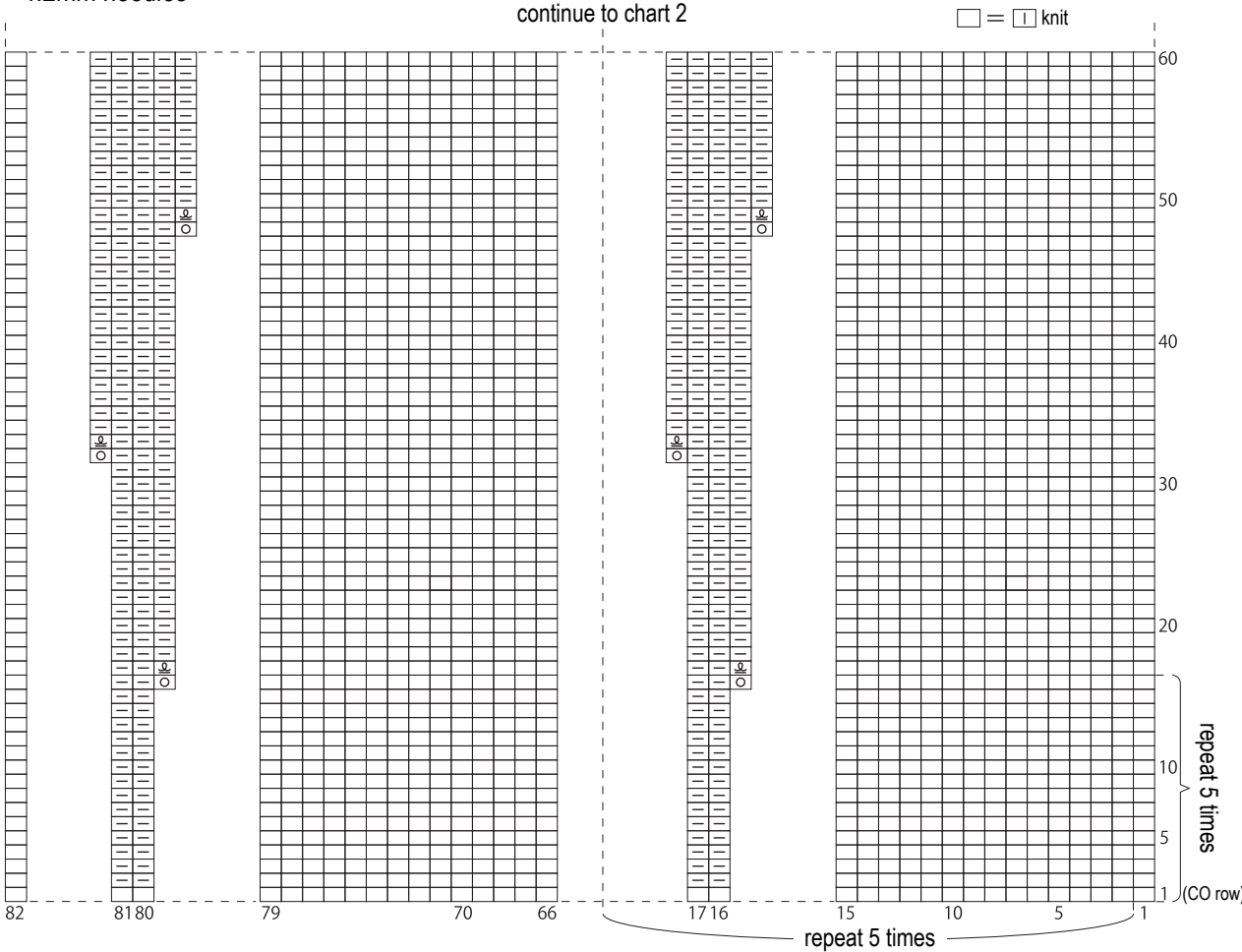
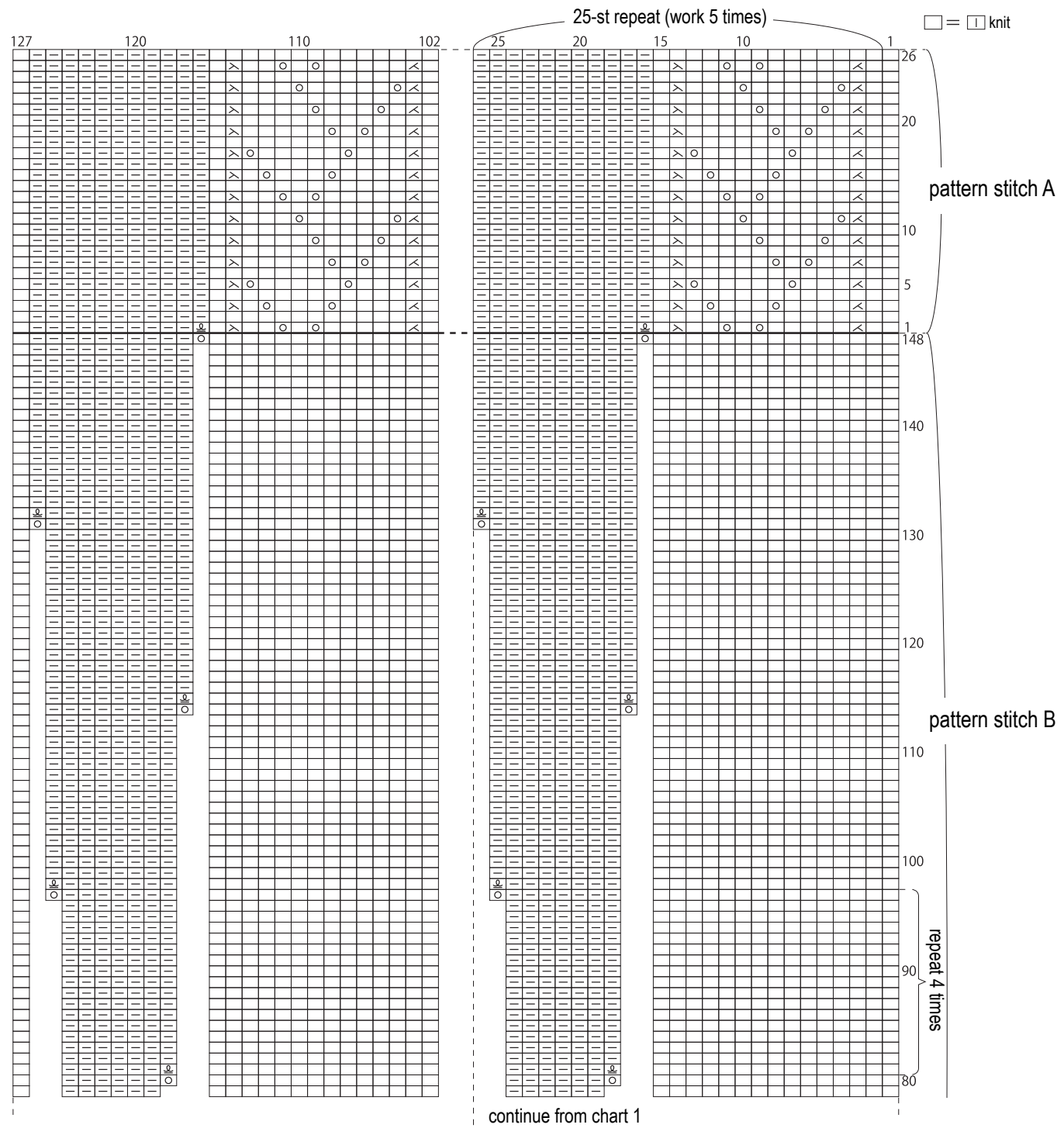


Chart 2
