

213fw-19 Two-Color Aran Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Arles DK [100% baby alpaca; 133 yds/122m per 1.76 oz./50g skein]; color #01 milk, 7 skeins [320g]
- Pierrot Yarns Saumur [70% merino wool, 30% baby alpaca; 118 yds/108m per 1.06 oz./30g skein]; color #06 mint gray, 2 skeins [60g]

Tools/Notions:

- 3.0mm (US 2½) and 4.2mm (approx. US 6) straight knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- 2.7mm (approx. US 2) and 3.0mm (US 2½) double-pointed knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge
- cable needle

Finished measurements:

- bust 90cm/35.43"
- cross back width 34cm/13.39"
- length 65cm/25.59"
- sleeve length 58cm/22.83"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- pattern stitch A: 21 sts and 26 rows
- pattern stitches B & C: 24 sts and 31 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

Knitting Tips

Back & front body: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k3p2 ribbing. Change needle size, then continue in pattern stitches A and B.

Sleeve: Cast on with long-tail cast-on method. Work in k3p2 ribbing. Change needle size, then continue in pattern stitch C. Shape curve of sleeve cap as follows: when decreasing 2 or more stitches, bind them off. When decreasing 1 stitch, work decrease 1 stitch in from the edge. Bind off in pattern.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with crochet slip stitch seam. Seam sides and sleeve undersides with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around neckline, then work collar in k3p2 ribbing in the round. Bind off in pattern. Seam sleeves to body with crochet slip stitch.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off

CO = cast on

k = knit stitch

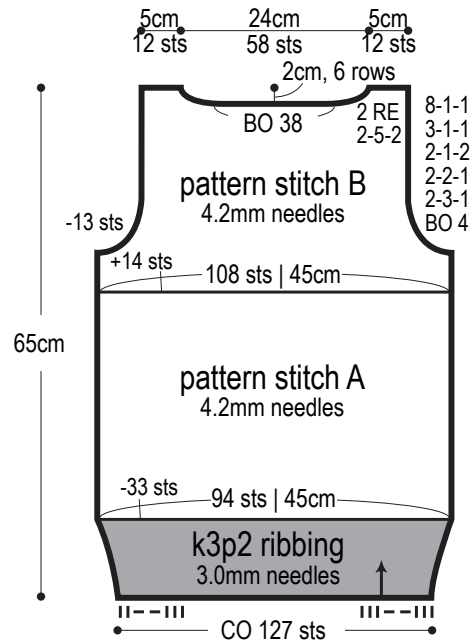
p = purl stitch

PU = pick up

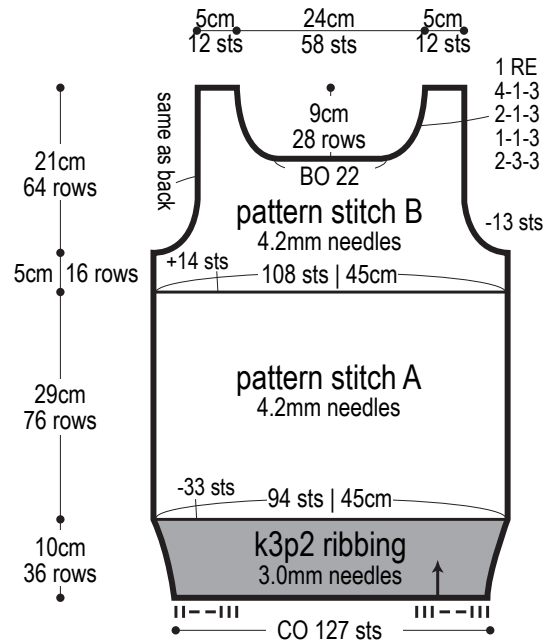
RE = row(s) even

= rows-stitches-times

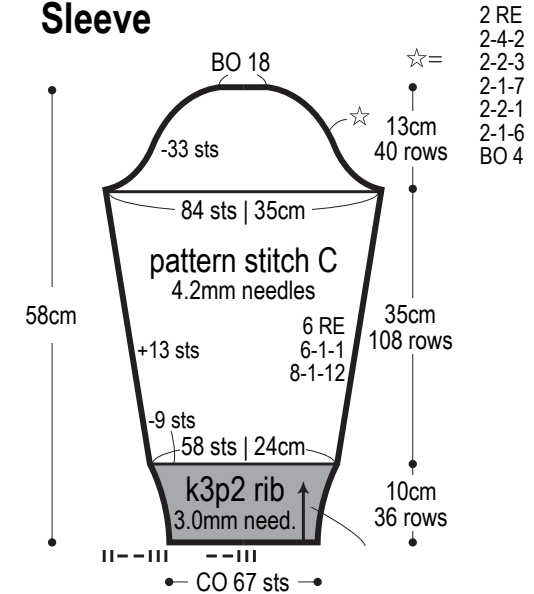

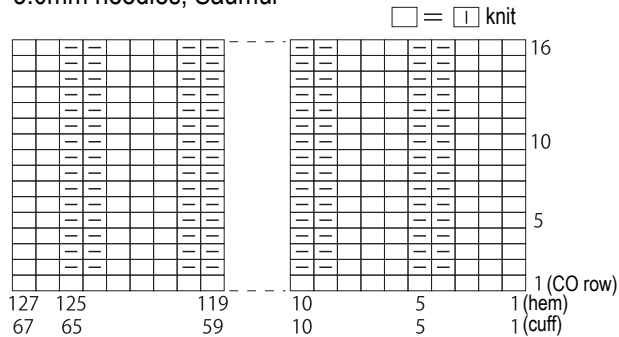

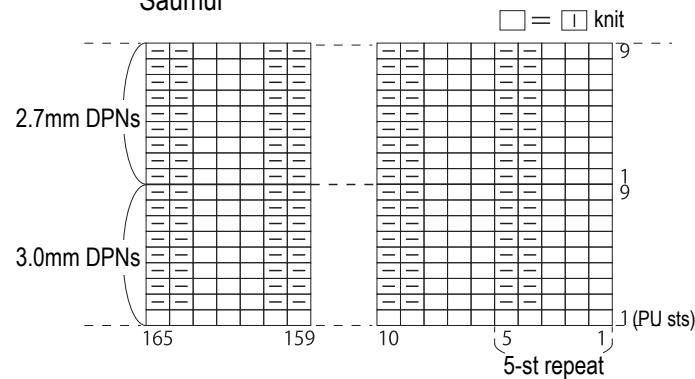
Hem & cuff ribbing

3.0mm needles, Saumur



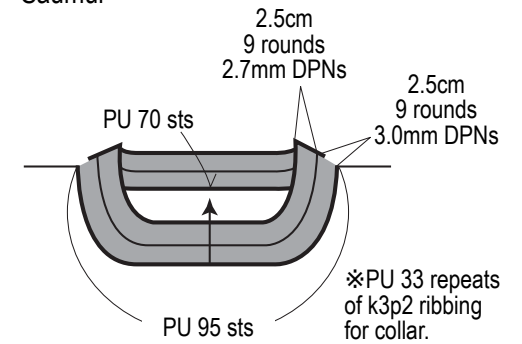
Collar ribbing

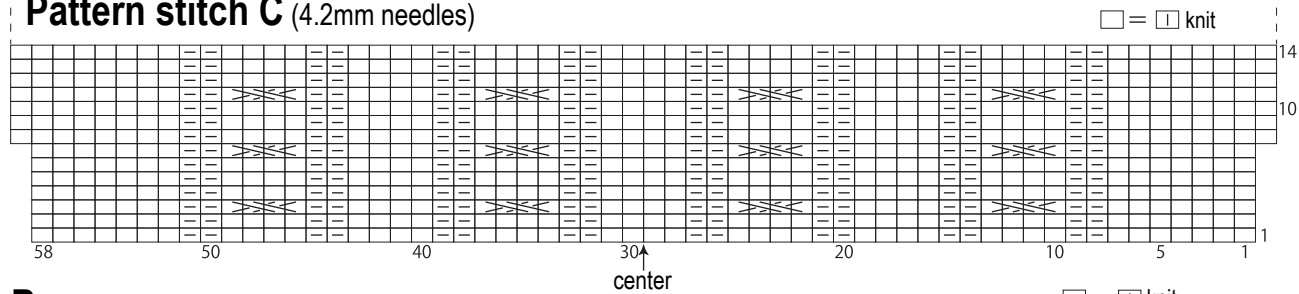

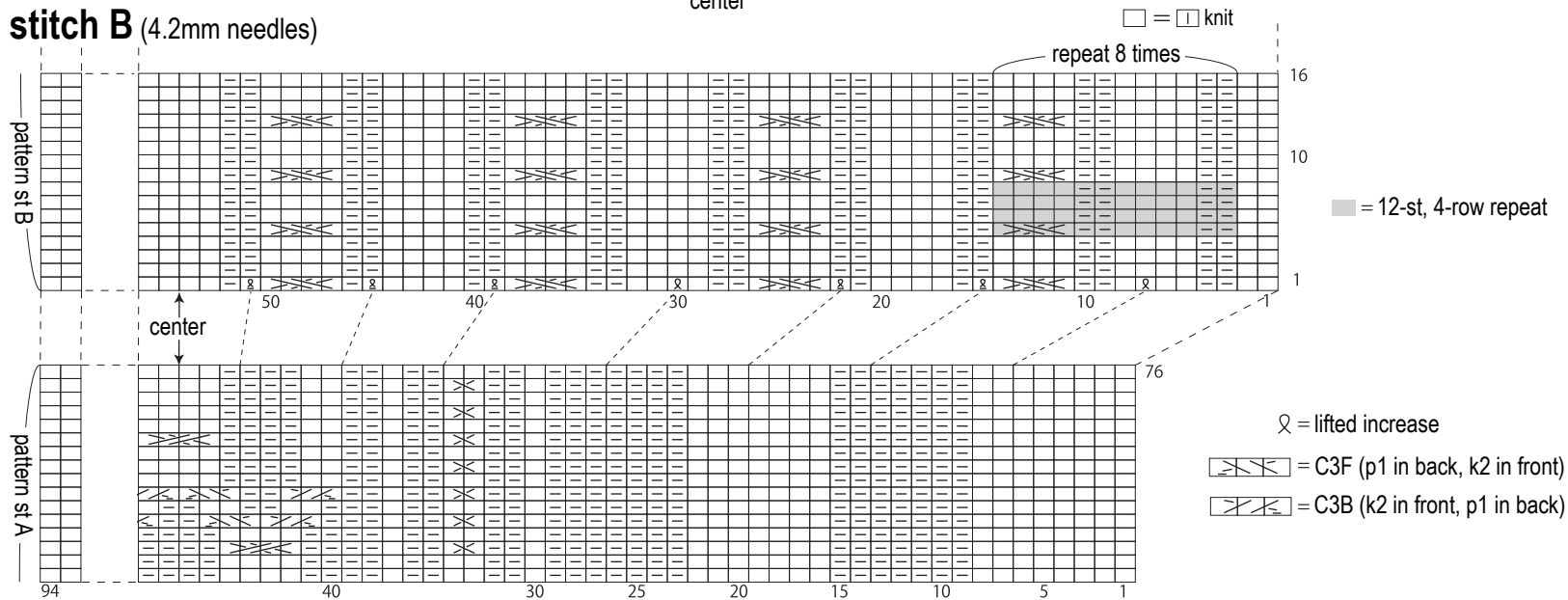
