

213w-13 Soft Merino Square Sweater



Suggested yarn:

- Pierrot Yarns Soft Merino Bulky [100% merino wool; 44 yds/40m per 1.41 oz./40g skein]; color #7-1 camellia rose, 10 skeins [370g]

Tools/Notions:

- 6.3mm (approx. US 10) and 6.6mm (approx. US 10½) knitting needles or sizes necessary to achieve gauge

Finished measurements:

- width 68cm/26.77"
- length 45cm/17.72"

Gauge (10cm/4" square):

- stockinette stitch: 12.5 sts and 17 rows
- pattern stitch: 12.5 sts and 20 rows

Gauge may vary according to individual knitting style. Change needle size if necessary to achieve gauge. Alternatively, rework pattern with your own gauge measurements.

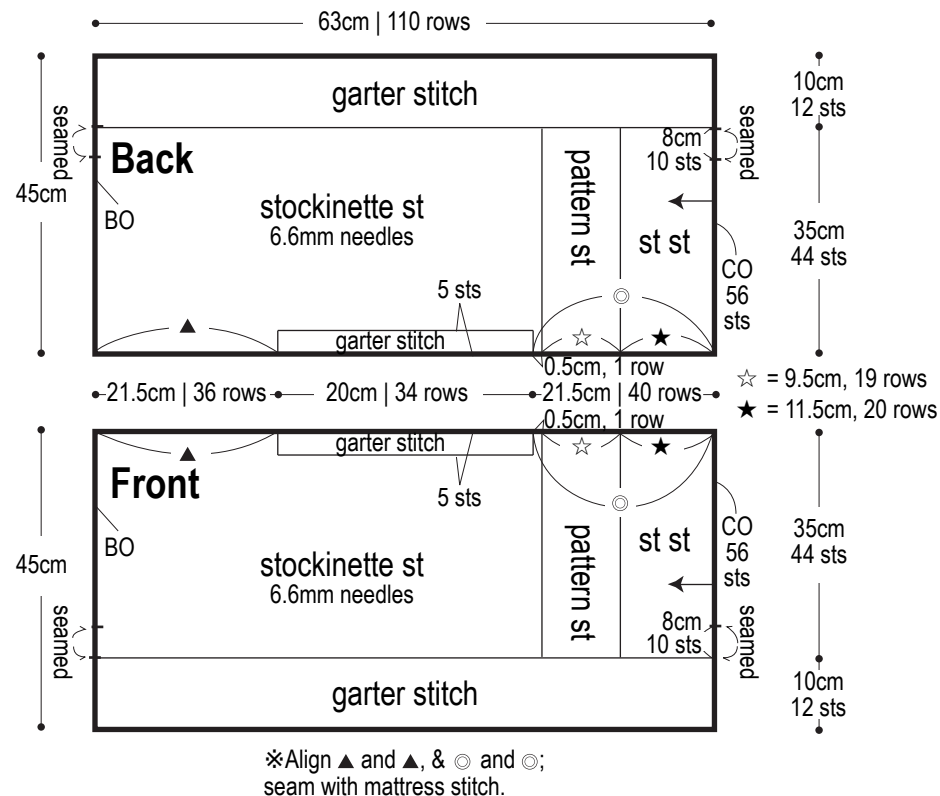
Knitting Tips

Body: Cast on 56 stitches with long-tail cast-on method. Work 20 rows of stockinette stitch and garter stitch, then 19 rows of pattern stitch and garter stitch. Continue according to schematic. Bind off in pattern. Make a second body piece identical to the first.

Finishing: Seam shoulders with mattress stitch. Pick up stitches around armholes; work edging in garter stitch, then bind off in pattern. Seam 10 stitches on each side together with whipstitch; continue to sleeve underarm, seaming it with mattress stitch.

Abbreviations:

BO = bind off
CO = cast on
PU = pick up
st st = stockinette stitch



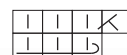
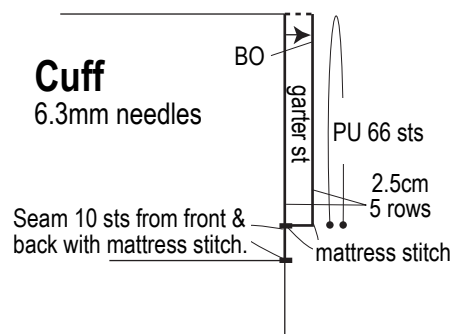
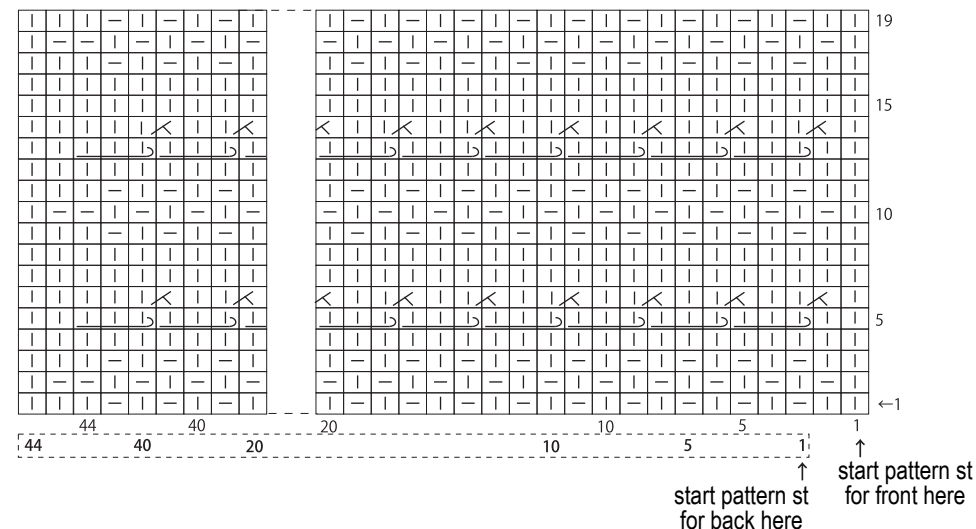

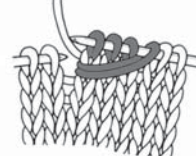
Pattern stitch 6.6mm needles



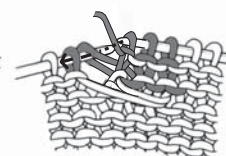
Instructions



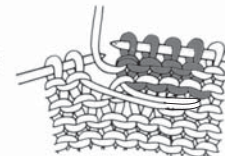
① Pull up a loop
between 3rd and
4th sts on L needle.



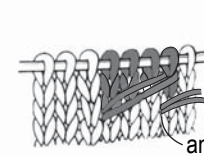
② Knit the first 3
sts on L needle as
usual.



③ On next row, insert
R needle purlwise
through big loop and
the st on its L side.



④ Purl these 2 sts
together.



⑤ One finished pattern
repeat (seen from RS
after working purl row).
